

The Politics of Science: A Background on Energy Medicine

Adapted from a presentation given to the 18th Annual Medical Symposium of the ARE Clinic Phoenix, Arizona, January 23-27, 1985

I WAS MOST excited to learn that the Fetzer Foundation had stepped forward to assist the ARE Clinic in setting up a program in "Energy Medicine," and I'm glad they didn't call it "Paramedicine." I think, in some ways, if we'd had "Energy Psychology" instead of "Parapsychology" there would have been less controversy.

I have been following some very interesting developments in energy medicine that really go a long way back—to the very start of this century. It looks as though, with the initiative of this marvelous foundation in Kalamazoo, maybe something can be done to pick up the pieces of some of this research which has all but been forgotten.

Georges Lakhovsky

The first man I will mention today is the Russian-born Frenchman, Georges Lakhovsky. I learned only yesterday that Lakhovsky seems to have been an associate of, or knew, Nikola Tesla. I had not known that, and from the point of view of the history of energy medicine, it's a very interesting thing. At any rate, Georges Lakhovsky began to experiment with what he called a "multiwave oscillator." (In the Library of Congress there are some ten books written by Lakhovsky, all in French.)

This multiwave oscillator (MWO) put out a very broad spectrum of electromagnetic frequencies. The theory, as propounded by Lakhovsky, was that each cell in the body of an organism—be it a plant, an animal, or a human being—is in itself a little radio receiver and works on its own special little frequency. Each cell, in addition to being tissue, in addition to being biology, is also electricity. On that theory, he held that pathology was a not matter of biological concern or intervention, but one of electrical concern and intervention. He theorized that from the bath of electrical frequencies put out by the multiwave oscillator, each cell individually could and would select that frequency which it most needed to restore its equilibrium.

So he began to experiment, not with animals or human beings, but with geraniums. These were geraniums which had cancers—plants get cancers too. And, lo and behold—the geraniums were cured of their cancers; which simply began to fall off, since they are external in the case of geraniums. The geraniums would just shed the diseased tissues when exposed to the MWO. Lakhovsky then went on to do work on animals and human beings and his work

was picked up by doctors in six or seven countries, among them Italy, Sweden and Brazil. Finally, because he was on the "wanted" list of the Nazis, he was smuggled out of France and came to New York during the war, where he worked with a urologist. The record of his treatment of degenerative disease, with what amounts to an early "energy medicine" device, was remarkable. But the work had to be done in secret because orthodox medicine did not favor this device, and its power, associated with that of the FDA and the AMA and other "control organizations," kept the MWO underground.

The Lakhovsky device is a very effective one. I'm not going to say that it's 100% effective because I don't think any device is, but it is way up there. Georges Lakhovsky, who died in 1944 or 1945.

Royal Raymond Rife

The next man is Royal Raymond Rife, who came on the scene just about the time that Lakhovsky had begun his research. Rife had no academic training whatsoever. He got a job as chauffeur and handyman for Timken, the roller bearing magnate from Ohio who also spent a lot of time in California back in the 1920's. And there, Royal Raymond Rife proved that you don't necessarily need academic training to develop something new. In the case of Lakhovsky, Rife—and about three dozen other people I could go on to mention—in fact, it was an advantage that they didn't have any academic training because what they did went against anything they would have been taught in the "academies." At any rate, Rife conceived and built, an extraordinary microscope called the *Universal Microscope*.

When I first heard of his work and his microscope, I simply couldn't believe that it existed. I got on the telephone in Washington and I called Walter Reed Hospital, the big central medical hospital for the U.S. Army. They have a special division, almost a museum, on microscopy. I asked where the Rife microscope was and nobody had ever heard of it. Then I called the Smithsonian Institute and nobody had heard of it there. Then I called the National Library of Medicine. Nobody had heard of it. So I began to wonder; was I "nuts," or was my informant misinformed, or what really was the story?

Suddenly, through a series of synchronous events, I had a stroke of luck. I was in the National Library of Medicine looking for some data about Rife, and there was nothing in the card catalog under R-i-f-e. I found myself leaning against a set of drawers containing cards which began with the abbreviated rubric M-I-C, for microscopes. There were about four drawers, and it takes about 1½ hours to carefully examine one drawer of cards. I figured it would be a pointless exercise to go through all the drawers, but I had the first drawer open and, just idly, halfway along the drawer I pulled the cards apart and there was something that, as I recall, read "The Allied Company." It bore an extraordinary subtitle. It was a report about cancer cures and a microscope, and way down at the bottom of the card was the notation: Written by Royal Raymond Rife. I could never have found that card by looking under Rife's name!

