


Volunteers Needed

Chaperones are also invited to participate during the week and take their meals and lodging with us. There are a variety of lodging options but we are keeping the costs minimal.

From 1991 until 2011 Little Farm sponsored a local youth apprentice program each summer. We have an excellent curriculum for teaching young people the basic skills of sustainable soil management, planting and transplanting techniques, soil building and composting methods as well as integrative growing for intensive production. The afternoons will be focused on using radionics to evaluate and create Balancing strategies for seed plant and soil.

It is our hope that this week will spark new ideas in our youth and give them tools to better the way we grow and manage our food supplies. At LFR we are excited to be preparing for you.



These organizations and periodicals, some of which ceased operation many years ago, are listed below, with brief information. **If you know anything about these organizations, please contact the editor.** The periodicals have been added to the master list of psychotronics periodicals in the **USPA Periodicals Library section** of this journal. We are seeking copies of all issues of these periodicals, which we plan to digitize and make available to our members as a USPA membership benefit. So if you have any issues the periodicals listed below or any of the missing issues of the periodicals listed in the USPA Periodicals Library section of this Journal, please let the editor know by emailing him at: joreed43@gmail.com.

Organizations:

American Radio Therapy Society (ARTS): This was an organization founded by Dr. Ruth Drown in 1949 in Hollywood, California, where she also operated the Drown Laboratory of Radio Therapy. ARTS published a periodical called the American Radio Therapy Society Journal, with vol. 1, no. 1 being June, 1949. This organization focused on radionics and psychotronics subjects, and had no interest in ionizing radiation therapies, such as x-ray therapy, which were also known as "radio therapy" at that time. It is not known how long this organization lasted, but it undoubtedly ceased to exist at the time of, or some time prior to the death of Dr. Drown in 1963. If anyone has any information about this organization or its periodical, American Radio Therapy Society Journal, please contact the editor.


Paraphysics Study Group, Society for Psychical Research: In the mid 1960s, a group of physical scientist members of the Society for Psychical Research (SPR) in London, England, decided to form a more specialized group dedicated to the study of Paraphysics. They hoped that their study group would eventually evolve into a more formal Society for Paraphysics under the umbrella of the SPR. Members met and exchanged ideas as well as paperwork, but the organization fell apart over disagreements who should be full members - People holding PhDs in Physics, the Physical sciences, any academic discipline, or just anyone who was interested. It is not known if any newsletter or other periodical was ever published by this organization. If anyone has any information about this organization or its potential periodical, please write the editor.

Periodicals: (all added to the master list of USPA psychotronic periodicals)

American Radio Therapy Society Journal: This was a periodical published in Hollywood, California, by the American Radio Therapy Society, which had been founded by Dr. Ruth Drown in 1949. This periodical began with vol. 1, no. 1 in June, 1949, and continued to be published for a period of time. However, it is not known when it ceased publication or how many issued were published, but presumably it ceased sometime before Dr. Drown's death in 1963. This journal focused on radionics psychotronics subjects, and had no interest in ionizing radiation therapies, such as x-ray therapy, which were also known as "radio therapy" at that time. The only library in the world that has copies of this periodical is the National Library of Medicine in Bethesda, Maryland. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical. If anyone has any issues of this periodical, or knows anyone else who does, please contact the editor.

Bioeffects Newsletter: This was a periodical that was published by the "Physiology Program", Office of Naval Research, in Arlington, Virginia, and focused on the biological effects of electromagnetic fields. It probably began sometime in the 1977, because it is known that Issue #5 was dated April, 1978. The Bieffects Newsletter is believed to have ceased publication when the Bioelectromagnetics Society (BEMS) was formed in 1978, because it was edited by Thomas Rozzell, who served as the editor of the BEMS Newsletter for the Bioelectromagnetics Society. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is undoubtedly in a number of private individuals' collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical. If anyone has any issues, please contact the editor.

Little Farm Journal: This periodical was published by Lutie Larsen and Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah, and focused on agruchtural radionics and related subjects. It began sometime before the first issue of The Radionic Homestead Report, which was published in May, 1988, because that issue referred to the Little Farm Journal. It is not known when it began publishing, how many issues were published, or when it ceased publication. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is undoubtedly in a number of private individuals' collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical. If anyone has any issues, please contact the editor.





- 1. Duncan Laurie, author of the excellent book, <u>The Secret Art: A Brief History of Radionic Technology for the Creative Individual</u>, recently sent USPA an online article titled <u>"Sick Frequencies: Behind Radionics, the Wacky Sound Therapy That Turns Thoughts into Music."</u> This article, written by Tom Howells in March, 2017, is all about Daniel Wilson and his "Radionics Radio Project" where he creates electronic music from human thoughts.
- Were you ever a member of the Electronic Medicine Association (EMA) or know anyone who was? According to online sources, this organization was co-founded by Peter Moscow (US), former president of the USPA, and John Morley-Kirk (UK) and was incorporated in the United Kingdom in 2001. (UK Company number 04223137). From 2001 through 2010, the EMA held numerous seminars, workshops, and conferences, and may have published a newsletter or journal, although this is uncertain.

