# Introduction to Tao Geomancy

## What is geomancy?

- Geomancy is the science of perceiving, understanding and working with the subtle energy fields of the planet Earth (Terra).
- Since modern Western science only focuses on the physical aspects of the Universe, most scientists are generally ignorant of the metaphysical and spiritual aspects of Life, and how they influence the health and overall well-being of humans, animals and plants.
- However, prior to the emergence and dominance of scientific rationalism in the Western world, all civilizations from around the world had developed and practiced some form of geomancy, a knowledge especially useful when looking for auspicious places for building houses, locating water and fertile lands for farming, and the building of cities and fortresses.

# Introduction to Tao Geomancy

## Origins of Feng Shui and Geomancy in China

- According to historians, the science of Feng Shui originated in China more than 4,000 years ago.
- It was developed by Taoist Masters in order to understand and attempt to harmonize human life with natural forces.
- The Taoist philosophy was based on the observed interaction of cosmic and terrestrial forces. Main principles: understanding the relationship of Yin and Yang, the interaction of the Five Cosmic Elements with the 8 Compass Directions, and the natural flow of Qi (Vital Energy) in and through land formations.
- Divination, astrology, and geomancy were a part of this practice.

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## Taoist origins

- Since the Taoist teachings were ancient, broad in scope, profound in nature, and deeply philosophical, it became common for people to specialize in one subset of the teachings.
- Some people became adept metaphysical scholars, others specialized in building design, or performance of propitiatory rituals, martial arts or healing arts, or composing poetry and calligraphy. Others simply became reclusive hermits, and devoted their lives to contemplation of the nature of Reality (Tao).
- It was rare to find someone who had a high level of skill in all of the Taoist teachings.

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## Qi-Mag International Feng Shui and Geobiology Institute

- In 1990 Dr Jes T.Y. Lim, born in Malaysia, started the Qi-Mag International Feng Shui and Geobiology Institute, which eventually became the world's largest college for Feng Shui and related studies, with over 30,000 students worldwide.
- In November 2000, Dr Lim began teaching an updated, contemporary version of Chinese geomancy, incorporating ideas from European geomancy and ethnic shamanic teachers from around the world.
- He named his version of this teaching "Tao Geomancy", because its essential basis was Taoist in orientation. But now it is no longer limited to the traditional practices from China, which in some ways became stagnant and ritualistic in nature.

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## Grandmaster Jes T.Y. Lim

- Grandmaster Jes T.Y. Lim is now semi-retired in his birthplace town of Kota Kinabalu, in the state of Sabah, on the island of Borneo, in East Malaysia.
- He continues to teach online courses on various health and wellness subjects, and occasion in-person courses locally in Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia.

# Classical Feng Shui and Geomancy

## Interaction of the Physical and the Metaphysical Worlds

- Classical “Landscape” Feng Shui studied physical land formations, the slope of the land and elevation; placement of water and mountains, the quality of soil, and assessing the suitability of the land according to the Taoist concept of Yin/Yang and the Five Cosmic Elements (Water, Wood, Fire, Earth, and Metal) in their constructive/ complementary and destructive/antagonistic interactions.
- In ancient China, this was considered essential knowledge, a deep and profound topic, contrary to the modern view of Feng Shui as stylized interior design, hanging a few wind chimes and mirrors, and moving furniture around.
- Geomancy was the study of invisible Natural Forces, and their influence on the lives of humans, animals and agriculture.

# Traditional Geomancy

## Interaction of the Inner (Spiritual) and the Outer (Material) World

- Understanding the interaction of outer, visible Natural Forces is the foundation and the base level of Classical Feng Shui.
- The next level of understanding is the mastery of the metaphysical level of Existence—controlling the weather, pacifying and subduing troublesome spirits, neutralizing various forms of geopathic stress, and purification of the etheric records of war, disease, poverty and suffering.
- Through geomancy, it is possible to improve the quality of agricultural land, control the weather and reduce atmospheric disturbances, and generally modify the physical and metaphysical environment to better support good health, social harmony, prosperity, and civilizational development.

