ISSN Number Granted to the United States Psychotronics Association Newsletter

The USPA is proud to announce that the International Standard Serial Number (ISSN) organization, headquartered in Paris, France, and acting through its US ISSN Center at the Library of Congress, Washington, DC, has granted an ISSN number to the **United States Psychotronics Association Newsletter**. **This ISSN is: 2473-7194**, and will be displayed on the cover of the USPA Newsletter, as well as at the bottom of the inside cover page.

ISSN numbers are not granted automatically, and an application must be made to the Library of Congress (for periodicals published in the United States). In addition, one or more samples of the periodical are required to be submitted for evaluation. The entire process usually takes many weeks, and in the case of the USPA Newsletter, our editor John H. Reed, M.D., submitted the application and samples in May, 2016, and received the ISSN number August 4, 2016.

The ISSN number is significant in that it is used extensively in the periodical publishing world and by libraries worldwide in ordering, cataloging, interlibrary loans, and other practices in connection with periodical literature. The ISSN uniquely identifies each periodical title, and is therefore, especially helpful in distinguishing between periodicals with the same or similar titles.

ISSN numbers are assigned by a network of ISSN National Centres, usually located at national libraries and coordinated by the ISSN International Centre based in Paris. The International Centre is an intergovernmental organization created in 1974 through an agreement between UNESCO and the French government. The International Centre maintains a database of all ISSNs assigned worldwide, the ISDS Register (International Serials Data System) otherwise known as the ISSN Register. At the end of 2014, the ISSN Register contained records for 1,811,110 periodical titles.

(PS: Please don't bother writing to me about the redundancy in using the phrase "ISSN number". Some may not be familiar with what the acronym stands for, and besides, I take the literary liberty to use the phrase as I see fit to enhance communication and understanding.)

Most people use Radionics in broadcast mode. Broadcast mode is fast, powerful and is a push of energy. Using broadcast the target will get the energy you push whether it is good for them or not. That is why we always check on the amount of time to broadcast, check appropriateness (GV, White Light) and insure that all cold scans are done with "harm to no one". Some people also use potentization, usually to water or oil. This is also powerful and has the advantage that it can be applied on a as-needed basis instead of on a as-available basis. Depending upon how it is used potentization could be a push or a pull of energy. If you drink the water you are absorbing all of it and you again need to follow the rules of broadcast.

There is a third way. This method directly applies the energies needed, when needed, where needed and always with harm to no one. It is like having a dedicated skilled radionics operator working 24 hours a day, 7 days a week on just one target. Any radionics operator can use this technique and the learning curve is low for existing operators. The additional costs are very low and the materials can be picked-up locally, sometimes for free.

Effect of Non-Hertzian Scalar Waves on the Immune System

THE RECENT AVAILABILITY of a scalar generator in the form of a Tesla watch has facilitated scientific research into the biological effects of this new type of non-Hertzian electromagnetic (EM) energy. The scientific rationale for conducting this type of research is discussed with respect to the non-linear nature of biological systems. Preliminary research findings are presented which indicate that scalar fields enhance the immune system, as measured by increased DNA synthesis in lymphocytes. Since this effect supersedes that observed by the EM field produced by the watch in the absence of the mobius strip, it can be concluded that scalar energy is more biologically active than traditional linear EM fields, at least in this system.

Introduction

Although numerous studies indicate the biological significance of linear, transverse EM and acoustic waves, relatively little is known about the role of non-linear, non-Hertzian waves in biological systems. Such a role for non-Hertzian waves is likely since recent quantum mechanical analyses of biological processes has revealed their inherent non-linearity.1 Thus, contrary to traditional thermodynamic theories, biochemical reactions can occur far from equilibrium and are not always dispersive and degenerative. Based on non-linear mathematical analyses of Maxwell's electromagnetic (EM) equations, quantum mechanical models have been developed which describe subatomic quasi-particles like exitons and plasmons,² and solitons.1 Recently it has been proposed that these quantum particles store and carry biological information along helical macromolecules like DNA.3 It has also been suggested that they are generated and propagated along helical proteins in the cell membrane in response to weak transverse EM radiation in the visible and extremely low frequency⁵ spectrum.