I learned from that report that the Universal Microscope had been written up and published (over 38 pages) in not only the official journal of the Smithsonian Institute in Washington, but also in the official journal of the Franklin Institute in Philadelphia—a big repository of engineering facts. The same article, entitled "The New Microscopes," had been simultaneously published by those two institutions in 1944. The other principal microscope which was treated in the article was the electron microscope, which had just been put on the market by RCA.

I find that to be an incredible bit of scientific history: that of the two microscopes which were featured, side by side, in an article published by the Smithsonian Institute and the Franklin Institute (the section on Rife's "Universal Microscope" was much longer than the section on the electron microscope), one went on to be used in practically every medical research lab of any size and the other one disappeared off the face of the map!

The electron microscope can only examine *dead* tissue while the Rife microscope could examine *living matter* on high magnification—up to 30,000X—and at extraordinary resolution. Was the Rife microscope, the one which could look at *live* tissue, taken off the market or destroyed just because of that? Does it say something to you?

So Rife invented this microscope. The Universal scope had something like 763 separate parts. It's all described in the article. (You can get it out of the libraries.) The man who provided the description was a devoted homeopathic doctor in Philadelphia who did the work with his secretary. They had a very hard time because it was during the war, and Rife was living and working in San Diego while they were in Philadelphia. It was extremely complex technology to describe. And therefore if, today, you give this article to even technically well-trained people, there are "holes" in it which make it very difficult to understand at the "nuts and bolts" level exactly how this microscope works. But what it did have, which distinguished it from all other microscopes, were lenses made, not of glass, but of quartz. Quartz, as you know, will admit ultraviolet light, whereas glass will not. So that is one key.

It also had was a quartz prism which could be rotated very, very slowly; so slowly, in fact, that Rife would sit in a specially built chair looking at a specimen—a living speci-

men— as long as 72 hours; just looking while rotating this prism! As the prism rotated very slowly, it would illuminate the specimen with a single frequency of light, and at a given point, if that frequency was "correct," it would cause the specimen being examined to illuminate itself through a reasonance factor. It was at this point that the special magnification and resolution could be achieved. But it takes great patience to get this kind of magnification in this special scope, which may be another reason why it never achieved popularity.

About 1977, I wrote a long article about this which was published in the *New Age Journal* and, among other things, it dealt with the controversy which is today still raging in medical circles after 50 years, as to whether microorganisms are mono- or pleio-morphic. That is, either microorganisms, from bacteria down to viruses, are monomorphic, meaning that they are "one form and one form only," or they are pleiomorphic, meaning that they can change from one form to another.

There was a terrible fight in the 1930's over this and the monomorphic people won. It's a very interesting controversy which took me about six weeks of work to research in the Library of Medicine when I was doing the article for the *New Age Journal*. (The article was entitled "What Has Become of the Rife Microscope?") The last sentence of the last paragraph was a plea to the public to help out to see if we could find them.

(Subsequently, I did find two of Rife's microscopes in very bad condition in the garage of one of Rife's mechanics in San Diego. Still another is preserved in perfect condition in the Welcome Foundation, a medical foundation and museum in London, because it had been carried over during the war to London at the request of a Dr. Gonin, who was then Physician Royal—physician to the Royal Family. Because World War II was in progress, Dr. Gonin was unfortunately never able to work with the scope. When he died shortly after the war, nobody was interested in taking up where he left off. So that Rife microscope stands in the Welcome foundation, inert and unused.)

Rife, looking in his microscope, found that living things in fact were pleiomorphic and not only were they pleiomorphic, but they were drastically so, depending on the "terrain" as Claude Bernard had it—and, by the way, Pasteur's last words were supposed to have been: "Claude Bernard is right: The microbe is nothing, the terrain is everything." Meaning that, depending on the terrain, depending on the metabolic condition, depending on the internal state, the chemical or biochemical state of the body, a given microbe could alter its form and its function and become something else. Rife posited that much disease was not caused by the microorganisms but that the microorganisms were caused by, or perhaps better said, associated with, the disease.

