

A Week for Youth

at Little Farm June 4-10, 2017

This USPA sponsored event is hosted by Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah. It will be held the week of June 4-10, 2017. It is focused primarily on youth ages 8-20 who have an interest in growing food crops; farming, market or community gardening or to develop family gardening skills.

The system used at Little Farm is sustainable, natural and organic, using zero refined agricultural products. Furthermore techniques applied to improve produce quality are determined and largely applied energetically using radionic technique. The environment at the Farm is wholesome and balanced.

We can accept up to 20 young people (and their accompanying chaperones) for this educational week. Applications are now being accepted by Lutie Larsen at lutielarsen@mac.com. or mailed to 993 West 1800 North, Pleasant Grove, UT 84062. These will be reviewed and responded to as soon as they are received. Any questions or further information about the program can also be directed to this same email.

For the youth involved in this event there is no charge. It is a gift, but many will need to find sponsors for transportation costs to get to Little Farm. Chaperones will help with this. Chaperones are also invited to participate during the week and take their meals and lodging with us. There are a variety of lodging options but we are keeping the costs minimal.

From 1991 until 2011 Little Farm sponsored a local youth apprentice program each summer. We have an excellent curriculum for teaching young people the basic skills of sustainable soil management, planting and transplanting techniques, soil building and composting methods as well as integrative growing for intensive production. The afternoons will be focused on using radionics to evaluate and create Balancing strategies for seed plant and soil.

It is our hope that this week will spark new ideas in our youth and give them tools to better the way we grow and manage our food supplies. At LFR we are excited to be preparing for you.



Newly Discovered Psychotronics Related Organizations and Periodicals: May, 2017

A number of newly discovered psychotronics related organizations and periodicals have been discovered since the last issue of the USPA Journal and Newsletter. These organizations and periodicals, some of which ceased operation many years ago, are listed below, with brief information. If you know anything about these organizations, please contact the editor. The periodicals have been added to the master list of psychotronics periodicals in the USPA Periodicals Library section of this journal. We are seeking copies of all issues of these periodicals, which we plan to digitize and make available to our members as a USPA membership benefit. So if you have any issues the periodicals listed below or any of the missing issues of the periodicals listed in the USPA Periodicals Library section of this Journal, please let the editor know by emailing him at: joreed43@gmail.com.

Organizations:

Royal Rife Research Society (RRRS): The RRRS was an organization that is believed to have been founded in the early 1990's. Their mailed literature in December, 1993, showed the address: Suite 4, 4677 30th Street, San Diego, CA 92116. However, this literature also stated that the RRRS was actually located in Baja California, Mexico, and that the San Diego address was only being used for the convenience of US members. In August, 1995, the US address of the RRRS had changed to 7040 Avenida Encinas, #104-291, Carlsbad, California 92009-4698. The RRRS published a periodical called "Journal of Bioenergetic Research", with issue vol. 1, no. 3 being for November, 1992.

International Radionic Association (IRA): The IRA was an organization founded in the late 1920's or early 1930's at a convention of Calbro-Magnowave owners. The Calbro-Magnowave was an early radionics device. The address of the IRA was 615 East Walnut Street, Springfield, Missouri, according to a 1947 IRA monograph publication. The IRA discontinued operations in the late 1950's or early 1960's. It is not known if it ever published a periodical of any kind.

Japan Psychotronics Institute (JPI): This was an organization operating in Tsukubashi Ibaraki, Japan, in the 1990's, although it is not known when the JPI was founded, or if it still is in operation. The president in 1993 was Shiuji Inomata, Ph.D., who was a senior scientist at the at the Electrotechnical Laboratory in Tsukuba-shi Ibaraki. The JPI published a periodical called "JPI News".

Periodicals:

Psychoenergetic Systems: This periodical was published by Gordon & Breach Science Publications in New York City, and focused on psychotronic related subjects. It began with vol. 1, no. 1 in December, 1974, and continued with this title until 1981, when the title was changed to "Psychoenergetics" (ISSN: 0278-6060) with the April, 1981, issue. It then continued under this title until 1988, when the title was again changed to "Theoretical Parapsychology" (ISSN: 0894-2528). However, only one issue (vol. 6, no. 1) was ever published under this title, after which it ceased publication. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Psychotronik: This periodical was published in Innsbruch, Austria, and focused on radionics and psychotronics related subjects. It began with Vol. 1, No. 1 in 1977, but ceased with Vol. 3 in 1979. **The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.**

Energy & Character - Journal of Bioenergetic Research: This was a periodical published by Abbotsbury Publications, Dorset, England, UK, and focused on psychotronic related subjects, especially orgone energy and Wilhelm Reich's research. It began with vol. 1, no. 1 (January, 1970), and continued publishing 3 times per year for 38 years, but ceased publication with volume 37 in 2009. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Short News, Notes, and Queries

(If anyone would like to make a short news announcement, report something, has a question about anything related to psychotronics and related subjects, or has any information or comments about any of the following notes and queries, please write to the editor, John Reed at: joreed43@gmail.com)

- 1. Art Tool and Die Company: Does anyone know anything about the Art Tool and Die Company that was located in Detroit, Michigan, in the 1930s and 1940s, and apparently manufactured radionics devices? It has been referred to in a number of publications on radionics, psychotronics, and related subjects, but it is not clear what devices they manufactured.
- 2. Mangrove College for Radionics: Does anyone know anything about the Mangrove College for Radionics, and if it ever published a periodical of any kind? Its address at one time was: 1313 N. Market St., Hercules Plaza Suite 3410, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, although this appears to be a mail box service location. It was once headed by a Dr. P. W. Meier.
- 3. Duncan Laurie, author of the excellent book, <u>The Secret Art: A Brief History of Radionic Technology for the Creative Individual</u>, recently sent USPA an online article titled <u>"Sick Frequencies: Behind Radionics, the Wacky Sound Therapy That Turns Thoughts into Music."</u> This article, written by Tom Howells in March, 2017, is all about Daniel Wilson and his "Radionics Radio Project" where he creates electronic music from human thoughts.
- 4. Were you ever a member of the Electronic Medicine Association (EMA) or know anyone who was? According to online sources, this organization was co-founded by Peter Moscow (US), former president of the USPA, and John Morley-Kirk (UK) and was incorporated in the United Kingdom in 2001. (UK Company number 04223137). From 2001 through 2010, the EMA held numerous seminars, workshops, and conferences, and may have published a newsletter or journal, although this is uncertain.

Unfortunately both Peter Moscow and John Morley-Kirk died in 2011, and records show that the organization was officially dissolved in the United Kingdom in October of 2011. A number of people have indicated that they would like to revive this organization, and we are attempting to locate all former members. So if you have any interest in this, or by chance have an old membership list, please write to the editor, John H. Reed, M.D. (joreed43@gmail.com), so that I can contact the former members to see if they would be interested in resurrecting this organization, or starting a new one with a similar mission.

Do any of you happen to know anything about the Paraphysical Laboratory that was founded in the UK by Benson Herbert in 1966, or have any issues of the Journal of Paraphysics that he published for more than 20 years. Mr. Herbert's laboratory was located at Privett Farm, Downton, Wiltshire, England, between Salisbury and Southhampton. His mission included an attempt to provide a workable theory and physical explanation for paranormal phenomena, including telepathy, remote viewing, dowsing, and other extraordinary abilities and phenomena. Unfortunately, Benson Herbert died in 1991, and no one seems to know what became of the papers and records of the laboratory, or if he even had any family, who might be able to shed light on this. 





Missing Book: Dr. Stefan Manczarsk's book, <u>The Problem of Thought Transference in the Light of Radio-Technical Investigations</u>, 1945 English version

Has anyone ever seen the book, The Problem of Thought Transference in the Light of Radio-Technical Investigations, by Stefan Manczarsk, published in England in 1945, in which he discussed at length how telepathy, dowsing, and other phenomena might physically occur?