Since at least some of these quasi-particles can propagate in silicon dioxide crystal lattices,² the author has previously proposed in the Crystalline Transduction Theory ⁶—a bidirectional transduction of non-Hertzian waves to transverse EM waves by liquid crystals in the cell membrane. It is also likely that non-Hertzian waves propagate throughout the body via the crystalline lattices of the elaborate collagen network comprising the extracellular space.⁷ These results suggest a new non-linear

regulatory network in the body with properties best described by quantum physics. Although the relationship between this new network and the endogenous linear EM fields in the body (both pulsating and stationary) is unknown, theoretically non-linear waves can couple to, and interact with, transverse EM fields.

Since linear EM fields are known to affect biological systems, it is likely that non-linear fields will be similarly, if not more, biologically active. Indeed non-linear irregularities in square wave pulses generate EM fields which are usually more biologically active than purely symmetrical fields. Other wave forms exhibiting non-linear properties include non-Hertzian scalar potentials. Scalars, mathematically described in the original Maxwellian EM equations, are the electric and magnetic components comprising transverse EM vectors. Since scalars (but not transverse EM vectors) exist in 5-dimensional space/time they do not decay with time or distance from their source and have other unusual quantum properties.8 Although scalars have not been considered by the biological community, they are well known in astrophysics, geology, and hydrodynamics. They were first utilized by Nikola Tesla at the turn of the century when he demonstrated wireless transmission of electricity without a loss of energy.9

Biological research with scalars has recently been prompted by the availability of a scalar generator. Dr. Andrija Puharich first utilized a mobius loop to cancel the EM fields generated from an ordinary digital wrist watch. The analog Tesla watch marketed by ELF Cocoon International has been shown radionically to generate scalar fields, although it is unclear whether this also applies to the original digital watches. In addition to the numerous case reports from people wearing the Tesla watch, scientific studies are beginning using the watch as a source of scalar energy. The watch has a unique advantage for scientific studies since it is possible to remove the mobius loop, thereby generating the EM carrier in the absence of the scalar wave. Dr. Eldon Byrd has shown that wearing the analog Tesla watch increases the amplitude of the EEG recordings, particularly in the low frequency range.¹⁰ Dr. Persinger was first to utilize cells in vitro to study the action of scalar fields on mast cell degranulation.11 Scalar fields were generated by partially cancelling two polarized magnetic fields (0.5Hz, 10μT) by intersecting them in air. Dr. Puharich has organized a study at the Max Planck Institute in Germany where they have shown that *E. coli* microorganisms exposed to 8.00Hz scalar fields have increased activity of the RAD-6 gene which codes for proteins involved in DNA repair.¹² The author has also utilized the in vitro approach to show that the scalar fields generated from the analog watch inhibit neurotransmitter uptake into nerve cells¹³ via the same mechanism as tricyclic antidepressants.

Materials and Methods

Using standard laboratory procedures,¹⁴ a mixed lymphocyte fraction was isolated from whole blood, obtained from three healthy volunteers, within 24 hours after being drawn. The procedure involves layering the blood onto a Histopacque (Sigma Chemical Co.) centrifugation gradient and isolating the mononuclear cell population from the interface. Monocytes were then removed by differential plating onto plastic petri dishes. The mixed lymphocyte fraction was then layered onto a second Histopacque gradient to remove dead cells and debris. The resultant fraction is a purified mixture of T and B lymphocytes.

The lymphocytes were plated onto 35mm plastic petri dishes at a seeding density of 1 x 10⁵ cells and incubated at 37°C with 1.0 µCi/ml (3H)-thymidine (93 Ci/ mmole, Amersham Corp.) for 48 hours in a standard carbon dioxide (5%) incubator. Control dishes were exposed to Tesla analog watches with the mobius strip removed. Experimental dishes were exposed to analog watches containing the mobius strip. All watches were obtained from ELF Cocoon International. A petri dish (with its cover) was placed under each watch immediately after addition of the radioactive precursor. Control and experimental dishes were placed in opposite sides of a dual incubator separated by a metal wall to minimize possible carryover effects from the scalar fields. To assess the viability of the three lymphocyte preparations, their proliferation in response to standard mitogens was determined. Cells were treated as described above, except that polkweed mitogen (50ng/ ml) was added immediately prior to the addition of thymidine.

