

This is a new "column" or section of the USPA Newsletter, and will be an ongoing part of every issue, with the purpose of helping the USPA, as well as, our members and research associates locate people, organizations, periodicals, books, artifacts, collections, and other items that have seemingly disappeared, or have been extremely difficult to find. Updates will be added, and each missing item will be retained in future issues until it is found or otherwise resolved, since some readers may not have seen prior issues of the USPA Newsletter or the original notice of the missing item.

In addition, this will also serve as a "People Locator Service" to help find authors and researchers on psychotronics, radionics, subtle energies, energy medicine, and related subjects, who have "disappeared" or have died long ago, and whose relatives you may be trying to find in order to preserve the research papers and collection of that person.

In our research and reading, we all have encountered people, organizations, periodicals, books, articles, or other things that we have tried to find, and some people have searched for years to find something, but have not yet found it, despite the vast resources of the Internet. However, with our large USPA membership, we can all help one another find what we have been searching for. Some of you may have experience in genealogical research, or private investigation, law enforcement, or even intelligence work which you could utilize to help each other, or perhaps just make suggestions on how or where to search for something.

Missing People, and Updates:

We are trying to track down some of the original directors and officers of the United States Psychotronics Association (USPA), when it was organized in 1975, with the word "Radionics" in the organization title. Does anyone have any information on the current whereabouts of the following people, or family members, if the person is known to have passed away, or where they passed away?? Please check Ancestry.com, social media websites, newspaper archives, and any other databases you have to help find these people.

- 1. Dr. Marcel Vogel and his Research Papers: Does anyone know what became of the papers and files of Dr. Marcel Vogel, who died in 1991? Dr. Vogel did extensive research on crystals and crystal healing, pyramid power, the "Backster Effect" involving plants and their bioenergetic fields, and a number of other psychotronics related subjects. He also spoke numerous times at USPA conferences. Marcel Vogel worked at IBM for 27 years and had 32 patents. If you have any knowledge about Marcel Vogel and what became of his papers and files after he died, please write to your editor at: joreed43@gmail.com. The USPA would like to make sure that all of his papers are preserved.
- 2. Colonel I. B. Clark, a Director of the USPA in the first two years of its existence in 1975-1976, and then second Vice President in 1977. Update: USPA Board Member, Scott Beutlich, sent information telling that in 1973 Colonel Clark's address was P.O. Drawer One, Marble Falls, Texas 78654. At that time, he operated a radiesthesia and radionics locating service. A 1958 newspaper article also stated that Col. I. B. Clark, was head of Clark Enterprises of Cedar Hill, Texas (a city South of Dallas on Highway 67. At that time Col. Clark was in the ranching business and raises hogs, sheep and cattle. If any of you have access to Ancestry.com, perhaps you could find a listing for him or his relatives.
- **3. Dr. Otha Wingo**, Original USPA Board Director, 1975-1977; Update: A researcher provided information that Ortha Wingo's full name is Elvis Ortha Wingo, and currently
- **4. Paul Sauvin**, USPA 2nd Vice Pes., 1976 and 1st Vice Pres., 1977
- **5.. Henry Nagorka**, USPA 1st Vice Pres., 1975 and 1976, and then President, of the USPA in 1977.

Missing Pages of a Book

The book, Relationship Between Parapsychology and Gravity, Vol. 3 of Handbook of Unusual Energies, by J.G. Gallimore, was published by Borderland Sciences in the 1970's, although the date of publication and copyright date were not noted in this book. The USPA has this book in its library, and plans to republish it for the Gallimore family, but unfortunately, pages 208 and 209 are missing from the printed book. It appears that this is a publisher printing error, because page 210 is printed on the back side of page 207. However, it is possible that pages 208 and 209 were missing from the manuscript when it was sent to Borderlands for publication. Or these pages of the manuscript may have been inadvertently lost by the publisher, or possibly they were intentionally removed by someone from the manuscript prior to publication.

Do any of you have a copy of this book, and if so, would you please check to see if it has pages 208 and 209? I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the books and monograph holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere in the

Missing Organizations:

1. International Association for Psychotronic Research (IAPR): Does anyone know what became of the International Association for Psychotronic Research? And do any of you have copies of its meeting proceedings or newsletter, if such a newsletter were published? It was founded in 1973, even before the United States Psychotronic Association (USPA), which was founded in 1975. However, the current location or activities of the IAPR are unknown.

The IAPR held numerous international conferences around the world, beginning with its first in 1974 in Prague, then Czechoslovakia. At this conference, Dr. Zdenek Rejdak was elected president for the Eastern Division of the IAPR, and Dr. Stanley Krippner was elected president for the West. The 8th International Conference on Psychotronic Research was held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 1993, as a joint conference with the United States Psychotronics Association (USPA), but it is unknown if any subsequent conferences of the IAPR were held.

Proceedings of each of these conferences were published. If copies of these proceedings can be obtained, or any newsletters that it may have published, we will add them to the USPA Library and make them available to USPA members. 2. International Radionics Association (IRA): Does anyone know anything about the International Radionics Association (IRA), which was located in Springfield, Missouri in the late 1940s. This is known, because a book called The Truth about Radionics was published in 1947 by this organization, and although the author's name is anonymous, it is highly probable that the author was T. Galen Hieronymus, who passed away many years ago.

I checked several newspaper databases, and references to this organization were found in the press as far back as the early 1930s, and as late as the early 1960s, but nothing more recent than that. If you have any knowledge about this organization, please write to the editor at: joreed43@gmail.com

Missing Periodicals:

<u>1.</u> British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics: Does anyone have any issues of The British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics. It was published in London, England, by the British Radiesthesia Association, 1953-1963. The original title was **British Journal of Radiesthesia**, published from 1953-1957. No libraries in the United States, public or university, have this journal in their collection., and only five libraries elsewhere in the world are known to have any issues at all: The British Museum Library (AKA The British Library), Oxford, Cambridge, the National Library of Scotland, and Trinity College Library, in Dublin Ireland. If you have any issues of this periodical, will you please let me know? And for our members and associates in The UK and Irelad, if you can access these periodicals at any of the above libraries, you would do a huge service for all of us if you would Xerox what issues are available and send them to me. A generous donor has offered to pay whatever expenses are involved for doing this service. We will add them to the USPA Library and make them available to researchers. 2. Journal of Scientific Controversy. This periodical was referred to on page 49 of the Vol. 1, No. 1 (Spring, 1967) issue of the INFO: The Journal of the International Fortean Organization. Someone was trying to find out about it even then, 49 years ago, and said that this journal was "formerly published in Boulder, Colorado" implying that it may have ceased publication prior to 1967, or that it moved somewhere else after being published for a period of time in Boulder. I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the periodical holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere overseas. But this title, or anything close to it does not exist in the WorldCat database, so that indicates that this periodical title is not held in any library, even special collections, which are also included in WorldCat. However, this does not mean that the periodical does not exist, since many periodicals in the psychotronics, scientific anomalies and similar fields are excluded from libraries.