There are at least two references that state that this book was published in England in 1945, apparently in English:

- 1) A 1962 issue of International Journal of Parapsychology
- 2) In Daniel S. Halacy's 1966 book, Radiation, Magnetism and Living Things page 103

The problem with the 1945 publication date is that this book was originally published in Polish in Warsaw, Poland, in 1946, and the only library in the world that has the Polish version is the National Library of Poland. It is not in any library in the US or UK, including the Library of Congress and the British National Library (formerly British Museum Library). Also, it is not recorded in the British copyright office. It is highly unlikely that Manczarsk would have had the manuscript translated into English, and published in England before he published it in his native language and country of Poland. So the two references above are probably in error, but stranger things in the publishing world have happened.

I have been able to determine that this book was serialized in 1946-47 in six issues of the Polish periodical, Przegląd Telekomunikacyjny: miesięcznik poświęcony sprawom telefonji, telegrafji, sygnalizacji, radja (Telecommunication Review: monthly magazine devoted to matters of telephony, telegraphy, signaling, radio) 1946, No. 10, 11, 12 and 1947, No. 1, 2, and 3.

It would be very useful if this book were indeed published in English, because Mancsarsk was an important, but little known researcher on antennas and EM waves, and it would be extremely interesting to see his thoughts on the physical explanation of dowsing, thought transference, and other phenomena.

Andrija Puharich's Lost Manuscript and other Puharich Mysteries by Greg Mallozzi

During the late 60s and into the 70s, Puharich owned and worked out of a large house in rural Ossining, New York. A home laboratory known as Lab 9. Lab 9 produced the most mysterious and far out work that Puharich was involved in when he began to delve deeper and deeper into parapsychological, experimental research: like alleged communication with extraterrestrial beings VIA trance mediumship and ELF (extremely low frequency) waves and their effect on the brain.

At Lab 9, Puharich worked with a faraday cage, a large cage that blocks electrostatic and electromagnetic influences. Puharich found that when a subject was placed inside

the faraday cage and a certain level of specially controlled electromagnetic waves were sent through the cage, the subjects ESP abilities were heightened significantly. He conducted what some have called inhumane, psychological experiments on human subjects. Lab 9, like The Round Table Foundation, began to attract people from all walks of life.

Shrouded in controversry, the new film on the life of Dr. Andrija Puharich that we are producing will show what Lab 9 was really like, using never before seen photos, videos and transcripts. In 1978, a mysterious attempt to burn down Lab 9 was made. The town of Ossining ruled it arson. Puharich's publisher, Doubleday, was also broken into at this time and the manuscript he was working on was destroyed. Was someone out to get Puharich, to discredit and sabotage his work? If so, who? People who were present at Lab 9 at the time of the infamous fire will weigh in on what really happened, which to this day is unsolved.

Combo Mystery: Missing Person, Organization, and Book, All Related

Person: Dr. Floyd S. Graham, Sr. **Organizations:** Radionic Laboratories and Radiant Associates, Inc. founded by Floyd S. Graham, Sr. **Book:** The Radiant Era, by Floyd S. Graham, Sr.

This is our first "Combo Mystery" of a missing person, the organization(s) he founded, and the book that he wrote. The organization "Radionic Laboratories" was referred to in the American Society of Dowsers Quarterly Digest, Vol. 4, No. 2 (May, 1964), page 22, in a letter to the editor, by Dr. Floyd S. Graham, Jr. It indicated that Dr. Graham was the president of the "International Headquarters Unit" of "Radionic Laboratories", located in the small town of Tumtum, Washington, which is located northwest of Spokane, WA. The letter was signed "Radiant Associates, Inc.".

These names suggest that there may have been two different organizations, or that the "Radionic Laboratories" was part of the corporation, "Radiant Associates, Inc. However, I checked my database of incorporated organizations, which covers both profit and non-profit corporations, operating or defunct, that have been formed in the United States and worldwide since the early 1900's, and neither name was shown as ever having existed in the State of Washington. But since the letter was written and published in 1964, there is little doubt that Dr. Graham and the organization entities he mentioned did exist at that time in Tumtum. WA.

A further mystery related to Dr. Graham is the booklet he wrote titled, "The Radiant Era", date and place of publication unknown. It is being offered for sale online, with a photo, as shown at left. It is said to be published by the Journal of Natural Living, and is 22 pages long, stapled, and sized 6.75 by 7.75 inches.

However, a check of the WorldCat database, which lists the holdings of every library in the United States, Canada, and the UK, including the Library of Congress and the famous British Library (AKA British Museum Library), shows that this booklet by Dr. Graham is not located in any known library.

Missing Devices:

1. The AGRAD Machine: In the 1970's Mankind Research Unlimited, Inc.(MRU), headed by Dr. Carl Scleicher, was offering for sale a device called the AGRAD Machine. It was intended to be used in the electromagnetic treatment of crops and the control of insect populations, and sold for \$390.00. MRU claimed that AGRAD machines had been used for several years by MRU researchers to conduct experimental applications of the type described in The Secret Life of Plants by Christopher Bird and Peter Tompkins, and Report on Radionics by Edward W. Russell. Theoretically, the AGRAD machine was intended to produce effects through electromagnetic wavefronts that would interact with and control insects by disturbing the insect sensor mechanisms. A photo of the device and additional information appeared in one of MRU's publications which you can access here.

Missing Organizations:

1. American Electronic Research Association (AERA): Albert Abrams established the American Electronic Research Association in the early 1920s and it continued to operate until at least 1935, when John F. Spaunhurst was the president of AERA, according to the 1935 Edition of Who's Who Among Association Executives. The AERA published the monthly Journal of the American Electronic Research Association from 1924 through some point in

1936, when it ceased publication, according to Harvard University records.. Only two libraries in the world are known to have issues of this periodical. There are only two issues in the Harvard University Medical School Library, and the Kirkwood School of Osteopathic Medicine has one issue. 2. International Association for Psychotronic Research (IAPR): Does anyone know what became of the International Association for Psychotronic Research? And do any of you have copies of its meeting proceedings or newsletter, if such a newsletter were published? It was founded in 1973, even before the United States Psychotronic Association (USPA), which was founded in 1975. However, the current location or activities of the IAPR are unknown.

The IAPR held numerous international conferences around the world, beginning with its first in 1974 in Prague, then Czechoslovakia. At this conference, Dr. Zdenek Rejdak was elected president for the Eastern Division of the IAPR, and Dr. Stanley Krippner was elected president for the West. The 8th International Conference on Psychotronic Research was held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 1993, as a joint conference with the United States Psychotronics Association (USPA), but it is unknown if any subsequent conferences of the IAPR were held.

Proceedings of each of these conferences were published. If copies of these proceedings can be obtained, or any newsletters that it may have published, we will add them to the USPA Library and make them available to USPA members. 3. International Radionics Association (IRA): Does anyone know anything about the International Radionics Association (IRA), which was located in Springfield, Missouri in the late 1940s. This is known, because a book called The Truth about Radionics was published in 1947 by this organization, and although the author's name is anonymous, it is highly probable that the author was T. Galen Hieronymus, who passed away many years ago.

- 1. Paul Sauvin, USPA 2nd Vice Pes., 1976 and 1st Vice Pres., 1977. Paul Sauvin, whose full name is Pierre Paul Sauvin, is an electrical engineer and inventor who, according to one source, worked in the aerospace industry and later with the National Institute for Rehabilitation Engineering at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paterson, NJ. He also worked with Dr. Carl Schleicher, head of Mankind Research Unlimited, and helped develop a device called the "AGRAD Machine". This device was designed to control crop insects, and was introduced on an experimental basis, although it is not known if it ever reached commercial production. Paul Sauvin's mother was Edith Sauvin, who lived in White Plains, NY, and died August 25th, 1987. Edith's only child was Pierre Paul Sauvin, who himself had 2 sons, Alan Paul Sauvin and Steven Eric Sauvin. He also had one daughter, Jane Elizabeth Sauvin. Missing Pages of a Book

The book, Relationship Between Parapsychology and Gravity, Vol. 3 of Handbook of Unusual Energies, by J.G. Gallimore, was published by Borderland Sciences in the 1970's, although the date of publication and copyright date were not noted in this book. The USPA has this book in its library, and plans to republish it for the Gallimore family, but unfortunately, pages 208 and 209 are missing from the printed book. It appears that this is a publisher printing error, because page 210 is printed on the back side of page 207. However, it is possible that pages 208 and 209 were missing from the manuscript when it was sent to Borderlands for publication. Or these pages of the manuscript may have been inadvertently lost by the publisher, or possibly they were intentionally removed by someone from the manuscript prior to publication.