Unfortunately both Peter Moscow and John Morley-Kirk died in 2011, and records show that the organization was officially dissolved in the United Kingdom in October of 2011. A number of people have indicated that they would like to revive this organization, and we are attempting to locate all former members. So if you have any interest in this, or by chance have an old membership list, please write to the editor, John H. 3. Do any of you happen to know anything about the Paraphysical Laboratory that was founded in the UK by Benson Herbert in 1966, or have any issues of the Journal of Paraphysics that he published for more than 20 years. Mr. Herbert's laboratory was located at Privett Farm, Downton, Wiltshire, England, between Salisbury and Southhampton. His mission included an attempt to provide a workable theory and physical explanation for paranormal phenomena, including telepathy, remote viewing, dowsing, and other extraordinary abilities and phenomena. Unfortunately, Benson Herbert died in 1991, and no one seems to know what became of the papers and records of the laboratory, or if he even

Andrija Puharich's Lost Manuscript and other Puharich Mysteries by Greg Mallozzi

During the late 60s and into the 70s, Puharich owned and worked out of a large house in rural Ossining, New York. A home laboratory known as Lab 9. Lab 9 produced the most mysterious and far out work that Puharich was involved in when he began to delve deeper and deeper into parapsychological, experimental research: like alleged communication with extraterrestrial beings VIA trance mediumship and ELF (extremely low frequency) waves and their effect on the brain.

At Lab 9, Puharich worked with a faraday cage, a large cage that blocks electrostatic and electromagnetic influences. Puharich found that when a subject was placed inside the faraday cage and a certain level of specially controlled electromagnetic waves were sent through the cage, the subjects ESP abilities were heightened significantly. He conducted what some have called inhumane, psychological experiments on human subjects. Lab 9, like The Round Table Foundation, began to attract people from all walks of life.

Shrouded in controversry, the new film on the life of Dr. Andrija Puharich that we are producing will show what Lab 9 was really like, using never before seen photos, videos and transcripts. In 1978, a mysterious attempt to burn down Lab 9 was made. The town of Ossining ruled it arson. Puharich's publisher, Doubleday, was also broken into at this time and the manuscript he was working on was destroyed. Was someone out to get Puharich, to discredit and sabotage his work? If so, who? People who were present at Lab 9 at the time of the infamous fire will weigh in on what really happened, which to this day is unsolved.

Combo Mystery: Missing Person, Organization, and Book, All Related

Person: Dr. Floyd S. Graham, Sr. **Organizations:** Radionic Laboratories and Radiant Associates, Inc. founded by Floyd S. Graham, Sr. **Book:** The Radiant Era, by Floyd S. Graham. Sr.

This is our first "Combo Mystery" of a missing person, the organization(s) he founded, and the book that he wrote. The organization "Radionic Laboratories" was referred to in the American Society of Dowsers Quarterly Digest, Vol. 4, No. 2 (May, 1964), page 22, in a letter to the editor, by Dr. Floyd S. Graham, Jr. It indicated that Dr. Graham was the president of the "International Headquarters Unit" of "Radionic Laboratories", located in the small town of Tumtum, Washington, which is located northwest of Spokane, WA. The letter was signed "Radiant Associates, Inc.".

These names suggest that there may have been two different organizations, or that the "Radionic Laboratories" was part of the corporation, "Radiant Associates, Inc. However, I checked my database of incorporated organizations, which covers both profit and non-profit corporations, operating or defunct, that have been formed in the United States and worldwide since the early 1900's, and neither name was shown as ever having existed in the State of Washington. But since the letter was written and published in 1964, there is little doubt that Dr. Graham and the organization entities he mentioned did exist at that time in Tumtum, WA.

A further mystery related to Dr. Graham is the booklet he wrote titled, "The Radiant Era", date and place of publication unknown. It is being offered for sale online, with a photo, as shown at left. It is said to be published by the Journal of Natural Living, and is 22 pages long, stapled, and sized 6.75 by 7.75 inches.

However, a check of the WorldCat database, which lists the holdings of every library in the United States, Canada, and the UK, including the Library of Congress and the famous British Library (AKA British Museum Library), shows that this booklet by Dr. Graham is not located in any known library.

So if you know anything about Dr. Floyd S. Graham, Sr., the Radionic Laboratories, or Radiant Associates, Inc., in Tumtum, Washington, or anything



about his booklet, The Radiant Era, please contact the editor, John H. Reed, at: joreed43@gmail.com. Missing Devices:

1. The AGRAD Machine: In the 1970's Mankind Research Unlimited, Inc.(MRU), headed by Dr. Carl Scleicher, was offering for sale a device called the AGRAD Machine. It was intended to be used in the electromagnetic treatment of crops and the control of insect populations, and sold for \$390.00. MRU claimed that AGRAD machines had been used for several years by MRU researchers to conduct experimental applications of the type described in The Secret Life of Plants by Christopher Bird and Peter Tompkins, and Report on Radionics by Edward W. Russell. Theoretically, the AGRAD machine was intended to produce effects through electromagnetic wavefronts that would interact with and control insects by disturbing the insect sensor mechanisms. A photo of the device and additional information appeared in one of MRU's publications which you can access here.