Missing Books:

Rhea White and Larissa Vilenskaya wrote a book titled Parapsychology in the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe, and China: A Compendium of Information. It was supposedly published by Scarecrow Press of Metuchen, NJ, a well know publisher of reference books. This book was listed as reference work #680 on page 213 of Rhea White's book, Parapsychology: New Sources of Information, 1973-1989, also published by Scarecrow Press. I called the publisher, and they said they have never published this book, and know nothing about it. As you can see from entry #680, Rhea White noted that this book was "in press", so it may have been in a preparation stage, but the manuscript may never have been sent to Scarecrow Press.

Aganin, I have searched the WorldCat, which shows books and monograph holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere in the world. But this book title does not exist in the WorldCat database, which indicates that this book is not held in any library, even special collections, which are also included in WorldCat. Unfortunately, I was unable to ask either of the authors about this, since both have passed away.

Rhea White was a well known parapsychology researcher, so some of you may have known her or heard her speak of the missing book manuscript that she was working on. Larissa Vilenskaya was from Russia, but lived and worked in the San Francisco area, and she was a prolific researcher on Russian and Eastern European psychotronics research. Most people use Radionics in broadcast mode. Broadcast mode is fast, powerful and is a push of energy. Using broadcast the target will get the energy you push whether it is good for them or not. That is why we always check on the amount of time to broadcast, check appropriateness (GV, White Light) and insure that all cold scans are done with "harm to no one". Some people also use potentization, usually to water or oil. This is also powerful and has the advantage that it can be applied on a as-needed basis instead of on a as-available basis. Depending upon how it is used potentization could be a push or a pull of energy. If you drink the water you are absorbing all of it and you again need to follow the rules of broadcast.

There is a third way. This method directly applies the energies needed, when needed, where needed and always with harm to no one. It is like having a dedicated skilled radionics operator working 24 hours a day, 7 days a week on just one target. Any radionics operator can use this technique and the learning curve is low for existing operators. The additional costs are very low and the materials can be picked-up locally, sometimes for free.



The Evolution of Radionics and Psychotronics for Farming and Gardening, Part 1 by George Kuepper*

Introduction

This is the first in a planned series of articles to be published in the USPA Newsletter that summarize the history and evolution of radionics/psychotronics as applied to horticulture and the growing of field crops. To those who know and study radionics as a modality for human health and well-being, applications to agriculture may seem ancillary. It's true that society sets a priority on our physical and mental health by supporting a gargantuan and costly medical system and infrastructure. Sadly, however, it often focuses more on treating symptoms than on correcting (or at least admitting to) the underlying causes of disease, which include devitalized and residue-laden food, as well as environments polluted by pesticides and other contaminants from modern farming and other sources. The food we eat; the water we drink; the air we breathe; are keys to health, and the way we farm and garden has so very much to do with the quality of all three...and more. The on-going expansion of organic and local markets indicate a growing proportion of the public recognizes this as well, and they are putting their food-dollars on the line.

Radionics/Psychotronics can contribute to improvements in our food system and the wider environment in numerous ways. Two of these are obvious. First, we can use their analytical methods to assess the purity and vitality of foods in stores, farmers' markets, and on our plates. This application is already a frequent part of basic education in dowsing and radionics.

Secondly, radionics and psychotronics can be used directly in the growing of food, feed, fiber, and energy crops to increase production; suppress weeds, pests, and diseases; cut costs; reduce the pollution and contamination of soil, air, water, and food; and enhance discrimination among crops and crop varieties often developed through misguided breeding programs and objectives. By extension, we can use these radionics and dowsing modalities to assess the quality of foodstuffs arising from different systems of growing, plant breeding, and handling. This feedback can guide advancements in farming and gardening in exceptional ways.

U.K.A.C.O. and the Emergence of the Homeopathic Hypothesis

The story of modern agricultural radionics begins with the commercial enterprise called U.K.A.C.O., and its spin-offs—the Homeotronic Foundation and the Radiurgic Corporation, which operated from the late 1940s through the early 1970s.¹ The name,

U.K.A.C.O., derives from the first letters of the last names of Curtis <u>U</u>pton, William <u>K</u>nuth, and Howard <u>A</u>rmstrong—the principals of the company. Of these, Upton stands out as the main force behind the enterprise. Edward W. Russell, the author of *Report on Radionics*², which is the primary source of information on U.K.A.C.O., considered Upton the discoverer of agricultural radionics much as he recognized Albert Abrams as discoverer of radionics.

U.K.A.C.O is best remembered for its numerous successes in radionic pest control—most of which were large-scale—done on crop fields in Pennsylvania and Arizona. They employed remote broadcasting, using aerial photographs as witnesses and botanical pest control substances³ as reagents to rid crops of pest insects. The operators delimited the treated areas by drawing boundaries on the photos and/or cutting away non-target zones. This provided for "check plots," which could be compared to the treatment to assess the effectiveness of the broadcasts. Most of these treatments appear to have been very successful; numerous field results are summarized in the aforementioned *Report on Radionics*. Also included are the verbatim texts of letters of documentation and support from the Farm Bureau, which observed the field demonstrations. U.K.A.C.O. charged the growers on a per-acre basis only when treatments were successful. The cost was well below that of conventional pesticides and was of significant savings to farmers. There were many growers pleased and supportive of this work.

The re-telling of U.K.A.C.O's pest control success stories has created a narrowed perspective and obscured what may be the true nature of radionics broadcasting to field crops and how it might actually work. The mythologized image suggests that pests were attacked or "zapped," at a distance, using souped-up radionic instruments and methods. This is a seductive image for a world immersed in drones, smart bombs, and violent video games. But while this image *might* be substantially accurate, there is a less-sexy, but more plausible explanation for radionic pest suppression; one that is built on concepts common to Homeopathy, Biodynamic farming, and organic agriculture.

To begin, many Biodynamic and organic farming practitioners consider agricultural insect pests to have a specific role in nature as garbage collectors. They perceive their main function as the removal of plants that are sick, genetically-damaged, or otherwise stressed and weakened. While these growers cannot control all stress factors, they understand many of them to be *agricologenic*—caused by the way we farm. Imbalanced crop nutrition, reaction to herbicides and other pestcides, destruction of soil

profit organization whose purpose was the pursuit of the science behind agricultural radionics. The Radiurgic Corporation was another commercial venture that, in turn, emerged from the Homeotronic Foundation to again offer radionics services to growers. According to E.W. Russell, the Homeotronic Foundation was still active in 1973 when his book, *Report on Radionics*, was published.

tilth, and loss of biodiversity are among problems resulting in modern farming and gardening. Traditional Biodynamic and organic growers, therefore, look first at what they are doing in the field which might have encouraged pests to get out of control, and then correct that, if possible.