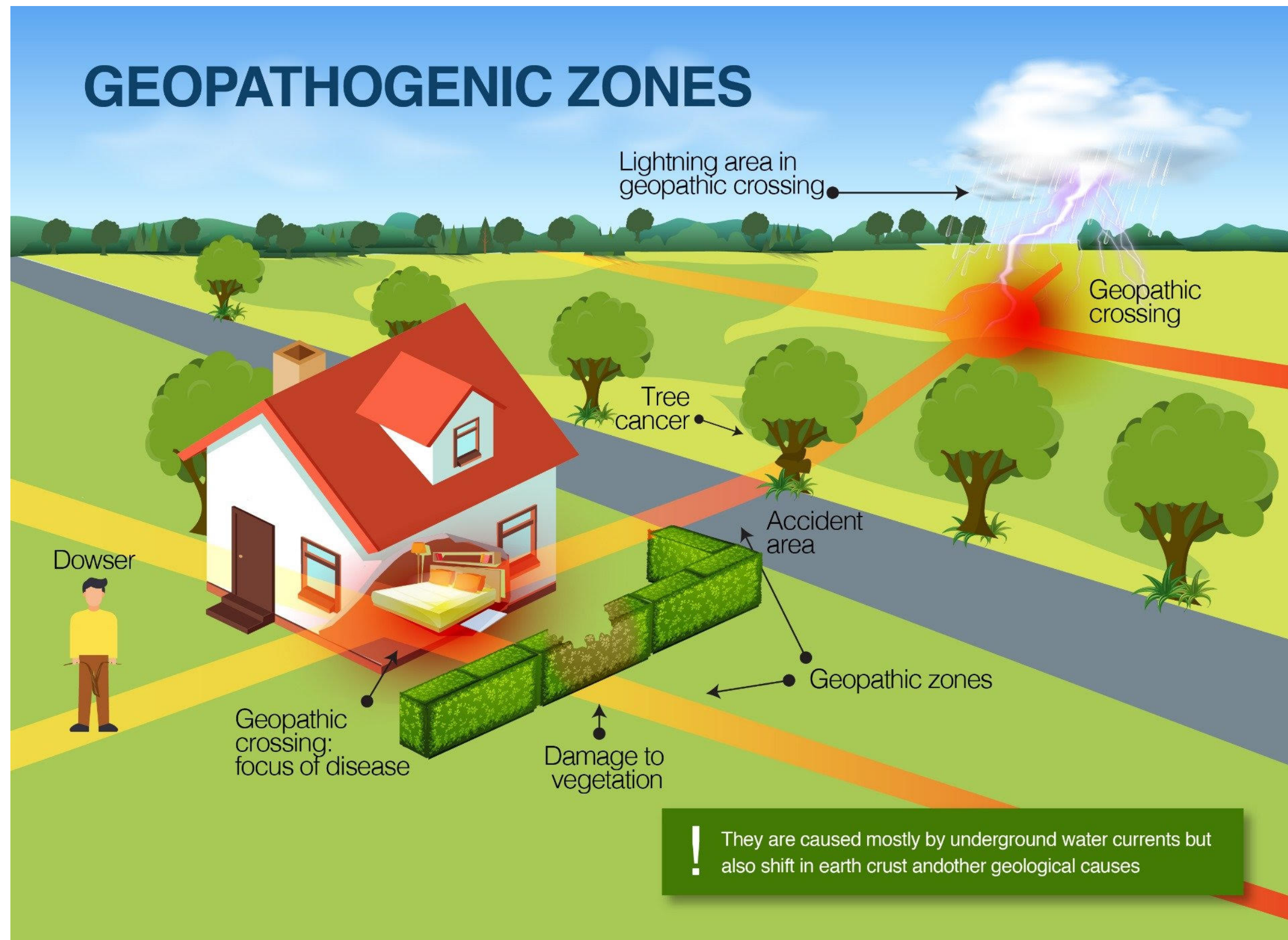
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## Energetic signatures in the land

- People have been living in the same places for thousands of years.
- Their energetic records are imprinted in the rocks, trees, soil and ether.
- These dormant energetic records can become activated through earth changes or human activities such as excavation for new construction, and may have a detrimental effect upon our health.
- The geological structure, elements and minerals in the earth will also affect our health.

- Widespread international research now indicates that geopathic stress may be one of the primary causes of degenerative illnesses and chronic health conditions. These studies show a high level of correlation between major illnesses and sleeping or working over an area of geopathic stress.
- In one recent study, scientists from the Dulwich Health Society studied over 25,000 people with ill health and concluded that geopathic stress with directly related to..
- 100% of people who get secondary forms of cancer
- 95% of people who get cancer were sleeping and/or working in an area with geopathic stress
- 95% of children who are hyperactive, who have learning disabilities, or who are difficult to control
- 95% of people who get AIDS

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## Geopathic Stress is directly related to...