Missing Organizations:

1. American Electronic Research Association (AERA): Albert Abrams established the American Electronic Research Association in the early 1920s and it continued to operate until at least 1935, when John F. Spaunhurst was the president of AERA, according to the 1935 Edition of Who's Who Among

Association Executives. The AERA published the monthly Journal of the American Electronic Research Association from 1924 through some point in 1936, when it ceased publication, according to Harvard University records.. Only two libraries in the world are known to have issues of this periodical. There are only two issues in the Harvard University Medical School Library, and the Kirkwood School of Osteopathic Medicine has one issue. If you know anything about this organization, or happen to have any issues of its journal, please contact the USPA Journal and Newsletter editor, John Reed at: joreed43@gmail.com.

2. International Association for Psychotronic Research (IAPR): Does anyone know what became of the International Association for Psychotronic Research? And do any of you have copies of its meeting proceedings or newsletter, if such a newsletter were published? It was founded in 1973, even before the United States Psychotronic Association (USPA), which was founded in 1975. However, the current location or activities of the IAPR are unknown.

The IAPR held numerous international conferences around the world, beginning with its first in 1974 in Prague, then Czechoslovakia. At this conference, Dr. Zdenek Rejdak was elected president for the Eastern Division of the IAPR, and Dr. Stanley Krippner was elected president for the West. The 8th International Conference on Psychotronic Research was held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 1993, as a joint conference with the United States Psychotronics Association (USPA), but it is unknown if any subsequent conferences of the IAPR were held.

Proceedings of each of these conferences were published. If copies of these proceedings can be obtained, or any newsletters that it may have published, we will add them to the USPA Library and make them available to USPA members. 3. International Radionics Association (IRA): Does anyone know anything about the International Radionics Association (IRA), which was located in Springfield, Missouri in the late 1940s. This is known, because a book called The Truth about Radionics was published in 1947 by this organization, and although the author's name is anonymous, it is highly probable that the author was T. Galen Hieronymus, who passed away many years ago.

I checked several newspaper databases, and references to this organization were found in the press as far back as the early 1930s, and as late as the early 1960s, but nothing more recent than that. If you have any knowledge about this organization, please write to the editor at: joreed43@gmail.com

- 1. Paul Sauvin, USPA 2nd Vice Pes., 1976 and 1st Vice Pres., 1977. Paul Sauvin, whose full name is Pierre Paul Sauvin, is an electrical engineer and inventor who, according to one source, worked in the aerospace industry and later with the National Institute for Rehabilitation Engineering at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paterson, NJ. He also worked with Dr. Carl Schleicher, head of Mankind Research Unlimited, and helped develop a device called the "AGRAD Machine". This device was designed to control crop insects, and was introduced on an experimental basis, although it is not known if it ever reached commercial production. Paul Sauvin's mother was Edith Sauvin, who lived in White Plains, NY, and died August 25th, 1987. Edith's only child was Pierre Paul Sauvin, who himself had 2 sons, Alan Paul Sauvin and Steven Eric Sauvin. He also had one daughter, Jane Elizabeth

Missing Pages of a Book

The book, Relationship Between Parapsychology and Gravity, Vol. 3 of Handbook of Unusual Energies, by J.G. Gallimore, was published by Borderland Sciences in the 1970's, although the date of publication and copyright date were not noted in this book. The USPA has this book in its library, and plans to republish it for the Gallimore family, but unfortunately, pages 208 and 209 are missing from the printed book. It appears that this is a publisher printing error, because page 210 is printed on the back side of page 207. However, it is possible that pages 208 and 209 were missing from the manuscript when it was sent to Borderlands for publication. Or these pages of the manuscript may have been inadvertently lost by the publisher, or possibly they were intentionally removed by someone from the manuscript prior to publication.

I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the books and monograph holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere in the world. - <u>1.</u> British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics: Does anyone have any issues of The British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics. It was published in London, England, by the British Radiesthesia Association, 1953-1963. The original title was British Journal of Radiesthesia, published from 1953-1957. No libraries in the United States, public or university, have this journal in their collection., and only five libraries elsewhere in the world are known to have any issues at all: The British Museum Library (AKA The British Library), Oxford, Cambridge, the National Library of Scotland, and Trinity College Library, in Dublin Ireland. If you have any issues of this periodical, will you please let me know? And for our members and associates in The UK and Irelad, if you can access these periodicals at any of the above libraries, you would do a huge service for all of us if you would Xerox what issues are available and send them to me. A generous donor has offered to pay whatever expenses are involved for doing this service. We will add them to the USPA Library and make them available to researchers. - <u>Journal of Scientific Controversy</u>. This periodical was referred to on <u>page 49</u> of the Vol. 1, No. 1 (Spring, 1967) issue of the INFO: The Journal of the International Fortean Organization. Someone was trying to find out about it even then, 49 years ago, and said that this journal was "formerly published in Boulder, Colorado" implying that it may have ceased publication prior to 1967, or that it moved somewhere else after being published for a period of time in Boulder. I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the periodical holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere overseas. But this title, or anything close to it does not exist in the WorldCat database, so that indicates that this

periodical title is not held in any library, even special collections, which are also included in WorldCat. However, this does not mean that the periodical does not exist, since many periodicals in the psychotronics, scientific anomalies and similar fields are excluded from libraries.