Do any of you have a copy of this book, and if so, would you please check to see if it has pages 208 and 209? I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the books and monograph holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere in the world. Missing Periodicals:

- <u>1.</u> British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics: Does anyone have any issues of The British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics. It was published in London, England, by the British Radiesthesia Association, 1953-1963. The original title was British Journal of Radiesthesia, published from 1953-1957. No libraries in the United States, public or university, have this journal in their collection., and only five libraries elsewhere in the world are known to have any issues at all: The British Museum Library (AKA The British Library), Oxford, Cambridge, the National Library of Scotland, and Trinity College Library, in Dublin Ireland. If you have any issues of this periodical, will you please let me know? And for our members and associates in The UK and Irelad, if you can access these periodicals at any of the above libraries, you would do a huge service for all of us if you would Xerox what issues are available and send them to me. - 2. Journal of Scientific Controversy. This periodical was referred to on page 49 of the Vol. 1, No. 1 (Spring, 1967) issue of the INFO: The Journal of the International Fortean Organization. Someone was trying to find out about it even then, 49 years ago, and said that this journal was "formerly published in Boulder, Colorado" implying that it may have ceased publication prior to 1967, or that it moved somewhere else after being published for a period of time in Boulder. I have searched the WorldCat, which shows the periodical holdings of virtually every public and university library in the United States and Canada, and many of

the large libraries in the UK and elsewhere overseas. But this title, or anything close to it does not exist in the WorldCat database, so that indicates that this periodical title is not held in any library, even special collections, which are also included in WorldCat. However, this does not mean that the periodical does not exist, since many periodicals in the psychotronics, scientific anomalies and similar fields are excluded from libraries.

Missing Books:

Rhea White and Larissa Vilenskaya wrote a book titled Parapsychology in the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe, and China: A Compendium of Information. It was supposedly published by Scarecrow Press of Metuchen, NJ, a well know publisher of reference books. This book was listed as reference work #680 on page 213 of Rhea White's book, Parapsychology: New Sources of Information, 1973-1989, also published by Scarecrow Press. I called the publisher, and they said they have never published this book, and know nothing about it. As you can see from entry #680, Rhea White noted that this book was "in press", so it may have been in a preparation stage, but the manuscript may never have been sent to Scarecrow Press.

Consciousness and Our DNA

Jerry Gin, Ph.D. Foundation for Mind-Being Research (FMBR)

Most people think of our DNA as solely a molecular structure that chemically codes for making the components of our body. However, research is now demonstrating that it is much more than that -- it is also a transmitter of signals that carry information. With the fairly recent decoding of DNA in our genes via the Human Genomic Project, scientists thought that now we will have a "full" understanding of life as dictated by our genes. Unfortunately, the number of genes that we possess is not that different than most living organisms -- i.e., we are not so "special". Humans have about 23,000 genes, about the same number as found in mice and earth worms.

But we did have a lot of "junk" DNA that scientists did not understand since they were not the genes that coded for the proteins and enzymes that make up and build the body (hence, the term "junk"). We are now beginning to understand that the "junk" DNA appear to act as regulators that control the information that affects the operation of our body and hence its health. This understanding is creating a new field called epigenetics. It also appears that our intentions and thoughts become control knobs for changing the channel for the DNA signal! Light originating from our cells (biophotons) and electromagnetic signals appear to be involved in the signaling process. I will now briefly outline some of the scientific underpinnings that support this new look at the role of the DNA molecule.

Dr. Peter Gariaev, <u>Director of Wave Genetics in Russia</u>, performed an amazing experiment. When DNA, under vacuum, is exposed to a mild laser light, a sensitive photomultiplier instrument can pick up the signals from the DNA. When the DNA is removed from the container that held the DNA, the photomultiplier still picks up a structured photon presence and does so for about 30 days (the "phantom DNA effect"). Standard science says this cannot occur. Since it does occur, the DNA has structured the photons in this space, i.e., established a pattern in the field. This experiment gives us insight on the mechanism of messaging using DNA.

Related to the Phantom DNA story are other stories in which signals are used to carry out the action of DNA:

• Dr. Vlail Kaznacheyev, Director of the Institute for Clinical and Experimental Medicine in Novosibirsk, showed that a virus can be transmitted from one culture plate

to another using ultraviolet light. Thus, information is being carried with photons that have been "structured" in one culture plate to another culture plate. Some Russian scientists believe that this effect is being carried out by "torsion" energy.

- Dr. Dzang Kangeng in China showed that light passed through a duck into 500 chicken eggs resulted in chicks in which 80% had flat bills, 90% had eyes moved to a position similar to ducks and 25% had webbing between their toes. Their offspring remained partial duck, partial chicken.
- Dr. Gariaev directed green laser light through salamander eggs and then through frog eggs. Salamanders hatched from the frog eggs. He has coined the term "wave genetics".
- Nobel Laureate virologist, Dr. Luc Montagnier (who shared the prize for discovering the HIV virus) discovered the apparent ability of DNA fragments to "regenerate" themselves using an electromagnetic field. Two separate tubes were placed in a copper coil and subjected to an electromagnetic field of 7 hertz. One tube had a DNA fragment and the other tube just had pure water. After 16 hours, the tubes were subjected to the polymerase chain reaction (PCR) to create replicants of the DNA (the standard technique that enzymatically makes many copies of DNA to enable measurement of DNA that is originally in a small quantity). The DNA was found in the tube with just pure water. The hypothesis is that the DNA structure is preserved and amplified through quantum coherence in the water tube and the PCR process mistakes it for the DNA itself.

In order to gain some understanding of the mechanism involved and to see how consciousness plays into the effects, one can look at the work of Dr. Fritz-Albert Popp at the International Institute of Biophysics in Germany. The hypothesis: DNA interacts strongly with coherent laser light and affects the NH...O and NH...H hydrogen bonds. Biophotons from all parts of the body are coherent (not random) and thus can allow communication. Machinery of each cell coordinates its activities by exchanging biophotons with other cells. Organization occurs cooperatively using a pattern supplied by the DNA. The DNA acts like a photon store and will raise the energy levels of molecules, preparing them for a chemical reaction. Consciousness may affect the non-local field (like a torsion/bioenergy field) which affect DNA which affect biophotons release which affect chemical reactions such as protein synthesis.

In another hypothesis, Dr. Keith Scott-Mumby, reviewing the above types of experiments in <u>Virtual Medicine</u>, describes "radio DNA" in which the DNA acts like an antenna transmitting information to carry out the activities of the cell.

The science of DNA and consciousness is a fascinating field; we are lucky to be observing this field at its infancy.

With the above information, one can further hypothesize as to how distant healing can occur. One cannot just use electromagnetic fields (eg, light) since they reduce in strength with distance. For example, if one considers a torsion field interacting with the field of consciousness, then distal effects can occur. The consciousness frequencies involved would interact with the DNA which transmits the information for chemical reactions.

Some Thoughts on... The Language, Art and Music of the Virtual State

(Author of the book, The Secret Art : A Brief History of Radionic Technology for the Creative Individual)

THE THRUST OF my paper is to describe and encourage an inward turning of psychotronic technology in order to broaden our perspective on ourselves. It is apparent from the discussions involving both power generation and medicine that similar principles could be employed to aid us in obtaining information about our minds, our perceptions, our consciousness. To some, particularly those with an appreciation of ancient cultures and sacred societies, this is appropriately the domain of art.