After a 48-hour incubation at 37°C, the DNA was precipitated using 5% trichloroacetic acid and the immunoperoxidase precursor was separated from that taken up by DNA using Whatman microfiber glass filters (GF/C). The amount of thymidine incorporated into DNA was measured using a standard scintillation counter. Results are expressed as cpm/10⁵ cells. Thymidine incorporation is directly related to the rate of cell proliferation. Seven experimental dishes and six control dishes were exposed to the energy from the watch in three independent trials on three different days.

Results and Discussion

The data in Table 1 indicate that lymphocytes exposed to Tesla watches containing a mobius strip showed a 76%

increase in proliferation as compared to lymphocytes exposed to watches lacking the mobius strip (90 vs. 159 cpm/ 10^5 cells). These results indicate that the presence of an 8Hz scalar wave caused a more profound enhancement of immune function than observed by an 8Hz linear EM field. Although non-linear waves have been postulated to be more biologically active than linear EM fields, 11 this hypothesis had not been verified experimentally. These results are therefore the first to show that scalar waves are more active than EM fields, at least in the 8Hz region.

Lymphocyte proliferation in the absence of any watch or chemical mitogen corresponds to a blank value of 67 ± 20 cpm/10⁵ cells. Therefore, the EM field from control watches (no mobius strip) enhanced lymphocyte proliferation by 34%, whereas the scalar watches increased proliferation by 137% compared to blanks. Other investigators have also shown that weak EM fields can stimulate lymphocyte proliferation.15 The magnitude of their EM effect is similar to that reported here. The data in Table 1 are proliferation values obtained for the two types of watches minus blank values. The zero values indicate that the small EM effect on proliferation was not found in two out of six cases. This corresponds to clinical observations which indicate that as many as two-thirds of the population are not sensitive to EM fields. It is interesting to note that a scalar effect was observed in all cases, although the magnitude of the effect varied 8-fold in the three individuals studied. Since these are normal

individuals, it is unknown to what extent scalar fields will enhance the immune system in immunodeficient individuals.

The magnitude of the scalar effect can also be compared with chemical stimulation of the immune system with polkweed mitogen. This mitogen stimulated the lymphocytes used in this study by 149% compared with blanks. Thus the scalar waves enhanced the immune function to approximately the same degree as was obtained with standard chemical stimulation. This indicates the profound influence the scalar waves have on lymphocyte proliferation in vitro.

The results reported here also indicate that scalar energy can directly affect the cells of the immune system. Similar results were reported by the author who observed direct effects of scalar waves on nerve cells in vitro.13 The use of tissue culture techniques in these and other experiments, indicates that scalar fields can have direct effects at the cellular level independent of psychosomatic effects mediated by the mind. However, it is still possible that scalar waves will also affect the mind, and may explain some of the physiological effects observed clinically, e.g. independent of direct cellular effects. The complex relationship between mind and body is now receiving much attention and a new field of research, called psychoneuroimmunology, has emerged to address these questions.16 With respect to lymphocytes, it is now known that mental attitude and stressful life events—as well as diet, drugs, and the amount of sleep-can all inhibit lymphocyte proliferation. To further complicate the picture lymphocytes secrete chemical messengers, called cytokines, which can influence the brain. Thus the communication between the nervous and immune systems is bidirectional.

Although the scalar field generated from the Tesla watch has profound effects on lymphocyte proliferation, it should be pointed out that we do not know to what extent these or other biological effects will depend on the amplitude and frequency of the signal, as is known for EM fields. Therefore, the 8Hz signal used here may not be optimal with regards to stimulating the immune system. Whether similarly large effects will occur clinically in individuals wearing the watch is also unknown. Needless to say, this situation is far more complicated since lymphocyte proliferation will be influenced by a wide variety of biochemical,17 psychological18 and electromagnetic15 regulatory factors. It is presently unknown to what extent scalar and elecromagnetic fields interact. If scalar fields are clinically immunoenhancing, the potential exists for treating immunodeficient diseases like AIDS, cancer, Ebstein-Barr-and even flu symptoms-with scalar energy. The results presented here indicate that this

approach should be far more efficacious than using conventional linear EM fields.