He could *see* this at the microscope! For instance, he could see a bacterial form going through several successive stages to become a levurid form (yeast) or a fungus. Having invented the scope and come up with a new theory, he next reasoned that if he could illuminate a microor-

ganism with a single frequency and cause it to resonate, then he should be able to turn that principle around and find some electromagnetic frequencies which could be radiated into living organisms to cause the disappearance of those organisms which are associated with disease. And that is what he did!

He had the backing in his day—this was in the 1930's—of such eminent people as Kendall, a professor of pathology at Northwestern University; Millbank Johnson, M.D., was on his board, along with many other medical men, when he began to treat people with this new "ray emitter." What happened next is very strange. (There were articles written on the Rife technique up to the point I've described it in the Journal for the Medical Society of California and other medical journals.)

Suddenly, Rife came under the glassy eye of Morris Fishbein of the AMA and things began to happen very quickly. Rife was put on trial for having invented a "phony" medical cure. The trial lasted a long time. And Rife, being a very sensitive individual—he was a man who could sit in one position for 72 hours looking into a microscope until he got it in focus—couldn't take the pressure of the rank injustice and the trial broke his health to the point that he became so nervous that he couldn't function. Seeking to overcome that nervousness, he consulted a physician, who told him that every time he felt nervous, he should take a couple of drams of brandy. He became a lifelong alcoholic and died as such, never really accomplishing much in the last part of his life. He died in 1972.

Wilhelm Reich

I had also followed the life and work of Dr. Wilhelm Reich, a very interesting research pioneer who went from being Sigmund Freud's first assistant to dabbling in biophysics at an advanced level. He had involved himself in microscopy and discovered some consummately interesting things about living organisms which were also very controversial. A book about what he found at the microscope, called The Bions, was panned by every pundit who reviewed it. The only reason we're mentioning it here is that as he was working at the microscope he discovered various anomalous forms. At one point, Peter Thompkins invited me to work with him on a biography of Wilhelm Reich, which we didn't go on to do because Reich's personal papers are still under lock and key and we couldn't get access to them. They have been impounded for 50 years in the trust which was set up after he died.

During that period, I got to know Reich's daughter, Eva Reich, who was herself a doctor of medicine. She was cursing the day that she dropped the ball when her father died and, instead of becoming the trustee of his estate, allowed it to pass into the hands of another person who became the sole trustee. She wanted to go to court to see if she could break the trust so that her father's private archives could be made public. We waited to see if that could happen. Well, years went by and it didn't.

At any rate, in the summer of 1979 I was driving down

the Maine coast with my wife and I knew Eva Reich had a little house in Hancock, Maine, where she spent a good deal of time. So we went over to see if she was there. She gave us each a bowl of soup and said: "Bird, I know you're interested in microscopes because I've read the fabulous article in the *New Age Journal* about Rife, whom I'd never heard of, and I know that you studied in detail all the work that my father did at the microscope. I want to tell you that there is another extraordinary microscope up in the woods in Canada that you ought to look into."

So in the fall of 1979, I went up to those Canadian woods. There, in a tiny village outside Sherbrooke, which itself is a provincial city about a half-hour drive from the top of Vermont, was an extraordinary man.

Gaston Naessens

Gaston Naessens is a Frenchman who, at the age of 26, invented a microscope which could do nearly as well as Rife's! I really can't describe it except to say that it combined various aspects of electromagnetics, magnetic fields, and optics that allow this microscope to look at cells at up to 30,000X magnification with excellent resolution—routinely so at 3,000X, which is about 1,000 times more than can be achieved in any laboratory, at least until recently.

Naessens, I discovered, had invented this scope in 1948 and as a result of his being able to see living things at these magnifications, he discovered that there was an ultramicroscopic, sub-cellular organism in the blood of all living things, incuding the sap of plants! This organism he called a somatide and it was 2 to 3 angstroms in dimension. I can't appreciate how small that is, so I'm just giving you the dimension. This ultramicroscopic form could be cultured in vitro and it reproduced just like a cell. As long as the body it inhabited was in a healthy state, metabolically speaking, it went through a three-stage growth cycle from a tiny particle, let's say, to a tiny spore, to a tiny double spore, and back again.