Missing Books:

Rhea White and Larissa Vilenskaya wrote a book titled Parapsychology in the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe, and China: A Compendium of Information. It was supposedly published by Scarecrow Press of Metuchen, NJ, a well know publisher of reference books. This book was listed as reference work #680 on page 213 of Rhea White's book, Parapsychology: New Sources of Information, 1973-1989, also published by Scarecrow Press. I called the publisher, and they said they have never published this book, and know nothing about it. As you can see from entry #680, Rhea White noted that this book was "in press", so it may have been in a preparation stage, but the manuscript may never have been sent to Scarecrow Press.

Again, I have searched the WorldCat, which shows books and monograph holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere in the world. But this book title does not exist in the WorldCat database, which indicates that this book is not held in any library, even special collections, which are also included in WorldCat. Unfortunately, I was unable to ask either of the authors about this, since both have passed away.

Rhea White was a well known parapsychology researcher, so some of you may have known her or heard her speak of the missing book manuscript that she was working on. Larissa Vilenskaya was from Russia, but lived and worked in the San Francisco area, and she was a prolific researcher on Russian and Eastern European psychotronics research. Patents Relating to Radionics and Dowsing — 2017 update

(This article is modified from the original since the accessing of patents is now available from worldwide.espacenet.com/ rather than from the British Patent Office and the instructions on the site are clear and simple and no further explanation is therefore necessary here).

Since the Patent Office has gone on-line (www.ipo.gov.uk) patents are now available over the Internet. The earliest patents that are available will depend on the country but for Britain patents earlier than 1920, which was the cut off date at start up and at the time of the original publication of this file (2003), are now available. The files are best accessed through worldwide.espacenet.com/. The US Patent office is also on-line at patft.uspto.gov/. A number of patents from around the world are also available although not all are available as a full description. Some patents have 'equivalents' where they have been taken up in a number of countries.

Below is a list of ones I have located but locating relevant ones requires putting in the correct key-words and it is almost certain that there are others of interest that I have missed. I have generally only included those for which at least an English abstract is available and the titles of non-English texts are normally given in English. There are a number from Russia and the far east with no English translation available. Most refer to dowsing devices and ways to neutralise geopathic stress. If readers know of others then please let me know, as I will add them to the list. Letters to the office at Baerlein House over the years are testament to interest, particularly for researchers, in the patents available. It is quite clear that by far and away the most common area for patents related to our dowsing interests is prevention of geopathic stress by interference with 'earth rays' or grids.

Bio-Electrical Reactions to Color, Sound, and Frequency Waves... The Components of a Closed System

othing exists in physical reality that has not first existed in the mind as an idea, a thought form, a fear, or an experience. If the mind and the body are an electrical system, then through modern electronics can we not tune the physical world to be more desirable? Perhaps then we can tune the electrical system of the body to be more receptive to conscious direction from the mind; to take creations in the mind and make them real.

I am going to share with you some experiences and techniques that hopefully you can use in your own work to improve guided visualization results, and even achieve the abatement of disease symptoms.

Dr. Jonas Salk said that the mind, in addition to medicine, has the power to turn the immune system around to defend the body against disease or illness. We all know someone who worries about being sick — and every time you turn around there they are, sick again. Don't you also know people who *never* get sick because they don't have time for it?

Regressive Hypnosis

I have been doing hypnotic regressions for over ten years and many times have seen physical changes in the body as a result of the subject's visualization exercises in conjunction with remembered experiences. A young girl I worked with broke out in hives and sneezed every time she got close to horses. Her remembered experience was being trampled to death by horses on a dusty track, while big flies were biting her. Once she had related the details of this experience she released the control it had over her and she no longer broke out in hives around horses.

To relive is to relieve is an old adage from Freudian psychology. Once the subject recognizes the relationship between the experience and the pattern, they can release the control that experience has over them.

Usually the subject learned to get the results they wanted, but there were times when they did not. This has been the situation with both physical goals of the subject and non-physical goals. The state of hypnosis, or if you prefer, the depth of relaxation, has an definite effect on the results. A deep state is not required to obtain results but

it won't work if the subject is thinking about financial or domestic problems while they are trying to learn to apply self hypnosis and controlled visualization. The subject is always in control at whatever level, even though the facilitator continues to direct the consciousness of the subject.

I had used a cassette recorder to preserve the details of a regression until one time, right in the middle of a heavy traumatic experience, a women stopped talking about her experience and asked me to turn the recorder off. I did so and she went back to crying and talking about her experience as though there had been no interruption. I have had subjects sit up in the middle of a good regression and clearly state that they did not want to do that anymore.

One subject came to me with neck pains where no medical cause could be found. He went back to an experience where he had been hanged. I guided him up to his gallows three times before he would complete his hanging so that he could release that experience.

Body-Mind Relationships

Traditional science is accepting more and more the relationship between what we believe and the physical state or health of the human body. This is evidenced quite frequently in magazine and newspaper articles and other media presentations. *TIME* magazine has carried articles on Carl Simonton's work with terminal cancer patients using guided imagery. The *Smithsonian* recently had a story on the way thought affects the brain cells.