Selective Destruction of Bacteria and Cancer Cells Using Modulated Ultraviolet Light

THE LITERATURE CONCERNING the use of specific frequencies to cause a biological effect is filled with a number of untested or unverified assumptions.

- All resonant frequencies are constant with time.
- Precision of frequencies need to be accurate to the nearest 1 Hz.
- 3. The shape or the waveform does not change upon application to the skin.
- A cookbook approach to time and intensity of exposure is sufficient to overcome most illness.
- 5. Little or no individual variability exists.
- Application of a single frequency at a time is sufficient to achieve the desired results.
- Exposure of cells and microorganisms to specific frequencies causes the cell to immediately disintegrate.

Our experimentation with this technology has shown that all of these assumptions are, at best, questionable. My laboratory has been experimenting with a prototype system based upon the modulation of ultraviolet light with specific frequencies and waveforms. The effect of this energy has been tested on a variety of microorganisms and tissue culture lines of tumor cells to examine the effects of this technology.

This report will concentrate on providing background information on the use of information modulated, randomly modulated and conventional ultraviolet light. In addition, the relationship of these factors to conventional photochemistry and the use of specific combinations of frequencies will be explored.

The portion of the electromagnetic spectrum with wavelengths between 180 and 400 nm is referred to as ultraviolet radiation (UV). UV is defined as that portion of the electromagnetic spectrum which lies between violet light and soft X-rays. UV is traditionally divided into three ranges of wavelengths: UV-A (near UV, 320-400nm), UV-B (290-320nm), and UV-C (far UV, 190-280nm).

The public and the scientific community have been concerned about potential hazards of ultraviolet light. Recommendations of the advertising and medical community suggest th UV light is "dangerous" and should be avoided at all costs. Yet all life forms on earth evolved un-

der the influence of UV rays from the sun. The relationship between UV and human health and well-being is relatively complex. Although overexposure to UV-A and -B can be harmful, some exposure may be required for well-being. Here we shall explore the scientific information concerning UV, its effects on living organisms and tissue, and potential applications of UV.

Types of UV

It would be a gross simplification to assume that the biological or chemical effect of all wavelengths in the UV spectrum are similar. The differences in the physical and biological activity of individual wavelengths are at least as great as their similarities. Lumping the effects of all wavelengths of UV together is similar to lumping together all wavelengths of visible light, rather than differentiating between all the colors of the rainbow. Furthermore, the specific wavelength of UV appears to be much more important than the absolute amount of energy. For example, to cause erythema or sunburn requires doses of UV-A 800–1000 times greater than UV-B.

Artificial Production of UV

The most common method of generating UV is by passing an electric current through special glass tubes containing ionized low-pressure mercury vapor. Most of the energy of the UV is emitted within two narrow energy windows at 254nm and 185nm. Germicidal lamps and ordinary fluorescent lamps are similar. However, the germicidal lamp is made of special glass which allows the UV light to pass through while the interior surface of fluorescent lamps are coated with a phosphor which converts UV to visible light.

Photochemistry and Light Energy

A basic law of photochemistry states that light cannot cause a reaction unless a photon of energy is absorbed. The effects of the wavelength of light versus the biological or chemical effects is called the action spectra. Each molecule can be characterized spectroscopically by its absorption spectrum. Specific wavelengths of UV are differentially

absorbed by specific molecules, and the interaction of the effects of such wavelengths may be quite complex.

Biological Action

There is a common belief that non-ionizing radiation, such as UV, cannot have profound effects on biological molecules (except for heating and sunburning). Yet, increasing molecular motion requires far less energy than does ionization. The consequences of such irradiation can lead to heating of tissues, depolarization of cell membranes, dielectrophoresis, piezoelectric induced mechanical stress and dielectric saturation, partial orientation of permanent dipoles, counter-ion polarization, orientation of the polar side chains of molecules, and altered ionic conduction through the intra- and extracellular fluids.

Pulsed UV

When UV radiation is pulsed, the biological effects differ depending on the presence of ambient light. If a dark period follows a pulse of UV, the thermal reactions producing biological alterations are more intense. Exposure to visible light immediately following UV irradiation may reduce the damage by reactivating the bio-synthetic processes necessary for growth and cell division.