But, when the body gets into a metabolically imbalanced state, this same form goes through a 16-stage cycle and, depending on how this form behaves in the early stages with reference to other blood figures (red cells, lymphocytes), which can be clearly seen in the microscope in a few seconds from a drop of blood drawn from a subject's finger—depending on that behavior, Monsieur Naessens can pre-diagnose degenerative disease states including a pre-cancerous state, two to three years before there are any clinical signs in the host.

While still in France, Monsieur Naessens went on to develop a *serum* which was very successful in curing various forms of advanced and, in some cases terminal, cancer. Partly because he had no degrees of any kind (in fact, he had only finished high school), he came to the attention of the French medical authorities and was put on trial before a Juge d'Instruction—the charge being that of practicing medicine illegally. They almost put him in jail and threw away the key! But just before that happened, a high official in the Sûreté National (The French National Police) came

to him and said: "You must get out of France, now, today—this evening—for it looks to me that you are to be 'railroaded' into jail."

It wasn't a *trial* in our legal sense of that word. It was more like a grand jury hearing—a special type of trial held before a judge. This trial, before which dozens of "expert" scientific witnesses had testified, had gone on for several months. Things looked so bad that the police official advised Naessens to go immediately to the international aerodrome at Orly and leave by plane for England. Monsieur Naessens looked at his watch and said: "I will never make it with the traffic." The police official replied: "We will hold the plane on the ground for you." And that is how he was exiled from his country.

Why had that police official acted to help him? Because Monsieur Naessens had cured that same official's wife of terminal cancer. She was still alive a few years ago!

Monsieur Naessens then came to Canada and got the covert backing of David M. Stewart, who ran one of the largest medical foundations in that country—the MacDonald-Stewart Foundation. Because his work was so unconventional, Mr. Stewart suggested that he work quietly, not in Montreal, but in the hustings. There, over the next twenty years, Gaston Naessens went on to invent another product to replace the serum which was very costly and difficult to make. He developed a product based on the camphor molecule. This molecule went into making an inexpensive liquid product, costing only about 80 cents a vial, which is injected into the lymph node in the groin. It does something to right, to enhance, to bring back to equilibrium the *immune defense system*.

Naessens had seen that most degenerative disease is as much a problem connected to immunity as to anything else. When this immune defense system is brought back into balance, the body can shed cancers of all forms; can shed rheumatoid arthritis, can shed cases of lupus; can shed, in some cases, multiple sclerosis (MS)—and I am talking about one case that I know personally. A dental surgeon (a friend of mine for thirty years) who hadn't been out of a wheelchair in two years, after being injected intralymphatically with the product 21 days, was walking around a table, holding the table in the middle.

After twenty years of working quietly to achieve these results in Canada, the provincial medical authorities of Quebec came to his house and seized nearly all of his dossiers. He has now moved his treatment clinic to Haiti, becoming another in a long line of medical martyrs. Naessens may have to stand trial a second time in a second country.

Antoine Prioré

I will tell you about one more person—still another self-taught genius, Antoine Prioré, who began working in 1944-45, right after the war, to develop an electromagnetic device which cured cancer. He got the backing of some very interesting and courageous people, including the world-famous immunologist Dr. Raymond Pautrizel, of the University of Bordeaux II, who did all the animal work.

When Dr. Pautrizel arrived on the scene, because the emotional atmosphere surrounding the cancer cure was so great, he decided to take the research in another direction and began to use the machine to treat what he knew best, which was sleeping sickness in animals. Sleeping sickness was of primary concern to Dr. Pautrizel because it is a widespread affliction in tropical countries and, perhaps because he was born and raised in Guadeloupe in the Caribbean, he had become very interested in tropical medicine. When he injected rabbits with the pathogen trypansome, which causes sleeping sickness, the trypanosome would multiply until there were billions of them circulating in the bloodstream and the rabbits would uniformly all die within 72 hours. But, when exposed to the radiation of the Prioré device, these same rabbits would live. Yet their blood was still teeming with the trypanosomes, which could be extracted from the radiated rabbits and injected into other control rabbits, which would then die.

This implies that the machine was doing something electromagnetically to the immune system of the rabbits such that they were able to fight off a lethal disease which would normally kill them in 72 hours!