My first experience with the body mind relationship was in 1977 while I was working with a subject who wanted to learn to relax. I was going over some visualization exercises with him and he could not sit still very long because he kept scratching his left ankle. When I asked him about it he said he had psoriasis there. As part of the visualization I suggested that he visualize his right ankle, where the skin was clear and smooth. When he could see it clearly in his mind's eye, I suggested that he visualize his left ankle, where the psoriasis was. When he could see that, I suggested he perceive the left ankle change until it was clear and smooth like the right one. The process was slow and clumsy, but it worked; and we both learned from it. Since

then I have developed straightforward procedures that work well with a variety of symptoms. These manifest in patterns that range from nightmares to physical handicaps.

The depth a subject can readily reach is determined by many factors: how easily they can relax, level of maturity and understanding, trust, suggestibility, and many more. A subject might relax easily and follow the visualization in a predictable manner but when traumatic experiences are remembered, lose their concentration. Most of the time I would notice the change and take appropriate action, but sometimes I would not. I needed a better way to determine the state of the subject. Something that would arouse my attention even if I was concentrating deeply with the subject.

Arm raising and testing for pain had long since gone out of style as a methods of testing. Watching the breathing and facial expressions usually worked: however, because they are under the subject's conscious control, they are not always conclusive. Bio-feedback devices such as GSR meters and brainwave monitors are helpful, but for some reason I was not able to measure the effect certain traumatic experiences were having on the body. Something was still missing — a factor I could not identify.

Father Ober helped fill in that missing factor for me at the USPA Conference in Dayton in 1988 when he presented his paper on the development of the Electro-Psycho-Meter. He was doing a lot of the same things I was doing with visualization techniques but he had a more reliable electronic device to measure a subject's emotional reactions. The factor I was missing, with the other biofeedback devices I was using, was the monitoring of involuntary muscle reactions.

To include an indicator of involuntary muscle reactions in my work, I dug out a plant monitor I had been building to measure changes in the electrical properties of a plant according to how the plant felt. I have a computer with a voice synthesizer and wanted to have my plants talk to me and tell me they needed water; or maybe I could get them to recognize me and other members of the household. I was using a diagram from the book *How to Build a Lie Detector*, *Brain Wave Monitor & Other Secret Parapsychological Electronics Devices*, by Mike & Ruth Wolverton, published by Tab Books, Inc.

I have since added several components to this circuitry to allow more control with different subjects and connections. It is basically a Whetstone bridge circuit built around an op-amp. I use a short piece of PVC pipe with copper wire wrapped around it for an electrode. The subject holds this electrode in one hand. I have used this body monitor with subjects who were concurrently connected to a GSR device, one that is available from a national electronics chain. Using verbiage that would prompt a predictable reaction, the body monitor showed responses that the GSR did not. The GSR was tested connected to several various parts of the body and showed the same results.

Sheri Edwards' presentation at the 1988 Conference aroused my interest in the effects that color and sound have on human emotions. I had been aware of these effects through books, experiments and other lectures, but was not currently using sound or color in my work.

Using the body monitor to measure the reactions, I then used my computer to generate tones for a subject. I varied these tones, one cycle at a time, until the subject found the one that was felt to be most pleasant. They also determined the one that annoyed them most. I verified the subject's indications with the body monitor responses.

I used another channel of the computer to generate a second tone three cycles higher than the first tone. This provided a beating effect, much the same as two lawn mowers running at about the same speed. I then varied this beat between one and ten cycles and found the one the subject liked best. If the subject did not prefer any of them then I left it at three cycles.


Again, using the body monitor to measure the responses, I set out to verify the effects colors have on a subject's emotions. Using verbiage selected to prompt predictable responses, the responses were quicker with some colors than with others. With subjects used so far, orange and yellow cause quicker responses than blue and indigo. Other studies have shown if you use an energy color—such as orange—body reactions will be faster than with a relaxing color like blue.

I filled the subjects visual awareness with different colors in several ways. The best way with one subject was to use gel filters on a slide projector. The color was projected on beaded movie screen and all the other lights turned out. The easiest way I found for several subjects was to use colored poster paper held up close to the subject's face so they can not see anything else. I have also used a slide projector with the lens modified with a quartz crystal, directing the subject to stare at the crystal. I have not made studies to see if any one method is more effective than another.

I then used the tone and colored light together on subjects I had worked with previously. There was a marked improvement in both the relaxation level of the subject and the results achieved. Subjects who had not achieved complete success at previous sessions did so with the tones and colors. If the subject had selected a beat frequency, and that beat was used during a regression, the subject relaxed easier. Other benefits of the beat frequency are still being studied.

Frequency Devices

After hearing and reading so much about Raymond Royal Rife's work with his microscope and diseases, I started using a Rife-type frequency device. The results were so interesting that I dug into the book *The Body Electric*, by Robert Becker and Gary Seldon, to gain a better understanding of the bio-electric nature of the body and electrical currents in living things.



With this awareness, I went back to the drawing board and came up with an amplifier and inductor system that I use to apply the same tones researched earlier for relaxation as a voltage to the subject. The subject hears and feels the same tone — not very loud and not very strong — just enough for the proper effects.

To connect the voltage to the body I used stainless steel plates, available from a local sheet metal supplier. I also made some pads from the black conductive foam used to protect electronic components from static electricity. Except when desirable to connect directly to a particular muscle, best results were obtained by resting the subject's feet on the pads. A damp paper towel aids conductivity.