There is a basic difference between continuous wave and pulsed energy. Although the energy deposited in both systems may be similar (same time-averaged power and frequency), pulsed radiation is absorbed more strongly than continuous wave. Apparently, this difference is due to a different time course of energy generation and dissipation of energy. These effects often occur at power levels far below that required to cause thermal effects. Such effects have been reported throughout the electromagnetic spectrum

and may effect systems as diverse as brain chemistry, lymphocyte count, and even cause behavioral changes.


If the pulse repetition rate of an external magnetic field or UV lamp is tuned to match exactly the beat frequency of a biological system, then that system may resonate with the pulsations of that external magnetic field. If the external field approximates an intrinsic rhythm, simple additive resonance or simple amplitude constructive interference can occur.

Modulated Ultraviolet

Ultraviolet light can be used as an efficient method of coupling electromagnetic energy to a biological system. Even in conventional UV lights, the AC power line frequency modulates cyclic information (mainly harmonics of 60 Hz) onto the UV output. Sympathetic vibratory coupling of modulated UV may occur when the modulation frequency approximates a natural frequency of the target. Such excitation is reinforced by repetition with identical or related waveforms.

The resonant interaction of energy effects are nonlinear; the effects on biological systems depends upon the modulated information. Many of these resonant effects occur in specific frequency and amplitude windows. Much of the confusion about such nonlinear resonance effects can be attributed to poor documentation of such physical variables as amplitude, phase relationships, bandwidth, pulse duration rate, shape and frequency of the energy used, as well as the biological systems and assays.

According to Faraday's Law of magnetic induction, the effects of time-varying fields are dependent on the waveform and frequency of the applied energy. This effect occurs throughout the electromagnetic spectrum including modu-






Figure 2. Survival of Salmonella after exposure to the modulated UV at a distance of 9" for 15–120 sec. Survival was measured by the growth of clonal colonies from the surviving bacteria. Virtually no killing of these bacteria occurs in the same time interval when conventional UV is used at the same power level.

lated UV. For example, a square wave having a very slow pulse repetition rate can have a rise/fall time of 1/1,000,000 of a second. In contrast, a sine wave of the same frequency will have a rise or fall time a few hundred times longer than that of a square wave. As a result, the current density induced in tissue by pulsed fields or square waves may be several orders of magnitude more intense than the current density arising from a sine wave of the same frequency.

All forms of matter have mechanical, acoustic, and electromagnetic vibratory frequencies. These frequencies are due to physical properties of the target including size, shape and density. Two self-oscillating systems quickly become synchronized provided the difference between their frequencies is small. An external field oscillating at the proper frequency can drive atoms, molecules, organelles, cells, tissues, organs and even whole organism into sympathetic resonance. Such entrainment may trigger a sequence of events involving possible piezoelectric induction of motion or molecular conformational change, altered rates of cellular, enzymatic, or organic processes, altered chemical processes, or overall changes in the organism.

Research Results

A UV-C light was modulated with a computer-synthesized chord of six individual frequencies. The overtones of these fundamental frequencies extended into the microwave region. Over 90 percent of the spectral energy was within the UV-C band (less than 290 nm) with major lines at 253.8 nm, 184.9 nm, and 270 nm. The remaining energy was dispersed throughout longer (30 cm – 1 mm) wavelengths. The UV-C output of the system was amplitude, phase, and frequency modulated with 40 watts pulsed UV-C power (equivalent to 6 watts continuous power). The

UV-C produced was measured with a research-grade Radiometer/Photometer.

The bacteria were grown in trypticase soy broth (TSB) on a shaker oscillating at 30 RPM. Cultures were grown to log phase and diluted serially for quantitation. Cultures of 0.1 ml of 106 to 107 bacteria/ml were spread evenly on trypticase soy agar plates (TSA) such that 100 colonies correspond to ~105 bacteria. The bacterial monolayer was exposed to the UV-C generated with the two major variables being time and distance. All experiments were performed in duplicate and after incubation at 35°C for 24 hrs. the plates were scored with a colony counter.