Any discussion of this nature must address the artistic implications of a field like psychotronics in parallel terms. Those would be: 1) its techniques, technology, and material implementation, and 2) its mythical, cultural and religious implications, especially where we stand historically in our attempts to develop a language appropriate to our discovery of new dimensions. The new dimensions I'm referring to are: those of the infinitely small, the subatomic; the macroscopic world of outer space; and the inner, psychedelic landscape of mystics, poets and dreamers. Any careful study of the emerging field of psychotronics will reveal that the medical or healing areas researched and discussed apply to the domain of the sub-atomic. Radionics, dowsing, etc., all address fields and properties that exist either before or upon the emergence of matter from the ether, or use electrical and magnetic stimuli of increasingly minute quantities the closer one gets to the domain of mind. This would include the works of Rife, Drown, Hieronymus, Abrahams, Prioré, and Reich, to name a few. Conversely, power and communications technology. The works of Keeley, Tesla, Steinmetz, Heavyside, Maxwell, Moray, Hendershot, Hubbert, Heisenberg, Planck, and others address the formative forces of the universe, describing and investigating the great cosmic engines of the universe, outside of general relativity or before its domination of our scientific world view. At any rate, this realm of study approaches the sources of all knowledge mechanically and macroscopically.

There is a third area of psychotronics, however, relatively untouched by comparison, both in scientific terms and in psychotronic studies; it is the domain of the self. Not until quantum mechanics demonstrated mans' iniquitous connection to the outcome of his own observations did physical science seriously begin considering the observer's position as relevant to the outcome of his study.

This overwhelming realization, still far from generally accepted in practical terms in day-to-day matters, has left mechanical science so shaken that now all sorts of hitherto outcast or unacceptable areas of research are being given a new lease on life. Tentatively, fields like psychotronics are being explored in an attempt to gain more information on exactly who this "observer of reality" really is and how his attitudes and emotions play a composite part of whatever he discovers about the universe, be it micro, macro or middle-order reality.

This research into ourselves and the breadth of humanity, humor, beauty, and awe that it suggests has for many, not been satisfied by either material science or religion. Oddly enough, I sense a few artists and dreamers have found it, and it is their perspective, to the extent I can articulate it with all its paradoxical complexities, that I wish to discuss today. Psychotronics, with its bizarre combination of mysticism and physics, healing by hands or with strange dialed boxes and flickering lights, its colorful association of mad inventors with basement laboratories demonstrating anti-gravity devices and their stories of communications networks existing in parallel, scalar dimensions; the fantastic theories of weapons that make conventional and nuclear threats pale by comparison; the inescapable association of UFO phenomena with machines that run from "free energy" - and now the raging controversy about alien abductions and alien collusion with world governments - make this new field a veritable hothouse for the mythical contents of the collective unconscious to come pouring out, and with it our collective frustrations over what we have done to our environment and to ourselves in our most recent lust for progress. I say, with the utmost seriousness, that it is our handling of these ideas and their consequent expression in human life that will either guide and engineer our consciousness back into a sense of the poetic, harmonious relationship we once shared with nature and each other, or we will spring upon ourselves and our unsuspecting neighbors a veritable Pandora's Box of untapped phenomena intimately linked to the power of our own imagination and thought.

In a sense, psychotronics is a latter day development of psychedelics, except that in the former the thought forms we are playing with are not confined to our own minds, but are tangibly evidenced in the environment by being linked to breakthrough electromagnetic technology. One need only peruse the disastrous results of the psychedelic revolution to see the obvious implications.

The alternative to this insanity is oddly uncomplicated, though by no means easier to effect. It emerges, happily enough, from the domain of art and beauty. Not, I might add, from the commercial art world where paintings are treated as valuable commodities and art careers as Madison Avenue hype, but from the traditional perspective still upheld by native peoples.

There must be some reason, aside from sheer ignorance, that human culture remained within certain technological limits for so long, preferring to enjoy nature and fathom the universe through the imagination. To some extent, our studies of psychotronics may bring us back to a simpler view of life — to healing with forces rather than machines, to non-polluting energy sources; to living in balance and harmony with the earth. It is just as possible, however, that without this benign vision, we will tear open the delicate fabric that divides the dimensions, opening ourselves and the external world to all the fantasmagorical contents of our collective unconscious. Who is to say all our fears, repressions, and frustrations will not suddenly confront us in full three-dimensional space/time as living myths? Certain shrewd minds suggest this is already occurring. The frenzied, fractured world of conceptual art was an instinctual reaction to its beginning; a symbolic retreat to concepts, to the head, placating a growing awareness that everything was getting out of control. What are the artists blocking, anyway? What do we not want to see beyond what we already see; the threat of nuclear war, environmental poisoning, etc., with which we have been living now for decades? What do we do about it?

WILHELM REICH HAS BEEN a leader in forging a solution through his discovery of orgone energy science. Reich began his career by trying to establish an empirical foundation through demonstrable scientific experiments of Freud's Libido theory. This he accomplished, but not in terms of electromagnetic theory. He discovered, instead, the body's emotional functions originated with a mass free environmental energy he called "orgone." Orgone is observable both around the living cell under a microscope and in the atmosphere. For Reich, understanding how orgone functioned in the human body and emotions was

key to determining health and balance. He extended his findings into a profound understanding of the ecology of the earth itself. He engineered with his findings, making motors run from the orgone and turning desert back into arable land. Above all, Reich laid a precise scientific foundation for understanding human sexual health and the forces that seek to undermine it. I feel that without first understanding the importance of Reich's work and pursuing psychotronic investigation from an emotionally balanced perspective, there can be no point in venturing practically into the interior realms.

What I want to point out about using psychotronic technology to explore the inner worlds has one very obvious parallel — hallucinogenic drugs. Albert Hoffman, who discovered LSD, was a research chemist at Sandoz Laboratories in Switzerland. In his autobiography, he points out several very interesting facts about LSD that should attract the attention of psychotronic investigators.

The first is dosage. An average LSD dose capable of producing life-transforming psychic experiences, is just .075 mg; that is .075 one-thousandth of a gram — a very tiny actual physical amount — so small, in fact, that it is possible to imagine its effects being triggered by an electrical process.

Second, the idea of LSD affecting the brain alone is fallacious. Experiments showed radioactive LSD disappeared rapidly from the bloodstream and was distributed throughout the organism. Unexpectedly, the *lowest* concentration was found in the brain; concentrated there in certain centers of the mid-brain that play a role in the regulation of emotions. Concentration in various organs attained maximum values 10 to 15 minutes after injection, then fell off quickly, with the exception of the small intestine. Psychic effects persisted long after it could no longer be detected in the organism. Hoffman and other researchers concluded LSD is not active as such, but rather triggers certain biochemical, neurophysiological, and psychic mechanisms that provoke the inebriated condition and continue in the absence of the active principle.

My point is that vast reality changes could be electromagnetically engineered through careful scrutiny of chemical brain processes and their relationship to triggering mechanisms in the brain, perhaps by anyone slightly familiar with psychotronic technology and access to a laboratory.

As for the hallucinatory visions themselves, Hoffman had this to say:

An artist visited me in order to obtain my opinion about how the experience under LSD should be understood and interpreted. He feared that the profound transformation of his personal life, which had resulted from his experiment with LSD, could rest on a mere delusion. My explanation — that LSD, as a biochemical, only triggered his visions but had not created them and that these visions rather originated from his own soul—gave him confidence in the meaning of his transformation.

Certainly, this statement of a responsible chemist working under strict laboratory conditions, discovering accidentally a profoundly mind-altering substance, should give us pause, to reflect somewhat on exactly what our own "inner vision" is, and what could emerge from that domain in our experiments.

My brief interjection of this data into the discussion is four-fold. It suggests multi-dimensional data can be assessed by chemical or electromagnetic processes, much in the same way "window frequencies" are discussed by psychotronic inventors privately and have produced disturbing, non-rational effects in their laboratories. It implies relatively small amounts of actual energy are necessary for triggering the effects, something well within the technological province of primitive or sacred cultures, further suggesting an access point for sacred technologies arising from natural processes. It certainly indicates a very real direction for exploration within the field, as it constitutes a holographic model where the microcosmic and macrocosmic spheres actually interpenetrate and become functionally identical for the observer. Finally, I hope everyone understands the danger of such a study and why maintaining psychological balance must be an a priori consideration under all circumstances.