Had it not been for the courage of Dr. Robert Courrier, who at that time was Perpetual Secretary of the Academy of Sciences of France, in the face of great criticism, the scientific data on 20 years of that work might never have been published. Time after time, over 20 years or more, Dr. Courrier personally introduced the papers for publication in the *Comptes Rendues* (Proceedings) of the French Academy of Sciences. There are 28 such papers. Even this could not prevent Dr. Pautrizel from nearly being fired from his post at the University of Bordeaux II, where he finally treated human patients successfully with the Prioré device.

When he wrote a paper and sent it this time to the Academy of Medicine, it was refused without explanation. Pautrizel then wrote a long letter, since made public, to the governing offices of the French Academy of Medicine to find out why the paper had been refused and which people on the jury refused it, so that he could consult with them in order to better inform them of the facts. For 3 ½ years he received no reply.

So then he decided to step outside of normal scientific channels and offered his story to a journalist who wrote an extraordinary book called *The Dossier Prioré*, A Second Affaire Pasteur? Because the book has not been translated from French, and may not be (because it was written for a French audience and should really be rewritten in English) it is not accessible to English readers. But I have written a 50-page paper which is a synopsis of it.

We have discussed the cases of four intrepid researchers. Of these, three had no formal academic training—Prioré, Naessens and Rife—and yet they went on to develop the most extraordinary medical tools in energy medicine that I think exist. Two of them were put to trial! One was nearly fired from his position. All this is moving and largely unknown medical history and all of it affords real opportunities for further exciting research.

The Biological Significance of Water Structured with Non-Hertzian Time-Reversed Waves

T. A. Gagnon and G. Rein, Ph.D.

CONTEMPORARY quantum physics has mathematically described and predicted the presence of a new kind of unified energy which underlies conventional transverse electromagnetic (EM) vectors. The concept of a subtle energy underlying EM fields was first introduced by Bohm and Aharonov¹ in describing quantum potentials as an implicate order "embedded in" our normal 3-D space. It has recently been proposed that an additional implicate order is embedded within the quantum potentials. This higher dimensional space is composed of an energy which has been called time-reversed waves,2 non-Hertzian waves,34 longitudinal waves,5 scalar waves,² or zero-point energy.⁶ Although non-Hertzian waves (NHW) can not be measured by conventional EM detectors, several devices have been built which should theoretically generate them. The idea that NHW may have some biomedical applications was first suggested by Puharich and is supported by the recent findings that living systems are nonlinear7 and self-organizing.8 Several anecdotal reports indicate that NHW reduce stress and may improve clinical symptoms in a variety of diseases. More scientific studies indicate that the NHW generated from the Teslar watch enhance EEG brain waves,9 alters neurotransmitter function,3 and enhance lymphocyte proliferation in vitro.4 The results of these studies indicate that living systems are affected by NHW and, at least in vitro, NHW are approximately 3-fold more biologically active than corresponding transverse EM vectors.

Bearden² has proposed a theory based on: a. Popp's observation that biophotons can be stored in DNA;¹⁰ and b. Puharich's theory that NHW originate from quarks within protons in the nucleus.¹¹ According to Bearden, each cell has a biopotential in its nucleus which is composed of NHW. The biopotentials are scalar charged patterns which form a virtual substructure. Rein^{12, 13} has extended these ideas and proposed that NHW transmit information throughout the body via a complex extracellular lattice network composed of water and helical proteins like collagen. This subtle energy body could therefore regulate endogenous self-healing mechanisms.

An extension of these ideas is presented here as the Intramolecular Matrix Theory. In addition to NHW interactions between protons of different molecules (Puharich), proton-electron interactions are proposed to be a source of NHW. These interactions, which can occur within each atom or between individual atoms, form a non-Hertzian information lattice which is unique for each molecule. Energy is stored as information at the interaction areas. The information in the lattice in turn forms the energy matrix of the molecule which

is the energetic blueprint for the physical/chemical properties of the molecule. According to Bohm's language, the information lattice is embedded in the energy matrix which is embedded in the physical structure.