A randomly chosen (null) waveform was included in the unit to serve as an ultraviolet exposure control. This null waveform produced the identical photon flux with the same intensity and duty cycle (pulsed with an alternating 1 sec. on, 1 sec. off cycle), but did not have the specific waveforms that enhances the lethal effectiveness in bacteria.

We found that the modulated UV-C emission from this lamp was lethal to several strains of bacteria associated with opportunistic infections at much lower energy fluxes than conventional UV-C lamps. Escherichia coli, Staphylococcus aureus, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Serratia marcescens, Staphylococcus epidermidis, and six strains of Salmonella were irradiated with modulated UV-C light. After incubation, most strains produced 90% fewer colonies at 1.5 J/m² and 98% fewer colonies at 4.4 J/m². The bactericidal effectiveness is limited to areas directly exposed to the UV and can be eliminated by shielding with aluminum foil, paper, or cloth. Exposure of these bacteria to an equivalent dose of UV which was not modulated with the bactericidal waveform was at least 3 orders of magnitude

less effective in killing bacteria. The effectiveness of the modulated UV-C is estimated to be between 103 and 105 times greater than normal UV lamps in their germicidal action at a given UV dose. Electron microscopic studies showed that treated bacteria were not immediately destroyed by the UV-C; rather, they appeared morphologically similar to untreated bacteria at 4 hrs. post-irradiation.

A series of *in vitro* experiments were performed on human dorsal forearm fibroblasts and a human adenocarcinoma breast tumor cell line (ATCC HTB-30). Viability was assayed using fluorescent vital stains which measures the integrity of the plasma membrane of individual cells. All results were confirmed using clonal assays for viability. Examination of fluorescent labelled fibroblast cells, either immediately or 4 hrs. after treatment showed no membrane-damaged, red-fluorescing cells for either control or treated cells. Further treatment with acridine orange (AO) stained all nuclei green, indicating the cell membrane was intact. From day 1 to day 7 post exposure an increasing percentages of cells with damaged cell membranes was observed. The percentages of detached cells also increased.

The differences between the null treatment and the resonant waveforms treatment were apparent with the HTB-30 tumor cells where ~ 9 J/m² and <3 J/m², respectively, were required for a 90% kill rate. In previous reports, UV-C doses of ~ 30 J/m² were required for 90% kill as determined by colony-forming techniques. Thus, fluences of information-encoded UV are <10% of the fluence required with conventional, non-pulsed, non-modulated UV-C germicidal lights.

Lethal UV irradiation induces a lag phase prior to the first post-irradiation division and a period of stasis which occurs 1 to 2 division cycles post-irradiation before the cells die. This was evident with our vitally stained cells. Few cells had irreversibly damaged membranes at 0 or 4 hrs. post-irradiation, but the number of stained (nonviable) cells increased with time.

Conclusions

The studies were designed to evaluate and document the concept and effectiveness of pulsed modulated UV light waveforms in a series of *in vitro* experiments. Exposure of six different strains of bacterial cultures which are common causes of infection for 1.5 minutes at a distance under one foot resulted in the number of viable bacteria being decreased by at least six orders of magnitude. Exposure of these bacteria to an equivalent amount of UV light which did not have the same bactericidal waveform encoded was far less effective in killing bacteria. These same waveforms increased the rate of killing of a tumor cell line by approximately 1.5 orders of magnitude compared to conventional UV.

Specific wavelengths and waveforms dramatically increase the effectiveness by resonant interaction with a target molecule. Apparently, the resonance causes oscillations of target molecules which results in a selective destruction or inactivation of the target molecules. This effect may be

further amplified by exposure to additional resonant waveforms, which simultaneously or in close succession act on the excited state of target molecules.

Rife, Rupert Sheldrake, Nikola Tesla, Marcel Vogel, and others.

Some of the forces, fields, waves, and energies studied and researched in psychotronics include: bioelectromagnetism, biophotons, biopotentials, electromagnetic wave pollution and harmful effects; coherent emanations of DNA, emanations of matter, "free energy", morphogenetic fields, non-hertzian waves, orgone energy, pyramid energy and power, qi (chi), quantum fields, scalar waves, subtle energies, ultra-weak radiation of living matter, zero-point energy, and others.