IN PREPARATION TO my short discussion on language, I want to mention something about "scalars" in relationship to information processing systems. Scalar is defined in Webster's dictionary, in its mathematical sense, as: 1) a real number rather than a vector, 2) a quantity (as mass or time) that has a magnitude describable by a real number and no direction. This does not tell us much, but a "scalar product" however, is described as a "real number that is the product of the lengths of two vectors and the cosine of the angle between them, also called dot product or inner product." I tend to use the term in the sense of an inner product, a form that exists before a physical form, like the pure geometry within a structure — there, regardless of scale or material rendering.

For myself, as an artist, the idea of a point that forms a doorway into another domain, that of a universal ether, has vast eidetic implications. We are discussing in other contexts how to access this zero-point energy. But what is it, subjectively, to the observer? Jung speaks of archetypes essentially as constraints, mental structures in the unconscious mind which make it possible for messages, in the form of images, to be sent to the conscious mind. The nature of these messages is mythological and symbolic. This

suggests the symbol and myth act as transducers to cosmic energy, an actual gating system between ether and physical reality, with much in common with electricity and magnetism. In the same way, Chomsky speaks of a universal grammar. Jeremy Campbell in *Grammatical Man*, a fascinating book on information, entropy, language and life, states as follows: "They (the archetypes) predispose the mind to special kinds of universal knowledge, insuring that the themes of world myths, like some constructions in languages, are universal, appearing and reappearing over long periods of time across cultures which have little or no contact with each other..." and further, "...by this, like dreams, have their own peculiar logic and structure and this structure reflects the structure of the mind."

Campbell begins to actually describe the functions of language in scalar terms when he states:

Universal grammar, the linchpin of Chomskyan linguistics, resembles as we have noted, theories of modern science whose essential power is to carry the mind beyond experience, so that new information arises not from the world, but from the abstractions in the mind.

Elsewhere, he comments on how our handling of language is, in fact, our method of corralling reality into models which are energetically tolerable to our organism. About psychoanalysis, for instance, he says:

The Freudian lexicon, full of such terms as drives, repressions, discharges, sources and sinks, belongs to the 19th century world of steam power and the mystique of railways. The brain was seen as an engine waiting to have its boilers stoked.

Extending this idea, Campbell goes on to build a bridge between the theories of mechanistic science with its roots in 19th century empiricism and rationalism, 20th century information theory, and further, by implication, the 21st century notions discussed here of mass-free energy and scalar electromagnetics when he says:

A picture of the brain as determination, with every cause leading directly to a specific result, and instincts asserting themselves as imperious forces demanding release, is at odds with what is known today. One especially important difference between energy and information is that the first is subject to the laws of conservation, while the second is not: information can be created or destroyed. By taking nerve cells to be sources and sinks of energy, Freud had to exclude the possibility that events in the nervous system could be simply neutralized or cancelled. In his system, nervous energy was siphoned off, discharged or repressed. Messages do not behave in this way at all. They can be stopped, switched off, with no price to pay in the form of pent-up forces linking morbidly in the psyche. The brain, far from just reacting to gusts of energy bombarding it from the instincts or from the outside world, maintains its own information system in a more or less stable balance, and to a large extent drives itself.

Thus, linguistics become deeply entangled with psychology, for both are studying the relationship between randomness and information. Each science is as complex as the other, which may explain why neither has yet surrendered all its secrets to inquisitive and ingenious probing, not by a very long way.

I have suggested that we should now view language as a major factor in any discussion of psychotronic technology. After all, language is the psychotronic instrument. I can make thoughts in your head by simply uttering small mouth noises. The degree of fineness of these images is still under exploration. Language is related to frequency through the chemical-electrical processes of the human brain. What matters for this discussion is that we perceive the viewing of language through psychotronics in general as forming a symbolic relationship with a deconditioning agent. Whatever agent we choose, and there are a good many offered, we must understand that it is released from the inertia of our cultural machinery that is the ultimate test of the agent's value in the here and now. I suggest we are venturing into a relationship with an information base outside human experience, an alien reality which symbolically and mythologically is presenting itself to us daily in various guises.

Despite many problems and differences in methodology attendant to different factions in this field, there exists general sympathy when it comes to the topic of finding models for explaining these esoteric ideas in simple terms. Alex Comefort, in *Reality & Empathy*, addresses this problem when he states:

For the scientist who hopes to produce not only a mathematical model of a world view, but a world view which can, as it were, be taken home with us, the place to start now is with the instrument which is doing the seeing and inferring, not with the structures which are seen and inferred, however real and objective these may appear. As Descartes pointed out, nothing seems more 'real' to us than the I which is doing the thinking.

Comefort goes on to say:

Aside from occultists who rub their hands at the idea that there may be other worlds, fourth dimensions, and so on, to vindicate their preconceptions, modern physics has had no religious and rather little philosophical impact. If, when it has 'set', modern physics could somehow be popularly empathized, it would be a blockbuster.

It is in consideration of precisely this predicament that the avenue for the creative tools of the artist linked with the psychotronic inventory has the most to offer. What psychotronics needs today are complimentary disciplines that address the various languages in which it tries to speak, languages that express its meaning in rich symbol, metaphor and, if possible, actual experience. We have already hypothesized earlier in this paper that symbols are themselves functional in respect to these mysterious energies. Missing to date from the technical application is a com-

mon metaphysical overview of where these disciplines meet in actual experience. It is here that artists can play a most valuable role, using the technology to design systems that inform the general public of the existence of other dimensions, actually creating environments where these dimensions become readily accessed. These art forms can embrace electromagnetics, or just be reconstructed along the more traditional lines suggested by thinkers such as John Michell, Keith Critchlow, Jocelyn Godwin, Terrence McKenna, and numerous others. The systems of thought hearken back to ancient cultures and suggest possibilities in many ways much more in harmony with nature and therefore, more powerful, especially historically, than their recent electronic analogues.

To accomplish this, it is first necessary to achieve a measure of confidence in the fact that it is no longer necessary to participate in this filtering down of information from scientific, military, governmental, and corporate elite sources. The adventure of being is not a cultural or a societal discovery, but a personal one, and all the tools and information necessary are available readily and inexpensively.

Since these topics are rightfully the province of Dennis and Terrence McKenna, I would like to include some of their thoughts. Understanding the relationship of spoken to visual language is critical for any artistic comprehension of the possibilities of this field.

The McKennas chose to research the Ayahuasca inebriating tribes of the Amazon jungle in the vicinity of the Choroni River, on the border of Colombia and Peru. Their experiences and studies substantiated rumors of a mysterious translinguistic fluid, the "Smoking Mirror," as it has been called, created by shamen in trance states and purportedly responsible for extraordinary effects on the viewer, affecting local distortions of time and space. The experience they describe is not unlike Jorge Luis Borge's story, "The Aleph," where an unsuspecting guest at a friend's house is exposed to an experience of cosmic consciousness, which starts at a point and expands into a cosmic vision.

Essentially, under discussion here is the phenomenon of sound which is beheld, the idea of a visual language. References go back to Philojudia who speaks of the "more perfect logos," where thought will be apprehended by being seen, not by being heard. It will cross from being heard to being seen without ever going through a noticeable moment where it shifts from one modality to another.

This experience certainly sounds like another way of describing scalar inferometry within the brain, and the orthorotation of perspective concomitant to the emergence of a scalar field. Here, first a thought emerges, which becomes a sound, then a synthesis where someone speaking produces an apparently three-dimensional object in the air, or concurrently in the mind, mutually beheld by speaker and listener alike. This experience evolves into a freely evolving topology of light and sounds that is translinguistic, a grammar of form, not shorn of meaning, but emotion-

ally rich and of poetic depth that is not like ordinary language. The particular meaning that logical necessity imposes on language is cancelled, and along with it our culturally prescribed conditions for reality. As this language finds its way into daily life, as I have suggested it must, from the visionary frontiers of art and science, we are, in effect, altering the medium or ether in which our reality takes place. Language has its own inertia, and it is hard to change, but when elements of self-reflection are entered into it so that language can become more conscious and less random, we are, in effect, producing neg-entropy. It is the non-randomizing of language that will give us a real hold on the kinds of social modalities we want to produce in the future.