Previously I used relaxing music or meditation tapes for background, mostly to cover up any distractions such as noisy cars going by, dogs barking, or the phone ringing in the other room. Now I use the particular tone that suits the subject and get quicker and deeper relaxation. By using the tones and frequency devices I have shortened the time required for each session and although it's hard to say for sure, I believe that subjects with patterns that would require 2 or 3 sessions without the tones are now achieving success with just one session. I use the body monitor to adjust the tone frequency while I talk to the subject about the area of their life they want to address. I try not to talk about problems. Talking about the pattern a subject wants to work on while adjusting the tones has an overall tuning effect that makes visualization more effective.

When the tone has been adjusted to be the most pleasing for the subject, a very common form of guided visualization is used to allow the subject to release their physical awareness and slide into communication with the subconscious. The subject is then directed to go to an earlier experience, another time and place, that relates to the area of their life they want to address. It never ceases to amaze me how easily people will come up with an experience that relates.

I have worked with weight loss as much as, or more than, anything else. When a person comes to me after going through several programs, several diets and sometimes even several doctors, I look for a deeper tie with their eating habits or physical appearance. One of the first clues is that they are continually trying something new. It works for a while, they lose weight and then they gain it back. Usually the same method of weight control won't work all the time.

The true source of the recall has never been important to my work. The fact that there is a remembered experience that the subject allows to control some facet of their life is what needs to be addressed. The source can be a combination of books, TV and real life situations. It could be from a past life, also. The important thing is that once the subject accepts the relationship between the past remembered experience and their behavior pattern they can release the control that experience has on their life.

Components of a Closed System

Bio-electrical monitoring and control between man and machines is established technology with current state of the art devices available from a number of sources. Many books and magazines have construction details to launch the experimenter into some useful and enlightening projects. The next step from my current work is a closed system where a computer monitors the physical and emotional state of a subject and varies the tone and voltage according to the responses of the subject.

If an experimenter was working with the specific frequencies and wave forms to abate distinct disease symptoms — and the subject was consciously directing the tones, color and voltages toward these symptoms — the computer could monitor and adjust swiftly and effectively to apply exactly the correct combination of modalities to abate these symptoms.

I hope some part of what I have been talking about you can take with you and use in your own work. A lot of you are better equipped than I am to connect devices like these together into a closed system. Build on this work; expand. Direct the creations of the mind and make them real.

Liboff, Araham R., "A Human Source for ELF Magnetic Perturbations" <u>Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine</u>, Volume 35, Issue 4 (2016), pp. 337-342

Abstract:

Current models that frame consciousness in terms of electromagnetic field theory carry implications that have yet to be fully explored. Endogenous weak extremely low frequency (ELF) magnetic fields are generated by ionic charge flow in axons, dendrites and synaptic transmitters. Because neural tissues are transparent to such fields, these provide the basis for the globally unifying qualities required to properly describe consciousness as a field. At the same time, however, an electromagnetic approach predicts partial transmission of this 1–100 nT field, suggesting external interactions similar to the various ELF magnetic perturbations that are linked to homeostatic and endocrine-related physiological effects. It follows that humans may represent an additional, previously unrecognized source of weak (1–10 nT) ambient ELF magnetic fields.

Abstract:

A novel property of DNA is described: the capacity of some bacterial DNA sequences to induce electromagnetic waves at high aqueous dilutions. It appears to be a resonance phenomenon triggered by the ambient electromagnetic background of very low frequency waves. The genomic DNA of most pathogenic bacteria contains sequences which are able to generate such signals. This opens the way to the development of highly sensitive detection system for chronic bacterial infections in human and animal diseases.



Abstract:

Objective and Context: This review was designed to assess the quality and review the outcomes of randomized controlled trials (RCTs) of biofield therapies (external qigong, Healing Touch, Johrei, Reiki, and Therapeutic Touch) that report using only nonphysical touch forms of treatment. RCTs of nonphysical contact biofield therapies have the potential to contribute to an evidence base for health promoting effects mediated through mechanisms outside the present understanding of biomedicine. **Methods:** Articles meeting inclusion criteria were identified from database and reference list searches and evaluated for a range of reporting and design items. Data were extracted to determine the range of protocol parameters and treatment outcomes. The final set of included RCTs were evaluated via a modified 5 item Jadad scale as well as by a set of 20 criteria that included items relevant to the early phase nature of the trials and to the examination of nonphysical touch biofield therapy interventions.

Results: Of 90 RCTs that assessed effectiveness of a biofield therapy in humans, 28 trials involving 1775 participants met additional inclusion criteria (most importantly a clearly reported use of only nonphysical contact treatment). The research designs of these 28 trials revealed marked heterogeneity in regard to condition treated, number and duration of treatments, nature of the control/comparison group, and outcome measures. Finally, 10 trials were excluded on the basis of low quality assessment scores. Twelve of the remaining 18 trials (7 Therapeutic Touch, 3 external qigong, 1 Reiki, and 1 Healing Touch) reported at least one primary outcome with statistically significant beneficial treatment outcomes.

Conclusions: The pilot study nature of essentially all the identified nonphysical contact biofield therapy RCTs, as reflected by low sample sizes alone, precludes drawing robust conclusions. Given this perspective, the finding that two thirds of the higherscoring trials demonstrated at least partial effectiveness favors a continued research effort, especially in light of the translational value of biofield clinical trials for studies exploring the nature and physiologic basis of biofield healing.