This line of thinking is well-supported by the overlapping theories of Predisposition⁴ and Trophobiosis⁵. In a most compelling example, it was discovered that stressed plants stop building proteins and begin reducing them, instead. This results in the proliferation of excess free nitrogen and amino acids in plant cells and sap. These compounds are the preferred foods of herbaceous insect pests, like aphids, which lack the enzymes to break down whole proteins into their amino acid constituents.^{6,7} Assuming this to be true, insect pests on healthy plants—being denied the digestible food that sick or stressed plants provide—need not be directly attacked either with pesticides or radionics; they will either starve in place or seek nourishment elsewhere.

This might help explain the observations by radionics pioneer Peter Kelly, as expressed in an interview from the early 1980s. In response to a question about the corporeal remains of insect pests controlled by radionic broadcasting, Peter notes that simple organisms, such as corn borers, essentially dissolve into "native materials like water and basic energy;" more complex organisms, on the other hand, "would have some remnants." This almost certainly reflects what one would likely observe under circumstances where a crop suddenly becomes unpalatable to pest insects. The larval or caterpillar (primitive) stage of moth, butterfly, beetle, and fly pests—being soft-bodied and unable to migrate to other feeding grounds, are likely to die of starvation in-place and decompose rapidly. Adult forms and those insect pests that do not pass a larval stage (e.g. true bugs), have an exoskeleton that would resist immediate degradation and leave some remains. However, such insects are also more mobile and betterequipped to move on!

Peter Tompkins and Christopher Bird hint at an alternative to the "zapping" hypothesis in their 1973 book *The Secret Life of Plants.* They suggest that U.K.A.C.O.'s radionic broadcasts may have acted homeopathically—directly affecting the plants (as opposed to the pests)—stimulating natural resistance. If true, we might argue that this resistance

may have assumed a plant-nutritional form to counter insect-feeding as suggested by Predisposition and Trophobiosis theories.

This notion takes on more weight when one carefully reads Russell, and Tompkins and Bird. Both sources indicate that U.K.A.C.O. sought, not simply to eliminate pests, but to vitalize crops to increase yield and quality! If we assume that successful vitalization equates to stress-reduction, that further leads to pest starvation, it is logical that most observers might measure success in terms of pest suppression. They might simply note any improvement of crop performance as resulting only from reduced pest damage. It would be quite possible to overlook the underlying causal factors associated with healthier plants.

It is not clear from Russell, Tompkins and Bird, and other published sources, just what protocols U.K.A.C.O. principals and cooperators followed, and whether the alternative "homeopathic/predisposition/trophobiotic" explanation truly holds water. However, we might take a hint from another radionics pioneer, T. Galen Hieronymus, who worked with U.K.A.C.O.'s not-profit research arm, the Homeotronic Foundation. In the "credimus" or introduction to his Cosmiculture manual, Galen outlines his philosophy and approach to using radionics/psychotronics for agriculture. He states:

Disease, unwanted insects, undesirable plants are simply indications of conditions, in that environment, conducive to their existence at a particular time and place. Change those conditions by enhancing the environment for the desirable, and the reason for the undesirable ceases to exist.

Reagents are incorporated within the Cosmiculture system that will, at once, enhance the vitality of the desirable <u>and</u> reduce the vitality of the undesirable.¹¹

This statement of belief mirrors the ideas common to Predisposition, Trophobiosis, and the traditions of Biodynamics, Homeopathy, and organic farming. They might also have been those of Upton, Knuth, and Armstrong. Whether they are or not, the concept continues through the contemporary evolution of agricultural radionics, the story of which will continue in Part 2 of this series.

CONSCIOUSNESS OF MATTER, INTERMATTER COMMUNICATION AND ETHER RESEARCH

There is no doubt that we are in a transitional time period. Technology has advanced so rapidly that it is impossible for one man to grasp the general outline, let alone the details. Personally, I have seen the changes from a time when oxcarts were still used to this time when

genetic god-playing is possible.

All changes of any importance have always been preceded by some basic development. For example, the printing press made it possible to make ideas available to the masses. Chemistry had to become a predictable science before medicine was able to make its concoctions, and electricity had to be first invented to launch us into this

age of high energy physics.

There has been one exception to this "first come, then do" rule and we find it among the people dabbling in psychotronics, radionics and the diverse branches of subjective disciplines. Chiropractic, for example, did not evolve from a science — it came out of observations. It seemed logical that when a vertebra was out of place it should be put back in place. Now, if a vertebra was out of place and something in the body hurt — and you put the bone back in place and the pain disappeared — then it made even more sense. But when you suffer from an organic disease and the spine is adjusted and you cure that disease, then things become a bit more complicated. A lot of people start to wonder, "Why?" Then the search for the scientific basis begins. It is really astounding that the chiropractic profession never came up with an ironclad scientific explanation.

D. D. Palmer, who is known as the father of the profession, provided a philosophical explanation. He simply stated that a force enters our body, and he called this force universal intelligence. The brain converts this force into innate intelligence and pumps it to every cell of the body via nerve pathways. Most nerves leave the spine between vertebrae and that is where this innate intelligence can get choked off by mechanical pressure. He was convinced that when innate intelligence got there all was well, and if it got choked off disease would certainly come about. Needless to say, this simplistic concept could ruin a religion. It certainly got ridiculed by the scientific community.

I am not here to promote chiropractic but simply wanted to point out that in this enlightened age a system still functions which at root has no scientific basis.

Medicine, on the other hand, calls itself "scientific"

because it can prove that a handful of drugs have a predictable and repeatable effect. Yet at root it is also just an evolving scientific system. Why do we spend so much money on medical research? They still do not know what AIDS is all about.

Research is in my blood. My childhood in Germany was spent in an atmosphere of technological intensity. My father, engineer and scientist, talked about satellites in 1940, and built and tested the first rudimentary particle beam weapons in 1944. So it is really no wonder that I set myself a goal of finding the other side of medicine, which the scientists ignore but nevertheless use, and which will ultimately destroy all of us if not fully understood.

For the past 25 years I have discovered bits and pieces of the puzzle of life. As this body of knowledge grows, it becomes increasingly difficult to lead a normal life. In a so-called "normal" life we always like to be in control; things should be as predictable as possible and should by all means conform to our standards. Shunyata, which is a portion of eastern Tantra teaching tries to teach you that you must see things as they are, not as you wish them to be. All things must have the right to exist on their own terms, not yours.

There are many things which can be discovered. Sometimes all you have to do is leave the mainstream of thought and fantasize a bit. Everybody knows it's impossible to build an antigravity machine. But just maybe somebody will build one. Physics, for example, has boxed itself in by two things. First, everything is limited to the speed of light; and second, the existence of the ether is rejected. When one mentions the subject of ether one is met with a fanatical counterattack. The word itself has almost totally disappeared. Every scientist knows that the Michelson-Morley experiment proved that there is no ether. This is how facts become distorted, because it only proved that ether has no effect on the behavior of light.

Why is it so wrong to consider the existence of ether? So it has no form or substance; why is it so irritating? What is wrong with a room without furniture? There was a time when everybody considered outer space to be an absolute vacuum. If you would exit from a spacecraft this vacuum would simply tear you to pieces. Now it has been accepted that space is a form of nothingness with very few atoms or molecules present and there is nothing to tear you up.