AT THIS POINT, I want to introduce the Cotleydon-Betar-Genesis device that has incorporated the work of a number of inventors in the psychotronic field at Virtual State Productions in Long Island City, N.Y. These contributors are: Michael Bradford, Peter Kelly, John Bedini, Eric Dollard, Preston Nichols, Eldon Byrd and Jim Murray to name a few on the technical end, as well as R. J. Reynolds, III, Aymon de Sales, John Michell, and Alix Toland, to name several others who have contributed substantially to its existence in the financial and conceptual areas.

The "Music Machine," as it is often called, is attempting to define itself within a plethora of ideas. It exists on the simplest level, as a music listening device. But as we evolve its actual purpose, noticing its effect on our lives, we are beginning to view it as a tool capable of producing the degree of self-reflection necessary to destructure language and thus free up unconscious processes. Both art, in the form of pre-recorded music, and technique, which is the mastery of the various functions of the machine itself, are essential ingredients to producing an effective experience, as are the necessary technologies provided and refined by the inventors. To this intent, it has already become a very successful merger of art, science and technology.

To date, everyone admits it does *something*. Most come away feeling opened, refreshed, nurtured, and affected positively — already an indication of some negentropic function in relation to the environment. I personally feel that technically it expands the dimensionality of sound, giving a three-dimensional quality to music. It also produces unusual eidetic images, pictures in the mind, under certain circumstances. Last but not least, Time itself seems to be stressed in unusual ways. All of these processes can

be amplified. Aesthetically, it functions in another whole dimension. It has become a catalyst for dramatically affecting peoples' lives, a tool for understanding many things spoken of here today as well as serving as a symbol and a product of those experiences. This effect is truly three- or perhaps four-dimensional, because it incorporates time into the equation. It may be a form of four-dimensional sculpture. That's how I choose to perceive it.

As a musical device the machine at present exists in limbo between the realm of listening and the realm of playing. It is to some degree, both an instrument and a huge stereo. Clues for its potential for instrumentation lie in its features for producing short-wave signals in stereophonic sound, its tone-producing apparatus, its ELF-producing equipment, and the incorporation of a sampling keyboard capable of mixing human voice patterns and music into the system.

In true creative activities there exists a self-sustaining energy that seems to extend and expand upon all existing systems, disciplines, etc. It seems to hold one's attention in the form of Epiphany or theorphany for however long the creative or inspirational state lasts. The machine seems to duplicate this experience in a passive way, or at least convey it metaphorically to its passengers.

IN JOCELYN GODWIN'S delightful book, Harmonies of Heaven and Earth, The Spiritual Dimensions of Music from Antiquity to the Avant-garde, he makes some very interesting observations on the nature of music, especially 20th century music, that apply dramatically to this experience.

The common ground on which the postwar, avantgarde met, transcending all their ideological differences, was tone. Call it also timbre, tone quality, pure sound: it was that dimension of music which had been comparatively neglected during several centuries of harmonic, melodic and rhythmic exploration. This is why avant-garde music, to the great distress of the conventionally-trained ear, seems to have no coherent melody, no harmonic language, no steady rhythm: it is just one sound after another. The very strangeness of its sounds, new combinations of instruments, weird sounds produced from them, electronic noises, draws attention to this dimension. While much of it simply disguises the predicament of composers who would otherwise have nothing to say, its broader effect is to focus on the very stuff of music, taken for granted in the past. At the same time, artists take for their subject the actual substance

of paint on canvas and poets write poems in which they wonder what words really are.

When Wagner first analyzed a tone in the "Prelude to Rheingold," showing in over eight minutes how it is made from the series of overtones in increasing density and rapidity of vibration, the first step had been taken towards a penetration by the listener of the single tone, as a microcosm to be explored in its own right, irrespective of its neighbors. The composers of the 1950s, in turn, present not melodies and harmonies, but sonorous objects for contemplation. Thus, I infer a sculpture of sound, leading to a point, and from there, to a scalar.

Stockhausen describes in his many writings how his early music moved from organization with reference to the note or single musical point, through composition with "groups" of notes, of the idea of the musical "moment" — a development as much in meditative listening as in music itself. Godwin grows even closer to articulating this scalar dimension when he continues:

But in the idea of the Moment we have what I called the sonorous object of contemplation: The musical entity which is a whole, and which can be perceived as a whole (momentarily) without awareness of the passage of time. Each moment is a glimpse of the sound-world, where time takes on a far different nature from its inexorable and irreversible flow down here. In contemplating these timeless moments, these musical creatures, one may enter a different state of consciousness.

From here, Godwin mentions the connection to architecture, where monks built their churches according to musical proportions in order to enrich their plainchant and to bring them into contact with the hidden dimension of tone.

Thus, we see expressed in the Music Machine the architectural dimension in its relation to tone. Artistically, we begin to evidence a shift of sensibility away from the expression of the composers' emotions or the performers' virtuosity to that of the listener, who now becomes an indispensable participant and whose activity is perhaps the main goal.

Godwin concludes:

The new emphasis on the listener and on the art of listening invites everyone without exception to participate in music to the utmost, just as the outpouring of formerly-guarded knowledge enables individuals to pursue their spiritual quests independently of church dogmas and authority...

...and, I might add, scientific dogma.

IN CONCLUSION, the following observations have presented themselves to me about psychotronic technology and the arts: There is extensive evidence that the ether exists as a medium for art, both actually and metaphorically. The medium can be engineered using various devices in lieu of traditional tools. The results are psychedelic in nature, reflecting a perspective synthesis of the macro and micro worlds in ordinary reality. This means in simple terms that they change the language in which we view the world and therefore ultimately change the world itself. The process is dangerous, psychologically, but can be effected by anyone with enough curiosity. It both fills a certain void of meaning in the art world (music, theatre and film) and yet oddly, is complementary to various avant garde developments and could also practically function to expand the impact of existing art forms on the emotions and imagination. If handled properly, psychotronic technology coupled with art could conceivably form the basis for a deconditioning process from the toxic excesses of twentieth century culture — and if misused, become their ultimate expression.

Gurwitsch, A. A. Historical Review of the Problem of Mitogenetic Radiation. <u>Experientia</u>. Vol. 44 (1988), pp. 545-550

Abstract:

The 'miracle of caryokinesis' was the starting point that stimulated Alexander G. Gurwitsch to carry out his famous 'mitogenetic' experiments in 1923. The results obtained confirmed his hypothesis of a weak radiation from cells, which is able to trigger the growth of other cells. Extensive experimental work within the first two decades after this discovery indicated that the problem of mitogenetic radiation is generally related to the biological significance of UV-radiation.

Both 'energetic' and 'informational' aspects have to be considered, namely radiation effective in activating molecules, and that involved in arranging them into larger units. The molecular organization of biological structures is evidently governed by non-equilibrium conditions needing the uptake or emission of radiation. These concepts of Alexander G. Gurwitsch can be linked with modern approaches based on hypotheses of coherence in biology, 'synergetics' and 'dissipative structures'. However, the question of causal interrelationships between this part of non-equilibrium radiation and biological matter on different levels of evolution has to be solved now.

Hormozi-Nejad M.H., Mozafari J., Rakhshandehroo F. Elimination of Bean Common Mosaic Virus Using an Electrotherapy Technique. <u>Journal of Plant Diseases and Protection</u>. Vol. 117, no. 5 (2010), pp 201-205;

Abstract:

Bean common mosaic virus (BCMV) is a major seed transmitted virus of common bean (Phaseolus vulgaris). The use of virus-free germplasm is a prerequisite for production of certified seeds, which is an important disease control measure. In this study, the

efficiency of electrotherapy in eliminating BCMV and producing virus-free plants in two common bean cultivars, Khomein and Capsouli, was evaluated. Nodal cuttings of infected bean plants were exposed to electric currents of 5, 10 and 15 mA for 10 minutes and planted in vitro. One month old regenerated plantlets were tested by a Double Anti- body Sandwich (DAS)-ELISA method for BCMV infection.