- 80% of parents or caregivers who abuse children
- 80% of divorces involve one or both partners experiencing geopathic stress
- 80% of couples who cannot conceive children naturally
- 80% of women who have a miscarriage
- 80% of babies who died in the crib
- 70% of post viral fatigue sufferers
- 70% of people who have food allergies

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## Common symptoms of geopathic stress can include:

- Fatigue, weak immune system, depression, nervousness, loss of appetite,
- Poor digestion, allergies, insomnia, circulation problems, muscle cramps, and grinding of teeth.
- Children are especially sensitive to geopathic stress.
- Bed wetting and continuous crying by babies may occur.

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## The Practice of Tao Geomancy

- Precisely identify the exact cause of the geomantic problem.
- Choose the most appropriate remedy or solution.
- Neutralize all “left-turning” (Life negative) energy fields using transformative techniques.
- Balance the Yin/Yang energies, the productive and destructive dynamics of the Five Cosmic Elements (Water, Wood, Fire, Earth, Metal), and the flow of Qi.
- Activate the vital energy of the land to be the level of virgin forest.
- Anchor these changes so that there is no regression to the previous state.

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## How is this different from the usual energy work?

- The work is performed in a proven, comprehensive, systematic way.
- The system was developed and taught by one of the highest level, most respected Grandmasters of Feng Shui, energy healing, and esoteric teachings.
- Professional training is required before being certified to practice.
- The techniques and methods are unique to this school.
- The proof and value is in the results.

# Tao Geomancy

## Transforming the energy of burial sites, battle grounds, ritual sites

- This is an area of specialization which requires higher level of skills.
- More spiritual protection is required.
- We can rank a person's Spiritual Level according to a numerical scale.
- The measure of the Spiritual Level of the practitioner is different from the "Level of Consciousness" rating developed by Dr David Hawkins.
- The Spiritual Level is related to what a person can actually accomplish, and not merely the subjective awareness of higher levels of consciousness.

# Tao Geomancy

## Black Streams

- Black Streams and Black Pools are underground formations of decomposing vegetation, dead animals and other organic materials.
- Landslides, earthquakes and other gradual earth changes may have resulted in healthy streams and pools of water being buried underground, and unable to decompose naturally with healthy by-products, like compost pits.
- Poisonous gases released by volcanic eruptions and fault lines can contaminate these black streams and pools and result in the emission of poisonous gases which may leak to the surface.
- These noxious gases are very toxic, even at very low levels, and have an adverse effect on human health.

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## Energy Vortices - Natural and Manmade

- The study and practice of Tao Geomancy allows us to identify natural energy vortices, and to create new ones in auspicious places in the house, and outside, on private and public property.
- We are not limited to the natural quality and influence of energy based upon the Compass Directions, and to the floor plan of a house.
- Even astrological influences and personal karmas can be mitigated to a certain extent by the creation, programming, and management of energy fields and vortices which promote better health, self-awareness, and enhance creativity.

# Tao Geomancy

## The Spiritual Dimension

- Tao Geomancy recognizes that there are other worlds and dimensions interacting with our own 3D human world.
- “Ghost-busting”, or working to remove mischievous and aggressive spirits, is an important part of this work.
- Very often the Soul of a physically deceased person is still attached to the human body and burial site. They might remain near the burial site for hundreds of years. These souls might resist the intrusion of new construction on or near their space, or resent the appearance of new occupants of a house.
- Spiritual rituals can be performed to encourage these discarnate spirits to leave the area.

# Tao Geomancy

## Homes built on hillsides and unstable ground

- Tao Geomancy includes teachings on how to stabilize houses built on unstable land.
- There are effective techniques to stabilize or deactivate small earthquake fault lines, and thereby reduce the effect of this type of geopathic stress.
- With practice, we can also create energetic, virtual pillars anchored deep into the earth, which can physically stabilize the house or office building.

# Tao Geomancy

## Space clearing and land activation

- With the techniques and practices of Tao Geomancy, the energetic records of a house can be transformed and the vital energy of a house can be raised to a high level in a few minutes—even remotely. The goal is 800-1000 Qi-Mag units.
- But for the house to maintain a high level of vital energy going forward, the house must be kept physically clean, and the residents must be doing some kind of regular spiritual practice to keep the energy high.
- Houses built on land with low vital energy can enjoy a higher level of vital energy through the spiritual practice of “Land Activation”. This is much more difficult and time consuming process than clearing the space above ground. We might need to send high intensity energy several hundred meters into the earth, to transmute, transform, and stabilize the renewed energy field at a higher level.

# The World Health Crisis

## Triage for Mass Casualty Incidents (MCI)

- The core goal is to do as much as possible with limited resources and limited time.
- We need to prioritize actions that save the maximize number of lives.
- Some people have serious conditions but can be saved with immediate intervention.
- Others will survive without immediate intervention; they can receive help later.
- Finally, some people are just too far gone. There is nothing you can do to save them.