The speed of light depends on photons; after all,

photons are the basis of the light phenomenon and most likely the beginning of everything. Yet to physics the photon is a paradox. A photon is either a particle or a waveform and the problem is solved by accepting a photon to be both. That, to me, is a cheap way out and not worthy of physics. I proved to my own satisfaction that a photon is at least a pre-particle, but the waveform on which it travels is an undulation of the ether. In fact, the undulation of the ether seems to precede an event. Now try to live with this statement. Ether is the conductor and storage medium of consciousness. Recently I conducted experiments with lasers which seem to back this proposition.

When Max Planck and Heisenberg started to develop quantum physics they irritated Einstein because quantum physics allows for uncertainties and for things to have their own consciousness, at least to a degree. Einstein and his camp had absolutely no room for that and he, Rosen, and Podolsky wrote the new, often quoted, ERP paper. This paper was presented to disprove some of the claims which the quantum people made. Yet, unexpectedly — and contrary to Einstein's intent — he provided some proof that consciousness is available in even the smallest things.

For the people not familiar with the ERP effect here is a quick explanation. You take a piece of matter and divide it into two portions. Now, one of the portions stays here and the other you ship off to the end of the universe. If you irritate the portion here the other part will know about it, no matter how far away it is, and this transfer of information is instantaneous. Concludes Einstein, since nothing moves faster than the speed of light, it can't work. He missed one point; while a *substance* cannot travel faster than the speed of light, the *interchange of information* (i.e. consciousness) is supraluminal. In fact, it may not be bound to time at all.

Some laboratories have been working for years on an experiment. Here they emit two photons in opposite directions, alter the spin of the one, and expect to find that the other reacts to it. So far the experiment has failed because the experimenters do not understand that to know something is not the same as reacting to it. They should have read Dumas' *The Corsican Brothers*.

A researcher is basically an unfulfilled person. His curiosity drives him on and on. He is not satisfied that things work, but must know how. I remember once going to Las Vegas and taking in a few of the shows. One maitre d'apparently felt that I had not adequately tipped him, so he gave me a table on the extreme side of the stage. But it turned out to be a really nice evening because all the pretty half-naked girls had to practically fall over my feet to get on stage, and I was fascinated with the magic show because I could see the back of the magician. I never thought that a man could hide so much on his back. As a researcher one is a happy man when one gets a look behind the scenes.

For a private individual to conduct proper research and

adhere to accepted protocol is generally too expensive and boring. Instead of having the university procure fancy equipment and supply quantities of cheap labor in the form of students, the private individual has to take another route. Generally, he makes use of free information by becoming a more acute observer, and he must have a certain amount of arrogance to believe that the great researchers have overlooked something.


In the late sixties a new interactive diagnostic system came into being in the form of kinesiology. It was found that certain muscles under certain circumstances became weak and then strong again. Soon it was used to diagnose anything from vitamin deficiencies to spiritual possession. It was a fascinating subject, but soon became a parlor game. For example, there was a guy on a talk show who would test the strength of an outstretched arm and then by simply putting a quantity of table sugar into the hand of the test person, make the strong arm totally weak. He used a number of other substances and some made the arm weak and some strong. I was very impressed. In fact, I took a clinical course a kinesiology, but soon got into arguments with the instructor. One could actually will a person's muscle to go weak. Then I built an electronic device. A test person would wear a set of earphones and I would pulse a click into one ear, then into the other, and finally, simultaneously into both ears. When the clicks were pulsed only into one ear, the muscles would invariably go weak, but when pulsed into both ears the muscles would stay strong. I abandoned this procedure when I used it on a deaf person and he reacted to it the same way.

It took years before I understood what was going on. I still use kinesiology but limit it to one set of muscles, namely opposing the thumb and little finger. This maneuver is difficult to do, and according to the late Bronowsky (of Ascent of Man fame) takes one pound of brain to execute. Needless to say that some people can't do it. I had abandoned all other muscle tests because I found out that most of these tests had nothing to do with muscles, but with reaction time. The brain is like a computer and does only one thing at a time in rapid succession, so that it seems that it can do many things simultaneously. So if you occupy the brain with something else and at the same time test the muscle, it seems to get In reality, the test subject is a bit slower to counteract your force, and once a muscle is in motion it can't be stopped. With the little finger and thumb opposed it is even a bit more complicated, because when there is an air gap between the fingertips, the brain has no way of knowing what the position of the fingers is. With a little bit of practice this became a very valuable tool. One could use a test subject as an extremely sensitive detector, and it was cheap. When you have access to plenty of patients, then you can make a lot of experiments, with or without them knowing it. Of course, I tried to get information directly through instrumentation and even used the "E"

Meter the Scientologists employ to probe emotions. It did not work.

Then I started to experiment with chemicals. In general, a toxic substance could be detected by a test person if that person was healthy. On the other hand, when that person was ill, he would detect a nontoxic substance. Once he recovered he again would react properly to the toxic substances. This observation opened up a whole new field. One thing became obvious. A chemical must radiate a field since the test substances were always in a test tube. At the same time the test person also must have a sensory field because he would react to the substance even over clothing. To measure the sensory field of the person was fairly easy. We simply measured the distance from the skin to the point where he would detect the substance. And here we made an observation which is a bit unsettling. 15 years ago this field was more than 9/16 of an inch and today it has collapsed to 1/8 of an inch - and seems to be becoming smaller. The implications are that our protective shield may be collapsing.


Gradually our test procedures became more sophisticated and my house now looks like a branch of the Los Alamos Laboratory. Things became more exciting. Unwittingly, I stumbled onto an experiment which proved that there really was an ERP effect. In Figure 1, I have summarized the observations made of the properties of chemicals:



- All "toxic to the normal human" chemicals have a square wave structure and a specific frequency and spin.
- 2. All "non-toxic or food" substances have a sine wave, a specific frequency and spin.
- 3. The information, or signature, of a chemical leaves an imprint on the environment. When standing still it leaves a drift behind itself as the earth rotates.
- When a substance is separated the portions stay in communication.

5. A sine wave substance can detect and transmit a square wave signature and vice versa.

Now we were ready for some neat experiments. We knew that when we separated a substance (sine) and then put another vial of a substance (square) on top of it the other part of the chemical would detect it. But how far could one separate these chemicals? We built the following setup. (Figure 2)



In addition to the separated sine wave chemicals we had a motor pass a square wave substance through its field every 5 seconds. The unit was then connected to a timer which turned the experiment on between 5 and 6 p.m. Then we went on vacation and every evening we would check the chemical taken along and detect the "pulse." A week later we ended up in Las Vegas, Nevada, and took the substance up to our room. That evening we got no signal. It was disturbing. Finally, something had broken the connection. When we phoned home to check on the experiment we found that a power failure had stopped the motor and when the power came back on the experiment worked again flawlessly. I conducted two more experiments of the same kind. I tried it out during a flight and it worked in the plane just as on the ground. Finally, I took the second substance all the way to Germany. It still worked flawlessly.