The three intensities of electric current resulted in mean virus elimination percentages of 37.2%, 45.5% and 71.9% and mean plant regeneration of 79.5%, 68.6% and 58.4%, respectively. The Therapy Efficiency Index for the three electrotherapy treatments was estimated as 28.9, 29.2 and 39.1 in cv Khomein and 26.9, 33.3 and 44.8 in cv Capsouli, respectively. Based on the Therapy Efficiency Indices, an electric current of 15 mA for 10 min was the most effective treatment in both cultivars. The technique developed in this study can be a useful procedure for the production of virus-free germplasm and/or nucleus seed stock in crop plants infected with seed-borne viruses. © Eugen Ulmer KG, Stuttgart.

Kwan R.L.-C., Wong W.-C., Yip S.-L., Chan K.-L., Zheng Y.-P., Cheing G.L.-Y. Pulsed Electromagnetic Field Therapy Promotes Healing and Microcirculation of Chronic Diabetic Foot Ulcers. <u>Advances in Skin and Wound Care</u>, vol. 28, no. 5 (2015), pp. 212-219;

Abstract:

Objective: To examine the effects of pulsed electromagnetic field (PEMF) therapy on promoting the healing and microcirculation of chronic diabetic foot ulcers. Design: A randomized, double-blind, placebo-controlled clinical trial on a homogenous subset of chronic diabetic foot ulcers. Setting: Hospital and university. Patients: Thirteen subjects (7 in the PEMF group and 6 in the control group) diagnosed with type 2 diabetes and had unsatisfactory healing of ulcer(s) in the preceding 4 weeks were recruited. Interventions: Subjects were randomly allocated to receive either active Pemf therapy (duration: 60minutes; frequency: 12 Hz; intensity: 12 Gauss) or nonactive PEMF for 14 sessions within 3 weeks.

Main Outcome Measures: Assessment on wound closure, wound depth, and microcirculation were performed at the baseline, end of the treatment period, and 1-month follow-up. Main Results: By the end of the treatment period, there was an 18% decrease in wound size in the active PEMF group as compared with a 10% decrease in the control group. The PEMF group demonstrated significant cumulative increase in cutaneous capillary blood velocity (by 28%) and 14% increase in capillary diameter. In contrast, the control group showed a decrease in both capillary blood velocity and diameter. Conclusion: In this study, PEMF therapy seemed to accelerate wound healing and improve microcirculation. © 2015 Wolters Kluwer Health, Inc. All rights reserved.



USPA Periodicals Library Update

In order to do good psychotronics research of any kind, whether it involves radionics, radiesthesia, psionic medicine, dowsing, subtle energies, biophotons, or any other subject covered by psychotronics, one needs access to as much of the periodical literature as possible on these subjects.

To address this issue, the United States Psychotronics Association has resolved to identify and acquire every psychotronics related periodical that has ever been published anywhere in the world, and to retain copies in the USPA Library.

As a first step, we have developed the following list of periodicals that focused on or frequently had articles on psychotronics related subjects. But this is only a preliminary list, and we know that there are probably more psychotronics periodicals that have been published, but that we do not yet know about.

So please look over the following list and check your own personal physical libraries and your computers to see if you have any issues of the periodicals on this list. Even if you just have one issue, please let us know, because that may be the one we need to complete all the issues of a particular periodical. Please write to me (John) at: joreed43@gmail.com, since I am the USPA librarian and archivist coordinating this effort, and tell me what periodicals you have.

As a whole, the members of USPA have a huge "library" of periodicals, but it just happens to be "distributed" among its members at this point in time. However, we can work together, and if you would be willing to loan, donate, xerox, or as a last resort, sell copies of your periodicals for the USPA Library, then we will be able to build a large centralized library of all psychotronics periodicals. And all USPA members will then be able to use these periodicals in their research or for their reading enjoyment.

American Journal of Electromedicine: Daniel Kirsch Ph.D., developer of Alpha-Stim Craniotherapy Electrical Stimulation (CES) was the first editor; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

American Radio Therapy Society Journal: This was a periodical published in Hollywood, California, by the American Radio Therapy Society, which had been founded by Dr. Ruth Drown in 1949. This periodical began with vol. 1, no. 1 in June, 1949, and continued to be published for a period of time. However, it is not known when it ceased publication or how many issued were published, but presumably it ceased sometime before Dr. Drown's death in 1963. This journal focused on radionics psychotronics subjects, and had no interest in ionizing radiation therapies, such as x-ray therapy, which were also known as "radio therapy" at that time. The only library in the world that has copies of this periodical is the National Library of Medicine in Bethesda, Maryland. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

BEMI Currents: BEMI Currents was a quarterly journal published by the Bio-Electro-Magnetics Institute in Reno, Nevada, from 1989-1993. The editor was Dr. John Zimmerman. This journal began with vol. 1, no. 1 (Spring, 1989) and continued through Vol. 3, no. 4 (March, 1993), after which it ceased publication. **A total of 12 issues were published, and the USPA Library has all 12 issues in its collection.**

Bioeffects Newsletter: This was a periodical that was published by the "Physiology Program", Office of Naval Research, in Arlington, Virginia, and focused on the biological effects of electromagnetic fields. It probably began sometime in the 1977, because it is known that Issue #5 was dated April, 1978. The Bieffects Newsletter is believed to have ceased publication when the Bioelectromagnetics Society (BEMS) was formed in 1978, because it was edited by Thomas Rozzell, who served as the editor of the BEMS Newsletter for the Bioelectromagnetics Society. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is undoubtedly in a number of private collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Bioelectric Medicine: Journal founded in 2014, Kevin Tracey, M.D., President of the Feinstein Institute for Medical Research, which has established a Center for Bioelectronic Medicine; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

BioElectroMagnetics: Published by John Wiley and Sons from Vol. 1, No. 1 (1980) to present. We need all issues. All articles are freely available online at Johns Hopkins, back to 1980; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Bridges: This was the newsmagazine of the International Society for the Study of Subtle Energies & Energy Medicine (ISSSEEM) from 1990 through the present. The USPA Library has a complete set of this periodical from vol. 1, no 1 (Spring, 1990) through the present.

British Journal of Radiesthesia and Radionics. Published by the British Radiesthesia Association, 1953-1963. The original title was British Journal of Radiesthesia. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

DeLaWarr Laboratories Newsletter: published by George and Marjorie DeLaWarr, and later their daughter Diana Di Pinto, from 1964-1986. **The USPA Library has a complete set of these, unless you know of any issues published after 1986.**

Dowsing Today: The journal of the British Society of Dowsers, published from 2000 to the present. Original title was Radio Perception, which began in 1933. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electro and Magnetobiology: Published by Taylor and Francis from 1993-2002. Title was changed to Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine: Published by Taylor and Francis from 2003-present. Former editor, Dr. Abe Liboff; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Electronic Medical Digest: published 1946 to about 1955, also by Fred J. Hart and the College of Electronic Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Energy & Character - Journal of Bioenergetic Research: This was a periodical published by Abbotsbury Publications, Dorset, England, UK, and focused on psychotronic related subjects, especially orgone energy and Wilhelm Reich's research. It began with vol. 1, no. 1 (January, 1970), and continued publishing 3 times per year for 38 years, but ceased publication with volume 37 in 2009. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Extension Bulletin, Electronic Medical Foundation: This was a series of bulletins published by the Electronic Medical Foundation of San Francisco, beginning in 1950. Thomas Colson was the editor, and at least three issues were published. It is not known if additional issues were published. The USPA Library needs all issues.

Journal of Bioelectricity: Published by Taylor and Francis from 1982-1992. Title was changed to Electro and Magnetobiology. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Electroceutical Medicine: founded by Richard Markoll, MD, PhD, Port d'Andratx (Majorca), Baleric Islands, Spain; **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Electronic Medicine: This was a continuation of Physico-Clinical Medicine, and ran from 1939-1945, published by Fred J. Hart and the College of Electronic Medicine. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Journal of Paraphysics/International Journal of Paraphysics: Benson Herbert started his Paraphysical Laboratory in Downton, Wiltshire, England and began publishing the Journal of Paraphysics with vol.1, no.1 in 1967, and the name was later changed to International Journal of Paraphysics. Herbert published the Journal from 1967 until around 1989, with the last volume being vol. 23 in that year. Since the Journal and Lab were mostly the project of Herbert, they fell apart as his health failed and have become defunct. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Journal of the American Electronic Research Association: Vol 1, No. 1 (January, 1924) through Vol. 13, No. ??? (1936), when it ceased publication; The USPA Library needs all issues.