USPA Periodicals Library Update

In order to do good psychotronics research of any kind, whether it involves radionics, radiesthesia, psionic medicine, dowsing, subtle energies, biophotons, or any other subject covered by psychotronics, one needs access to as much of the periodical literature as possible on these subjects.

To address this issue, the United States Psychotronics Association has resolved to identify and acquire every psychotronics related periodical that has ever been published anywhere in the world, and to retain copies in the USPA Library.

As a first step, we have developed the following list of periodicals that focused on or frequently had articles on psychotronics related subjects. But this is only a preliminary list, and we know that there are probably more psychotronics periodicals that have been published, but that we do not yet know about.

So please look over the following list and check your own personal physical libraries and your computers to see if you have any issues of the periodicals on this list. Even if you just have one issue, please let us know, because that may be the one we need to complete all the issues of a particular periodical. Please write to me (John) at: joreed43@gmail.com, since I am the USPA librarian and archivist coordinating this effort, and tell me what periodicals you have.

As a whole, the members of USPA have a huge "library" of periodicals, but it just happens to be "distributed" among its members at this point in time. However, we can work together, and if you would be willing to loan, donate, xerox, or as a last resort, sell copies of your periodicals for the USPA Library, then we will be able to build a large centralized library of all psychotronics periodicals. And all USPA members will then be able to use these periodicals in their research or for their reading enjoyment.

American Journal of Electromedicine: Daniel Kirsch Ph.D., developer of Alpha-Stim Craniotherapy Electrical Stimulation (CES) was the first editor; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

American Radio Therapy Society Journal: This was a periodical published in Hollywood, California, by the American Radio Therapy Society, which had been founded by Dr. Ruth Drown in 1949. This periodical began with vol. 1, no. 1 in June, 1949, and continued to be published for a period of time. However, it is not known when it ceased publication or how many issued were published, but presumably it ceased sometime before Dr. Drown's death in 1963. This journal focused on radionics psychotronics subjects, and had no interest in ionizing radiation therapies, such as x-ray therapy, which were also known as "radio therapy" at that time. The only library in the world that has copies of this periodical is the National Library of Medicine in Bethesda, Maryland. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

BEMI Currents: BEMI Currents was a quarterly journal published by the Bio-Electro-Magnetics Institute in Reno, Nevada, from 1989-1993. The editor was Dr. John Zimmerman. This journal began with vol. 1, no. 1 (Spring, 1989) and continued through Vol. 3, no. 4 (March, 1993), after which it ceased publication. **A total of 12 issues were published, and the USPA Library has all 12 issues in its collection.**

Bioeffects Newsletter: This was a periodical that was published by the "Physiology Program", Office of Naval Research, in Arlington, Virginia, and focused on the biological effects of electromagnetic fields. It probably began sometime in the 1977, because it is known that Issue #5 was dated April, 1978. The Bieffects Newsletter is believed to have ceased publication when the Bioelectromagnetics Society (BEMS) was formed in 1978, because it was edited by Thomas Rozzell, who served as the editor of the BEMS Newsletter for the Bioelectromagnetics Society. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is undoubtedly in a number of private collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Bioelectric Medicine: Journal founded in 2014, Kevin Tracey, M.D., President of the Feinstein Institute for Medical Research, which has established a Center for Bioelectronic Medicine; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

BioElectroMagnetics: Published by John Wiley and Sons from Vol. 1, No. 1 (1980) to present. We need all issues. All articles are freely available online at Johns Hopkins, back to 1980; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Bridges: This was the newsmagazine of the International Society for the Study of Subtle Energies & Energy Medicine (ISSSEEM) from 1990 through the present. The USPA Library has a complete set of this periodical from vol. 1, no 1 (Spring, 1990) through the present.

British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics. Published by the British Radiesthesia Association, 1953-1963. The original title was British Journal of Radiesthesia. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

DeLaWarr Laboratories Newsletter: published by George and Marjorie DeLaWarr, and later their daughter Diana Di Pinto, from 1964-1986. **The USPA Library has a complete set of these, unless you know of any issues published after 1986.**

Dowsing Today: The journal of the British Society of Dowsers, published from 2000 to the present. Original title was Radio Perception, which began in 1933. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electro and Magnetobiology: Published by Taylor and Francis from 1993-2002. Title was changed to Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine: Published by Taylor and Francis from 2003-present. Former editor, Dr. Abe Liboff; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electronic Medical Digest: published 1946 to about 1955, also by Fred J. Hart and the College of Electronic Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Extension Bulletin, Electronic Medical Foundation: This was a series of bulletins published by the Electronic Medical Foundation of San Francisco, beginning in 1950. Thomas Colson was the editor, and at least three issues were published. It is not known if additional issues were published. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Bioelectricity: Published by Taylor and Francis from 1982-1992. Title was changed to Electro and Magnetobiology. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Electroceutical Medicine: founded by Richard Markoll, MD, PhD, Port d'Andratx (Majorca), Baleric Islands, Spain; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Electronic Medicine: This was a continuation of Physico-Clinical Medicine, and ran from 1939-1945, published by Fred J. Hart and the College of Electronic Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Paraphysics/International Journal of Paraphysics: Benson Herbert started his Paraphysical Laboratory in Downton, Wiltshire, England and began publishing the Journal of Paraphysics with vol.1, no.1 in 1967, and the name was later changed to International Journal of Paraphysics. Herbert published the Journal from 1967 until around 1989, with the last volume being vol. 23 in that year. Since the Journal and Lab were mostly the project of Herbert, they fell apart as his health failed and have become defunct. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Journal of the American Electronic Research Association: Vol 1, No. 1 (January, 1924) through Vol. 13, No. ??? (1936), when it ceased publication; The USPA Library needs all issues.