Another opportunity to prove my theories came unexpectedly. There was a government office downtown in Santa Fe which had higher than normal incidence of illness. It was blamed on poor circulation, bad lighting, and the CIA — which had an office upstairs. When I checked the area out, I detected a toxic "drift" which ran east-west through the government office. Now, according to my theory a toxic chemical should be found either east or west of this office. I traced the drift west but could not find the deposit. The terrain goes uphill to the east and the drift then would disappear into the ground and I had no way to follow it. By making precise measurements I ended up in the basement of the old Saint Vincent Hospital, which was being remodeled. Here I found the source of the toxic drift. The toilets from all the sickrooms had been neatly stacked in the basement. They had never been cleaned and were still encrusted with human waste and


toxic chemicals. It put me on the front page of the local paper. The people remained ill at the government office until the toilets had been cleaned and reinstalled in the rooms. Suddenly, no more headaches, dizziness or fatigue.

Which now brings me to the subject of ether. When we separate two chemicals or consider a chemical drift, what transmits the information? Ether, since it has no substance, may be the medium for storing and transmitting information. It would also explain the dual nature of the photon. The photon is considered both a wave form and a particle. I have always argued that the photon is a particle, but it rides on the waveform of the ether which precedes the photon. Yet the scientists, especially the quantum people, talk about consciousness of photons (as in the double slit experiments). Einstein even speculated that "photons were guided by ghost waves." Later came Schrödinger's wave equation. Talk about soft esoterics! These guys have both feet in the water and get away with it. By accepting the ether and investigating its behavior, the physicists could abandon the statistical mumbo jumbo of the quantum people.

In conclusion, I would like to present one of our latest experiments. It became the basis for our Photon Link TechnologyTM employed in sophisticated allergy desensitization procedures. As mentioned before, every chemical

has a signature. By using a laser and passing it through a liquid, the laser beam transmits the information it picks up from the liquid. The surprise came when we totally blocked the laser light with a solid substance. The information of the chemical was still available past the barrier. Obviously the "wave" continued and the photon particle has nothing to do with the transmission of information. The photons, on the other hand, seem to be instrumental in setting up the intensity of the ether oscillations.

Figure 3 is a diagram of the experiment. The wave propagation of the laser goes in a direct line as long as a photon rides on it. Once the photon is stripped the wave continues on but is now subject to gravity. In fact, it returns — having slingshot around the earth. What is unsettling is that a 0.8mW helium-neon laser has that much power. When our "Star Wars" program became public the Soviets were more than usually disturbed. I had always had the feeling that they knew more about lasers than we do. Suppose you direct a laser beam towards a human target. Now you modulate the beam with a frequency which will disturb the nervous system. Strip all the photons so it cannot be detected and you have a pretty sophisticated weapon. The implications are pretty unsettling. The question is, how much of this sort of warfare is already implemented?



THE HOLISTIC PARADIGM

A review of holistic theories in science includes the "many worlds" interpretation of quantum mechanics, the zero-point energy, the EPR paradox, Bell's theorem, Bohm's implicate order, Prigogine's thermodynamics of self-organization, Sheldrake's morphogenetic fields, Pribram's holographic neurology and Woolf's holodynamic psychology. An integration of these theories yields implications for a new, expanded consciousness for humanity.

A new view of reality is emerging in Western science, a view that recognizes an inherent connectivity or oneness of seemingly separate objects; a view that allows consciousness, ultimately our very thoughts, to directly interact with other minds or objects. This view is called the holistic paradigm ("holistic" means whole; "paradigm" means pattern of belief). The concept of an inherent universal oneness is not new to humanity. The ideas have been expressed in ancient spiritual philosophies: Mysticism, Zen Buddhism, Taoism, Hinduism, etc. What is new is that Western scientists are gradually altering their views, and simultaneously, a gradual transformation of humanity's consciousness is occurring. It will be shown that this consciousness transformation or "awakening" contains surprising implications for all of us.

Reductionism

To appreciate the emerging holistic paradigm of Western science, it is useful to understand the current reigning paradigm known as reductionism. The major belief of reductionism is that, in principle, any system can be understood by reducing it into parts and understanding their interactions. All interactions are always local (if certain parts are spatially separate, then a propagating signal mediates the interaction). The requirement that all interactions can be ultimately reduced to local interactions is known as the principle of local causality. Reductionism generally formulates its physical laws on the substrate of space-time. Modeling the universe with more than three dimensions of space is considered superfluous or un-physical. Reductionistic physics include classical physics (Newton's laws, Maxwell's electromagnetism, classical thermodynamics, etc.) and Einstein's Theory of Relativity. Nearly all of today's engineering and technology are based on reductionistic theories, and, consequently, most scientists are philosophically reductionistic.

Quantum Mechanics

At the turn of the century, classical scientists declared that all the physical laws were known, and that only two "small clouds" were not adequately explained: the black body radiation spectrum of a heated object and the stability of electron orbits around atomic nuclei.1 These two "small clouds" ushered in a scientific revolution -the development of quantum mechanics. Plank and Einstein quantized the radiation field giving birth to the photon, and Bohr, de Broglie and Schrödinger proposed quantized energy "standing waves" for the electron to explain atomic stability. The equations of quantum mechanics are not reductionistic in their implications. The probability waves described by these equations give rise to nonlocal interactions. This point was made by Einstein, Podolsky, and Rosen (EPR) in 1935, showing that for an atomic system where two once-coupled particles separate, quantum mechanics predicts an instantaneous collapse of the wave function for either particle when its partner is measured — regardless of the distance between them.2

In 1965, Bell reformulated Einstein's argument into a theorem that allowed the experimental investigation of this result. Experiments were done in the 1970's confirming quantum mechanics,³ but at the expense of

undermining the principle of local causality.

Quantum mechanics begets other paradoxes as well. For example, in the two-slit experiment, an elementary particle exhibits wave or particle behavior depending on the detection apparatus. Wheeler has recently proposed a new configuration of this experiment where the detecting apparatus (for a wave or particle) is selected well after the particle/wave has passed the two slits, accenting the paradox.4 Quantum mechanics shows that before a measurement is made, the particle/wave does not appear to have an objective, three-dimensional existence. But, then what is it? The Copenhagen interpretation of quantum mechanics simply states that this is an irrelevant question - no attempt should be made to model the elementary particle/wave in a local way. Most physicists subscribe to this "interpretation" and give up attempts to explain what is going on underneath to give rise to the equations of quantum mechanics. This "interpretation" is perhaps the last bastion of reductionistic philosophy, which, in effect, simply ignores the astounding, hyperphysical implications of quantum mechanics.