The Intramolecular Matrix Theory predicts that specific exogenous NHW with amplitude and frequency envelopes corresponding to those in the internal information lattice can be used to modify the matrix. Matrix modification is accomplished by overlaying the exogenous signal characteristics onto the energy storage banks in the information lattice. This technique is analogous to frequency modulation of EM vector carriers. In Bearden's terminology, the exogenous envelopes charge or polarize the cell's biopotential with a structured pattern.

The purpose of this study was to test the Intramolecular Matrix Theory by intentionally emulating the internal information matrix of a molecule with a known biological function and directly comparing the biological effects of the NHW-emulated molecule matrix with the actual chemical molecule. In addition, we attempted to manipulate the information of the NHW-emulated molecule matrix with another set of NHW envelopes which was predetermined to either neutralize or inhibit the original information from the molecule.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

1. Biological Methods: Lymphocyte proliferation was chosen as the biological endpoint since this system is known to respond to weak low frequency transverse EM vectors 14,15 and Rein has shown that the system also responds to the subtle energies of homeopathic aconite imprinted into water. 16 Cell proliferation was monitored using a highly quantitative, stateof-the art radiometric assay involving the incorporation of (3H)-thymidine into replicating DNA. The assay has been described in detail elsewhere.17 At the initiation of each experiment, 35mm petri dishes containing 1 x 105 cells and 1.0μCi/ml (³H)-thymidine were exposed to: 1. the NHW coil, 2. a growth medium made from water which had been previously exposed to the NHW coil, 3. Interleukin-2 (IL-2) (25U/ ml) or homeopathic aconite (40ul, 200X), or 4. a combination of IL-2 or aconite and the NHW envelope frequencies. Cells which were directly exposed to the NHW coil, received four 15-minute treatments during the 12-hour stimulation period. The cells were then returned to the CO2 incubator for a 12-hour rest period.


For direct treatment of the water, 1000ml samples of spring water from Alhambra in a glass container were directly ex-

posed to a coil driven by 9.0ma current continuously for 24 hours. Plastic containers did not allow NHW information to be imparted to the water as effectively. The charged water samples were then used to make a standard DMEM tissue culture medium. The control medium was made simultaneously with the same batch of spring water which was not charged. The cells were exposed to this medium for the total incubation period. At the end of this period DNA synthesis was measured in all samples and counted in a spectrophotometer. The raw data is expressed as counts per minute (CPM), which represents the amount of DNA synthesis, or as percent effect. Percent effect was calculated as the difference in the raw CPM between control and experimental dishes divided by the control values and multiplied by 100.

NHW Methodology: NHW envelopes were generated using a specifically designed Caduceus-type coil (TR4) containing a complex monopolar DC square wave signal. The coil output is referred to as Structured-Electromagnetic Quotient Stimuli (S-EMQS) which has been used exclusively in equipment developed and marketed by T. A. Gagnon. The principle of the coil is to cancel the electric and magnetic vectors associated with the two currents flowing in opposite directions and to cause a helical vector to move in vertical opposition to the direction of current flow. These helical vectors are analogous to vortex rings known to occur in plasmas.18 This was accomplished with two concentric (Figure 1) anti-parallel coils in the same plane. The coils were wound with 24 gauge wire to create a non-horizontal current flow with a final value of 8.2 ohms, each coil winding being the mirror image of its counterpart. The entire transducer was then encapsulated in a non-conductive material.

The input current remained constant at 3ma for all studies involving direct stimulation of the cells. Each S-EMQS envelope was composed of several superimposed square waves varying in frequency from 2 to 6kHz.

The S-EMQS envelopes had a repetition rate of 930Hz. The interruption rate is a variable factor dependent upon the element under simulation and is not a constant. The entire envelope was then placed on a 60Hz sine wave carrier. Although 60Hz is not the optimal carrier frequency it was used to establish a point of reference for future work. Optimum carrier frequencies should be below 10Hz.



The frequencies were generated via a CP/U and downloaded into a 5-watt amplifier/mixer. The coils were directly connected to the amplifier by coax to eliminate any stray fields which might be active in the surrounding area.