Journal of the British Society of Dowsers: Published by the British Society of Dowsers from 1956-2000. Prior title was **Radio Perception**. Succeeding title: **Dowsing Today**. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

Journal of the United States Psychotronics Association. Published by the United States Psychotronics Association. Only six issues were published, and the USPA Library has a complete set.

Little Farm Journal: This periodical was published by Lutie Larsen and Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah, and focused on agruchtural radionics and related subjects. It began sometime before the first issue of The Radionic Homestead Report, which was published in May, 1988, because that issue referred to the Little Farm Journal. It is not known when it began publishing, how many issues were published, or when it ceased publication. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is

undoubtedly in a number of private individuals' collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Mind and Matter: published by George DeLaWarr of the DeLawarr Laboratories in Oxford, England from 1957-1967. **The USPA Library has a complete set of these very rare journals.**

Newsletter of the Institute of Psionic Medicine. Published by the Institute of Psionic Medicine only from 1978-1979. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Newsheet of the Psionic Medical Society. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the England only from 1975-1977. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics Journal. Published by the New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics from 1988-present. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

Physico-Clinical Medicine: This journal was started in 1916 by the father of radionics, Dr. Albert Abrams, and continued to be published up through 1938, by Fred J. Hart, who took over the College of Electronic Medicine after Abrams died in 1924. The USPA Library has all issues from 1916-1923, but need all issues from 1925-1938.

Psionic Medicine. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the UK from 1969-around 1991. The USPA Library needs most issues.

Psychic Research Neswletter (Marcel Vogel): Volume 1, No. 1 (May-June, 1984) through Vol. 5, No. 4 (July-August, 1988) This is the periodical that Marcel Vogel published in the 1980's as part of his research organization, Psychic Research, Inc. in San Jose, California. The title of the periodical is really a misnomer, as is the name of hiresearch organization, because the periodical deals almost exclusively with Vogel's and other's research on crystals and their use in healing, and very little with psychic matters. **The USPA Library has all known issues.**

Radio Perception. This was the original title of the Journal of the British Society of Dowsers, which began in 1933 and was published under that name until around 1956, when its name was changed to the Journal of the British Society of Dowsers, and continues today under the name, Dowsing Today. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Radiesthesia. Published by the Dowser's Club of South Australia, and began in 1992. The USPA Library needs all issues.

Radionics Journal: Published by the Radionics Association in England from 1954 through the present. The USPA Library has a complete set of these from Vol. 1, no. 1 (1954), through 2005, but needs all issues published after 2005.

Radionics Network Newsletter: Vol. 1, No. 1 (January-February, 1993); Last Known issue: Vol. 4, No. 6 (November-December, 1996); Published by the Radionics Network, New South Wales, Australia; The USPA Library has Vol.1, No.1 (Jan.-Feb., 1993) through Vol.5, No.1 (Jan.-Feb., 1997), but needs all issues published since then.

Resonance: Newsletter of the Bioelectromagnetics Special Interest Group (BEM SIG) of American Mensa during the 1980s and 1990s. **The USPA Library has a complete set of this rare periodical**;

Subtle Energies and Energy Medicine: Published by the International Society for the Study of Subtle Energies and Energy Medicine (ISSSEEM) from 1990 through the present, with some interruptions. **The USPA Library needs most of the issues of this periodical**;

The Radiant News: Vol. 1, Issue 0 [zero] (March, 2001) through Vol. 1, No. 12 (May, 2002), after which it ceased publication. Published by Peter Lindemann of Clear Tech, Inc. **The USPA Library has all 13 issues.**

The Radionic Homestead Report: This periodical was a periodical published by Lutie Larsen and Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah. It began with the first issue being May, 1988. It is not known how many issues were published, or when it ceased publication. The USPA Library needs all issues, except the first issue (May, 1988) and vol. 3, no. 4 (August-September, 1990), which are the only two issues in the USPA Library.

USPA Newsletter: Published by the United States Psychotronic Association from 1977 through present. **The USPA Library needs most of these issues.**

Zeitschrift RGS (Radiesthesie - Geopathie - Strahlenbiologie); (Journal of Radiesthesia, Geopathy, and Radiation Biology): This was a radiesthesia and radionics periodical published by the Schweizerische Gesellschaft für Radiästhesie (Swiss Society of Radiesthesia) in St. Gallen, Switzerland. It began publishing around 1949, although the date is uncertain, and the title was changed at some point to "Schweizerische Zeitschrift für Radiästhesie, Radionik, Geopathie, Strahlenbiologie" (Swiss Journal of Radiesthesia, Radionics, Geopathy, and Radiation Biology). It was still being published in 2014, with issue No. 291 being published during that year. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

USPA Local Groups and Affiliates Update