Many Worlds

In the late 1950's, Everett introduced a totally selfconsistent interpretation of quantum mechanics with a single assumption: that all systems - even the entire universe — are ultimately quantum mechanical in their nature.5 This assumption had the advantage of resolving "the measurement problem." The measurement problem relates to the collapse of the wave function when a quantum mechanical event is recorded. The philosophical problem is, "where in a system does the quantum world end and the classical world begin?" By allowing the entire universe to be a quantum system, the equations of quantum mechanics then show that what really exists is an infinite number of three-dimensional universes coexisting simultaneously, and these can influence each other through waves of probabilistic coupling.6 Our consciouness weaves a path through these many universes and experiences the perception of a single three-dimensional universe moving in time7. Perhaps what is most bizarre about Everett's many worlds interpretation is that within many of these universes simultaneously exist a multiplicity of ourselves. This notion seems absurd and perhaps is the reason that the many worlds interpretation is currently unpopular. However, as will be shown later, some novel concepts coming from the field of holodynamic psychology may make the notion of "self-multiplicity" not only less absurd, but perhaps even reasonable! The many worlds interpretation introduces a hyperspace embedding an infinitude of three-dimensional spaces. The nonlocal EPR interaction is simply the selection by our consciousness of a particular three-dimensional universe. This idea can support the many works on positive thinking8 where the process of visualization and emotional intensity (perhaps augmented by the alpha brainwave state)9 allows the selection of which universe is more likely to be experienced from the set of probabilistic universes. The collapse of the quantum mechanical wave function is a selection of a universe by our consciousness. This could be the most powerful and optimistic implication coming from quantum mechanics, for it gives us more choice than we have ever dreamed possible.

Zero-Point Energy

Quantum mechanics has also discovered the existence of an all-pervading energy embedded within the fabric of space, the zero-point energy. About thirty years after the Michelson and Morley experiment failed to detect the ether, it was recognized that a term was needed in the equations of quantum mechanics in order for them to correctly describe experimental results. The term described an inherent, electrically energetic fluctuation interacting with all systems, even in the total absence of mass, radiation or heat. Zero-point refers to a temperature of absolute zero degrees Kelvin and means that the fluctuations are not thermal in nature. The zero-point

fluctuations at first presented an embarrassing situation: their energy density was infinite. 10 Mathematical procedures called renormalization were devised for quantum mechanical calculations to remove this infinite zero-point energy to yield the finite masses and fields that we observe. A new and even more promising approach to modeling the zero-point energy may arise from superstring theories which unify all the forces of nature. 11 Recent experiments have shown that the zero-point energy is unaffected by the presence of absorbers and reflectors. 12 This implies that the energy does not propagate in our three-dimensional space. Where does it come from?

By applying the formalism of general relativity to the zero-point energy, Wheeler's geometrodynamics answers this question and derives the modern view of the fabric of space.13 In general relativity, a sufficiently large energy density causes the fabric of space-time to pinch (like a black hole) in a direction orthogonal to our three-dimensional space. This yields hyperspatial channels Wheeler calls "wormholes" through which this energy flows. Wormholes can link distant locations within our universe or create linkages to other parallel, three-dimensional universes. (Note: This hyperspatial description has similarities to Everett's many worlds interpretation.)14 The action of the zero-point fluctuations results from an electric flux orthogonally passing through our threedimensional space. Jitter in this flux, aligned with our three-space, gives rise to a turbulence of microscopic white holes (electric flux entering) and black holes (flux leaving) that are constantly pair-forming and pairannihilating. These holes are on the order of 10⁻³³cm and the resulting turbulence gives the fabric of space a dynamic foam-like structure sometimes called the "quantum foam."

The electrical flux through any of these channels has a (mass-equivalent) energy density on the order of 10⁹³ grams/cm³. This is simply enormous compared with the masses of elementary particles or even the earth (10¹² grams). Bohm suggests that the zero-point energy is the implicate source of all explicate matter and energy. But, how can a sea of turbulence give rise to the coherent structures that we observe as matter?

Self-Organization

The reductionistic view is that a random chaotic system should remain so. This is the common understanding of the law of entropy, the second law of thermodynamics. This view applies to those systems which are linear or near equilibrium. However, there are other types of systems.

In 1977, Ilya Prigogine won the Nobel Prize in chemistry for identifying under what conditions a system may evolve from a chaotic state to an organized state. The conditions are that the system must be nonlinear, far from equilibrium, and have an energy flux through it.¹⁵ A

nonlinear system is one whose response to a set of stimuli may produce new, surprising or synergistic behavior that cannot readily be predicted by simply summing the responses of the individual stimuli. (Linear systems, on the other hand, exhibit linear superposition where a reductionistic "sum of parts" view gives the correct prediction. In the history of science, most systems that were readily analyzable were linear systems. For these systems, the reductionistic view works quite well.) An example of self-organization is the generation of vortices and vortex rings in a turbulent fluid or air (e.g., tornadoes). Another example of order arising from chaos occurs in a turbulent plasma (highly ionized gas). Here, the formation of vortex ring pairs is observed to occur.¹⁶ This is of interest since the zero-point energy can be modeled as a virtual turbulent plasma. Vortex ring formation would then correspond to pair production of elementary particles (e.g., electron and positron). Note that a vortex ring exhibits a precessional rotation (a helical rotation around a cylinder that closes into a toroid). Many investigators have suggested that a precessional rotation may be a key for orthorotating into our three-space the hyperspatial flux that constitutes the zero-point energy.¹⁷ From a system's perspective, the behavior of the zero-point energy fulfills the conditions for self-organization: it is highly nonlinear in its interaction with matter; it can be driven far from equilibrium by abrupt motions of matter (or plasma); and it is maintained by a (hyperspatial) flux of electrical energy.

The holistic paradigm has the zero-point energy as the source that maintains the elementary particles and therefore all matter. It has recently been shown to be the basis for the stability of the hydrogen atom.¹⁸ Bohm shows that it is the basis of the implicate order from which arises the explicate phenomena of matter, energy, time and space.19 Bohm's implicate order contains a quantum potential that results in nonlocal correlations across space-time²⁰ (as well as perhaps across the multiple, parallel universes of Everett). These nonlocal linkages result in a holistic description of our universe as a hologram—where the whole view is implicitly embedded in every section of the hologram. Note that Wheeler's hyperspatial worm-holes likewise generate a nonlocal connectivity. The zero-point energy constitutes the first substrate of organization, and allows phenomena to be linked nonlocally through a higher dimensional space.

Morphogenetic Fields

Sheldrake has proposed the existence of subtle, hyperspatial "morphogenetic fields" which guide the formation of matter or living systems.²¹ These fields are further strengthened by the physical manifestation they help form, thus making it easier to repeat creating the physical form. For example, in chemistry it is often very difficult to grow a new crystalline compound for the first

time. But after one laboratory succeeds, it is easier for others to accomplish this, even at remote locations. A process that was previously failing begins to succeed after the first success. Similarly, the creation of predicted, new, elementary particles in an accelerator is difficult at first, but once the new particle is created, it is recreated easier in accelerators all over the world (even under the old experimental conditions). In Sheldrake's theory, the crystal or elementary particle has a morphogenetic field which becomes "locked in" at the first physical manifestation. This field then guides future growth and creation. The field is nonlocal and hyperspatial in its nature and can be likened to an "etheric" or "spiritual" form.