The frequencies and interruption rates were predetermined for each biological application according to the prediction of the Intramolecular Matrix Theory. The choice of the appropriate NHW envelopes was based on 18 years of experience using the S-EMQS technology to affect humans and plants. Frequencies were selected by a proprietary weighted system developed by T. A. Gagnon. The individual frequencies within each S-EMQS envelope used to emulate the information lattice of aconite and IL-2 were as follows:

a) Aconite envelope consisted of:

3347Hz 5611Hz 2791Hz Interruption rate: 3.3Hz

b) Interleukin-2 envelope consisted of:

3448Hz 2929Hz 4014Hz

5611Hz 2867Hz 2855Hz 2791Hz

Interruption rate: 2.0Hz

Some frequencies were selected specific chemicals known to be necessary for the maintenance of lymphocytes in tissue culture.


RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Initial experiments were designed to emulate the internal information lattice of aconite, an herbal extract with immuno-enhancing properties. Previous research by Rein indicated that the mother tincture and serial dilutions of this herb affected the lymphocyte proliferation assay used in these experiments.16 The effect varied in magnitude and direction depending on the individual, but generally caused an increase in cell proliferation. Approximately 100% stimulation of proliferation was observed at homeopathic dilutions of 200X, well beyond Avagadro's number. Therefore the energy matrix of this molecule can be homeopathically transferred to water and cause a biological effect. The information lattice of aconite was therefore emulated using the S-EMQS technology and used for either direct stimulation of the cultured lymphocytes, or to structure medium (water) which was added to the lymphocyte culture before measuring lymphocyte proliferation.

The data is presented in Tables 1 & 2 and shown graphically in Graphs 1 & 2. The results indicate that S-EMQS-emulated aconite caused an 87% stimulation of lymphocytes when applied directly to the cells, with a similar stimulation of 53% being observed with homeopathic aconite. Therefore, the frequency information within the atomic information lattice of aconite was successfully emulated and shown to cause a similar biological effect as homeopathic aconite. When both signals were tested simultaneously, no additivity or synergism was observed. This approach is frequently used in conventional pharmacology to determine whether two drugs are working by similar or different mechanisms. The absence of additivity indicates that emulated aconite and homeopathic aconite are affecting cell proliferation by similar mechanisms.

The results in Tables 1 & 2 also indicate that the emulated frequency matrix information from aconite could be directly transferred to a medium (water) and that once charged, this medium when added to the lymphocyte culture stimulated their proliferation by 61%. The results further indicate that the magnitude of this effect was similar to that observed (87%) when the lymphocytes were directly stimulated with the S-EMQS signal. Although we are presently determining how long the frequency information will remain in the medium, preliminary studies indicate the water will remain charged for at least two weeks.

S-EMOS emulation of a second molecule which is also known to stimulate lymphocyte proliferation was then tested. Interleukin-2 (IL-2) was chosen since this growth factor is well known to stimulate lymphocyte proliferation.19 Emulation of the atomic information lattice of IL-2 using S-EMQS technology was tested by direct stimulation of the cells as described for aconite. The results in Table 3/Graph 3 indicate that emulated IL-2 caused a 20-fold increase in lymphocyte proliferation compared to a similar 20-fold increase when the actual chemical was used. The results also indicate that the biological effects of the energetic and physical stimuli were

not additive and therefore, assumedly occur by similar mechanisms.

The Intramolecular Matrix Theory was further tested by pre-determining a specific set of frequencies which were predicted to either neutralize or inhibit the NHW envelopes known to stimulate lymphocyte proliferation. This was accomplished by initially charging a medium (water) with the aconite or the IL-2 S-EMQS envelopes for 24 hours. A portion of this medium was then extracted and treated for an additional 24 hours with a neutralizing or inhibiting S-EMOS envelope. The results of these experiments are presented in Table 4 and Graph 4, where it can be seen that neutralizing frequencies caused a 46% decrease (35 to 19) for aconite and a 29% decrease (58-41) for IL-2. Inhibitory frequencies showed even more profound effects. The emulated aconite effect came down to zero and the emulated IL-2 effect decreased to -58%. These results indicate that a pre-determined set of frequencies could be predicted from the Intramolecular Matrix Theory. Either neutralization or inhibition of the growth-

EFFECT OF S-EMQS IL-2 VS. S-MEDIUM Table 3 DIRECT EXPOSURE




Lymphocyte Proliferation



stimulating effects were induced by re-structuring the matrix of the medium; a new NHW matrix envelope was embedded on the carrier for the aconite or Il-2 molecules.