Sheldrake's theory applies especially to biological systems, and here the morphogenetic fields can give rise to group mind or collective intelligence. In embryology, the embryo of a dragonfly that is cut in half still yields a fully formed dragonfly — except it is half size.²¹ The fields guide the morphogenesis of the embyro, as opposed to only an internal, localized, reductionistic, growth mechanism. Thomas shows an example of collective behavior occurring in a single cilia of a protozoan.²² The cilia itself is a colony of separate microscopic organisms that combine to produce a single unitary filament. Hundreds of cilia are synchronized to propel the protozoan. Another example is the mitochondria. They live within the protoplasm of a single cell as autonomous beings — yet they participate in a collective fashion to provide the cell with energy.22 The morphogenetic fields of a single cell guide the collective behavior of its components.

The morphogenetic fields may also link the separate individuals of a specie. An example of collective intelligence occurs in the insect world with termites. When there are only a few termites, their pattern of building or moving pellets is random and meaningless. Yet, as more termites are added to the group, a threshold phenomena occurs where their behavior radically changes and they being to cooperatively create majestic, multi-arch structures for their nest.22 Another example occurs in squid migration. With one or just a few squid gathered, there is no awareness of what direction to swim. But when a sufficient number are present, a new group intelligence arises, and the collective acts as a single organism making a direct, purposeful migration across the ocean.22 Like the clear image that can be achieved through a large holograph versus the noisy image through a small one (or piece), a large collective of individuals is needed to manifest a clear intelligence.

Pribram makes this point as well, in his holographic theory of memory storage in the brain.²¹ Here, memory is stored redundantly on many neurons. The ability, clarity and quickness of recall is related to the large number of neurons. Experiments have shown that memory is not localized in the brain, but redundantly distributed.

Transgenerational collective intelligence has been

shown in experiments with mice. Since the 19th Century, a particular specie of mice has been used in psychological experiments where the mice have been taught to run mazes. It has been observed that the later generations are able to learn faster to run the mazes.21 Here, intelligence is associated with the morphogenetic field of the specie, and each individual is able to resonate with this field benefiting from and adding to the group intelligence. Perhaps the most famous example of specie collective intelligence was observed in monkeys on the Pacific islands near Japan.²¹ Scientists were studying the behavior of the monkeys. One monkey accidentally dropped a piece of fruit it was eating in the sand, and the scientist washed it off in the water. The monkey then proceeded to drop the fruit again, but then washed it itself. Soon, by imitation, other monkeys on the island began washing their fruit. In a few weeks, all the monkeys on the island had learned to wash fruit. The big surprise came when the scientists sailed to another island inhabited by the same specie of monkey. When they arrived, they observed that all the monkeys on this separate island were washing their fruit as well! It was as if this knowledge became encoded in the collective group mind of the specie, and this mind (or morphogenetic field) was nonlocal within space-time, yet each member of the specie is part of it.

Holodynamic Psychology

Holistic psychology extends the concept of a nonlocal collective group mind to human beings. Woolf describes the process as "holodynamic" psychology since all minds are in a constant dynamic state of growth, yet all are a part of the group collective or holistic universal mind.²³ The universal mind exhibits the following recursive, archetypical process: it gives rise to many individual human minds, each experiencing a separation from the universal mind. Each human mind, in turn, is comprised of many more primitive minds called "holodigms" each with its own ego that experiences separation from the other holodigms. What we experience as our ego is simply the holodigm that is currently active or conscious. The word "holodigm" means whole (holo), form (digm). It implies that each primitive ego state is a form that arises from the holistic, universal mind and contains the potential for reconnecting its awareness back to the universal mind. The process for establishing this reconnection or awakening is called psychomaturation. This process not only yields a happier, more fulfilled life, but also unlocks the psychic potential of the individual.

Psychic, extrasensory abilities such as telepathy, psychokinesis, astral traveling, precognition, cognition of other former lives, etc., arise simply by expanding one's identity and awareness into the universal mind.²⁴ In the past, it would normally take many years of mystic training, meditation, and practice to begin to achieve this awareness. The process of psychomaturation accelerates this awakening by removing the blocks that inhibit this

and, perhaps most importantly, by achieving a bonding experience with others on this same path of growth. When many minds are focused together in the psychomaturation processes, the awareness accelerates not only for those experienced, but also for those who are just beginning the process. The more bonded minds participating, the more rapid the growth. Thus, as more people awaken to their full potential selves (the spiritual-self which transcends the physical body), the easier it will be for others to awaken. When a sufficient number come into experiential awareness of the universal mind, a threshold will be breached in the morphogenetic field of mankind, and all minds will spontaneously become universally aware. At this point, all individuals will realize and directly experience that we are a single superconscious entity.

Summary

Quantum mechanics has given a new view of reality to Western science. Perhaps the biggest surprise to the reductionistic view is the existence of nonlocal connectivity. The successful experimental demonstration of the EPR paradox is the "crack in the cosmic egg"25 from which is emerging the new holistic paradigm. Quantum mechanics also shows that every elementary particle and therefore all matter is formed in the zero-point energy which exhibits a nonlocal or hyperspatial quality. Bohm proposes an implicate order in the zero-point energy, and Sheldrake suggests the existence of subtle, hyperspatial morphogenetic fields which guide the hierarchical organization of matter and living systems. Thomas observes this group organization and group intelligence throughout biology, and Woolf has developed a process to accelerate the experiential awareness of our universal mind. It is hoped that this brief overview motivates the study of the cited references, for a growing awareness of the holistic paradigm will usher in a unifying transition for humanity.

 P. Davies, Other Worlds, Simon and Schuster, NY, 1980.

This book describes the various views of superspace arising in modern physics, including the many worlds interpretation of quantum mechanics.

7. J. Gribbon, In Search of Schrödinger's Cat, Bantam Books, NY, 1984.

Gribbon presents the historic developments of modern physics for the layman, including a thorough explanation of the many worlds interpretation of quantum mechanics.

8. C. M. Bristol, *The Magic of Believing*, Pocket Books, NY, 1969.

This book teaches how visualization of desirable outcomes helps to trigger those events.

9. J. Stearn, The Power of Alpha-Thinking, Signet, NY, 1977.

Stearn shows that visualization of desirable events while in an alpha brainwave state increases their likelihood.

 E. G. Harris, "The Problems of Infinites in Quantum Electrodynamics," in A Pedestrian Approach to Quantum Field Theory, Wiley Interscience, NY, 1972.

In Chapter 10 is a discussion of the zero-point energy, including experiments that have detected its existence.

11. M. Kaku, J. Hainer, Beyond Einstein: The Cosmic Quest for the Theory of the Universe. Bantam Books, NY, 1987. This book is a layman's introduction to the various unification theories of modern physics. Superstring theory appears to be the most promising for unifying all four fundamental forces (strong nuclear, weak nuclear, electromagnetic, and gravitation). The fundamental unit in this theory is a filament on the order of 10⁻³³cm (same size as Wheeler's quantum worm-

holes) that can form into a Mobius loop. The theory avoids the problems of renormalization by not using point particles.

 O. H. Abroskina, G. Kh. Kitaeva, A. N. Penin, "The Effective Brightness of Zero-Point Fluctuations of the Electromagnetic Vacuum of Parametric Scattering of Light," Sov. Phys. Dokl. 30(1), 67 (1985).

This paper summarizes an experiment that shows that zero-point fluctuations are independent of the presence of nearby reflectors or absorbers. This shows that the zero-point energy does not arise from a propagation in our three-dimensional space, and thus supports the hyperspatial flux model for the source of the zero-point energy.

13. J. A. Wheeler, *Geometrodynamics*. Academic Press, NY, 1962.

Wheeler derives the modern view of the fabric of space by applying general relativity to the zero-point energy of quantum mechanics. The result is a dynamic maelstrom of nonlocal, microscopic channels across space-times through a turbulence of "wormholes" whose size is on the order of 10^{-33} cm. An electric flux passes through these channels with an energy density on the order of 10^{93} grams/cm³.

14. B. Toben, F. Wolf, Space-Time and Beyond, E.P. Dutton, 1982.

This book is an illustrated introduction to the theories of superspace, geometrodynamics, the many worlds interpretation and the resulting possibilities for expanding consciousness.

15. I. Prigogine, I. Stengers, Order Out of Chaos, Bantam Books, NY, 1984.

Prigogine overviews his Nobel Prize-winning theory for the layman, showing the conditions under which a system may evolve from a chaotic state to an organized one.

 W. H. Bostick, "Experimental Study of Plasmoids," Phys. Rev. 106(3), 404 (1957).

Bostick experimentally investigates the formation of plasmoid vortex ring pairs in a turbulent plasma. A "quantum condition" in the ratio of toroidal to poloidal diameters is identified as needed for stability.

 M. B. King "Cohering the Zero-Point Energy," Proceedings of the International Tesla Symposium, International Tesla Society, Colorado Springs, CO, 1986.

By merging theories of the zero-point energy with theories of system self-organization, it is shown that it may be possible to cohere the zero-point energy as a source. Possible methods are referenced and include ion-acoustic oscillations, abruptly pulsed bucking fields, and plasma vorticies and vortex rings exhibiting precession.

18. H. E. Puthoff, "Ground State of Hydrogen as a Zero-Point Fluctuation Determined State." Phys. Rev. D 35(10), 3266 (1987).

The author shows that the ground state of the hydrogen atom results from an equilibrium between radiation emitted due to acceleration of the electron and radiation absorbed from the zero-point fluctuations.

19. K. Wilbur, *The Holographic Paradigm*, Shambhala, Boulder, CO, 1982.

Wilbur combines a series of articles and interviews with the proponents of the holographic paradigm in Western science; David Bohm in physics and Karl Pribram in neurology. Bohm has proposed an implicate/explicate order with the zero-point energy at its basis. This gives rise to a holographic universe. Pribram presents a holographic model for the brain. Combining their work gives a holographic processing brain interacting with a holographic universe which yields the explicate perception of a space-time universe.

20. D. J. Bohm, B. J. Hiley, "On the Intuitive Understanding of Nonlocality as Implied by Quantum Theory," Found. Phys. 5(1), 93 (1975).

The authors show how nonlocality arises in quantum mechanics through the EPR paradox and Bell's Theorem. Bohm's "quantum potential" leads to the notion of an unbroken wholeness for the entire universe.

21. T. P. Briggs, F. Peat, *Looking Glass Universe*, Simon & Shuster, NY, 1984.

This book is an excellent overview of the holistic theories emerging in Western science. It includes Bohm's implicate/explicate order, Prigogine's thermodynamics, Sheldrakes' morphogenetic fields, and Pribram's holographic neurology. These holographic theories suggest a nonlocal connectiveness linking all of nature.

22. L. Thomas, *The Lives of a Cell*, Penguin Books, NY, 1978.

This book contains a collection of essays by Thomas that show the remarkable hierarchical organization at various levels in biology. The essay "Some Bio-mythology" shows the cilia of a certain protozoan are a colony of spirochetes. The essay "Organelles as Organisms" shows that the mitochondira are autonomous organisms within the cell. The essay "Living Language" describes the observation of termites' ability to build majestic structures when in large numbers.

23. V. Woolf, *The Principles of Psychomaturation*, (to be published).

The author presents a mind model based on levels of maturation which shows that in our fullest potential our minds link to a universal mind. Specific techniques for psychomaturation are presented with numerous case histories. The maturation process accelerates when many minds are focused in a bonding experience. Woolf extends the holistic concepts of Bohm and Pribram into a "holodynamic" psychology.

24. D. Loye, The Sphinx and the Rainbow, Shambala, Boulder, CO, 1983.

This is a thorough overview of consciousness, brain and mind research. It shows that the brain's frontal lobes are associated with bonding, psychic abilities, mystical awareness, and linking to a universal mind.

25. J. C. Pearce, Exploring the Crack in the Cosmic Egg, Pocket Books, NY, 1975.

This scientific and philosophical study examines the nature of paradigm shifts through human history. The author supports with numerous references the notion that our objective reality is created by a universal mind in which we all participate. This can allow paranormal phenomena.

Journal of Bioelectricity: Published by Taylor and Francis from 1982-1992. Title was changed to Electro and Magnetobiology. We need all issues.

Journal of Electronic Medicine: This was a continuation of Physico-Clinical Medicine, and ran from 1939-1945, published by Fred J. Hart and the College of Electronic Medicine. We need all issues:

Journal of the British Society of Dowsers: Published by the British Society of Dowsers from 1956-2000. Prior title was Radio Perception. Succeeding title: Dowsing Today. We need all issues.

Journal of the United States Psychotronics Association. Published by the United States Psychotronics Association. Only six issues were published, and we have a complete set.

Mind and Matter: published by George DeLaWarr of the DeLawarr Laboratories in Oxford, England from 1957-1967. We have a complete set of these very rare journals.

Newsletter of the Institute of Psionic Medicine. Published by the Institute of Psionic Medicine only from 1978-1979. We need all issues.

Newsheet of the Psionic Medical Society. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the England only from 1975-1977. We need all issues.

New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics Journal. Published by the New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics from 1988-present. We need all issues.

Physico-Clinical Medicine: This journal was started in 1916 by the father of radionics, Dr. Albert Abrams, and continued to be published up through 1938, by Fred J. Psionic Medicine. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the UK from 1969-around 1991. We need most issues.

- 10. Your right to participate in the USPA Psychotronic Literature Preservation Program (UPLPP). The USPA, via its Library and Archives, has established a "Literature Preservation Program" to preserve your personal papers, files, records, and collection of articles, periodicals, books, and devices on psychotronics and related subjects, noted above. You may no longer need or use some of these items that you have, and you can send them to the USPA, and we will preserve them in our library and archives, so that they can be of use to other researchers.