Journal of the British Society of Dowsers: Published by the British Society of Dowsers from 1956-2000. Prior title was **Radio Perception**. Succeeding title: **Dowsing Today**. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

Journal of the United States Psychotronics Association. Published by the United States Psychotronics Association. Only six issues were published, and the USPA Library has a complete set.

Little Farm Journal: This periodical was published by Lutie Larsen and Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah, and focused on agruchtural radionics and related subjects. It began sometime before the first issue of The Radionic Homestead Report, which was published in May, 1988, because that issue referred to the Little Farm

Journal. It is not known when it began publishing, how many issues were published, or when it ceased publication. This periodical is not found in any library of the world, but is undoubtedly in a number of private individuals' collections. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Mind and Matter: published by George DeLaWarr of the DeLawarr Laboratories in Oxford, England from 1957-1967. **The USPA Library has a complete set of these very rare journals.**

Newsletter of the Institute of Psionic Medicine. Published by the Institute of Psionic Medicine only from 1978-1979. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Newsheet of the Psionic Medical Society. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the England only from 1975-1977. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics Journal. Published by the New Zealand Society of Dowsing & Radionics from 1988-present. **The USPA Library needs all issues**.

Physico-Clinical Medicine: This journal was started in 1916 by the father of radionics, Dr. Albert Abrams, and continued to be published up through 1938, by Fred J. Hart, who took over the College of Electronic Medicine after Abrams died in 1924. The USPA Library has all issues from 1916-1923, but need all issues from 1925-1938.

Psionic Medicine. Published by the Psionic Medical Society in the UK from 1969-around 1991. The USPA Library needs most issues.

Psychic Research Neswletter (Marcel Vogel): Volume 1, No. 1 (May-June, 1984) through Vol. 5, No. 4 (July-August, 1988) This is the periodical that Marcel Vogel published in the 1980's as part of his research organization, Psychic Research, Inc. in San Jose, California. The title of the periodical is really a misnomer, as is the name of hiresearch organization, because the periodical deals almost exclusively with Vogel's and other's research on crystals and their use in healing, and very little with psychic matters. The USPA Library has all known issues.

Psychoenergetic Systems: This periodical was published by Gordon & Breach Science Publications in New York City, and focused on psychotronic related subjects. It began with vol. 1, no. 1 in December, 1974, and continued with this title until 1981, when the title was changed to "Psychoenergetics" (ISSN: 0278-6060) with the April, 1981, issue. It then continued under this title until 1988, when the title was again changed to "Theoretical Parapsychology" (ISSN: 0894-2528). However, only one issue (vol. 6, no. 1) was ever published under this title, after which it ceased publication. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

Psychotronik: This periodical was published in Innsbruch, Austria, and focused on radionics and psychotronics related subjects. It began with Vol. 1, No. 1 in 1977, but ceased with Vol. 3 in 1979. **The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.**

Radio Perception. This was the original title of the Journal of the British Society of Dowsers, which began in 1933 and was published under that name until around 1956, when its name was changed to the Journal of the British Society of Dowsers, and

continues today under the name, Dowsing Today. The USPA Library needs all issues.

Radiesthesia. Published by the Dowser's Club of South Australia, and began in 1992. **The USPA Library needs all issues.**

Radionics Journal: Published by the Radionics Association in England from 1954 through the present. The USPA Library has a complete set of these from Vol. 1, no. 1 (1954), through 2005, but needs all issues published after 2005.

Radionics Network Newsletter: Vol. 1, No. 1 (January-February, 1993); Last Known issue: Vol. 4, No. 6 (November-December, 1996); Published by the Radionics Network, New South Wales, Australia; The USPA Library has Vol.1, No.1 (Jan.-Feb., 1993) through Vol.5, No.1 (Jan.-Feb., 1997), but needs all issues published since then.

Resonance: Newsletter of the Bioelectromagnetics Special Interest Group (BEM SIG) of American Mensa during the 1980s and 1990s. **The USPA Library has a complete set of this rare periodical**;

Subtle Energies and Energy Medicine: Published by the International Society for the Study of Subtle Energies and Energy Medicine (ISSSEEM) from 1990 through the present, with some interruptions. **The USPA Library needs most of the issues of this periodical**;

The Radiant News: Vol. 1, Issue 0 [zero] (March, 2001) through Vol. 1, No. 12 (May, 2002), after which it ceased publication. Published by Peter Lindemann of Clear Tech, Inc. **The USPA Library has all 13 issues.**

The Radionic Homestead Report: This periodical was a periodical published by Lutie Larsen and Little Farm Research in Pleasant Grove, Utah. It began with the first issue being May, 1988. It is not known how many issues were published, or when it ceased publication. The USPA Library needs all issues, except the first issue (May, 1988) and vol. 3, no. 4 (August-September, 1990), which are the only two issues in the USPA Library.

USPA Newsletter: Published by the United States Psychotronic Association from 1977 through present. **The USPA Library needs most of these issues.**

Zeitschrift RGS (Radiesthesie - Geopathie - Strahlenbiologie); (Journal of Radiesthesia, Geopathy, and Radiation Biology): This was a radiesthesia and radionics periodical published by the Schweizerische Gesellschaft für Radiästhesie (Swiss Society of Radiesthesia) in St. Gallen, Switzerland. It began publishing around 1949, although the date is uncertain, and the title was changed at some point to "Schweizerische Zeitschrift für Radiästhesie, Radionik, Geopathie, Strahlenbiologie" (Swiss Journal of Radiesthesia, Radionics, Geopathy, and Radiation Biology). It was still being published in 2014, with issue No. 291 being published during that year. The USPA Library needs all issues of this periodical.

USPA Local Groups and Affiliates Update

As mentioned in the May, 2016, USPA Newsletter, one of our goals is to reactivate all of the former 24 USPA Chapters that once existed across the US and Mexico. WHAT IS PSYCHOTRONICS?

The United States Psychotronics Association defines psychotronics as the science of mind-body-environment relationships, an interdisciplinary science concerned with the interactions of matter, energy, and consciousness. Psychotronics involves the study, research, and applications of the physics and technology of the mind, brain, spirit, consciousness, and the underlying forces of life and nature – hence the term "psychotronics".

We believe that a true understanding of the universe must include the spiritual, as well as, the technical, and provide an opportunity for amateur researchers to present their findings along with the professionals. We stress research, with documentation of results, and practical applications, rather than personal experience and unsupported hypotheses.

Some Prominent People in the history of psychotronics research and application: Albert Abrams, Thomas Bearden, Robert C. Beck, Robert O. Becker, Jacques Benveniste, David Bohm, Harold Saxon Burr, George W. Crile, Ruth Drown, T. Galen Hieronymus, Vlail P. Kaznacheyev, Georges Lakhovsky, Wilhelm Reich, Royal R. Rife, Rupert Sheldrake, Nikola Tesla, Marcel Vogel, and others.

Some of the forces, fields, waves, and energies studied and researched in psychotronics include: bioelectromagnetism, biophotons, biopotentials, electromagnetic wave pollution and harmful effects; coherent emanations of DNA, emanations of matter, "free energy", morphogenetic fields, non-hertzian waves, orgone energy, pyramid energy and power, qi (chi), quantum fields, scalar waves, subtle energies, ultra-weak radiation of living matter, zero-point energy, and others.

Some of the phenomena believed to be produced or involved with the above fields and energies: action-at-a-distance, the aura of the body and other living things, bioinformation, bioluminescence, chakras, consciousness, distant intercellular interactions, meridians of the body, mind-body interactions, non-locality, the placebo effect, quantum consciousness, spontaneous remission of cancer and other diseases, water memory, water structure, and others.

Related fields of study and research covering the above forces, energies, and phenomena of psychotronics: bioelectromagnetics, bioenergetics, biophotonics, biophysics, psionics, psychoenergetics, psychoneuroimmunology, quantum biology, radionics, scalar electromagnetics, and others.

Some practices, techniques, and applications related to psychotronics include: acupuncture, biogeometry, brain entrainment, clairvoyance, dowsing, energy healing and medicine, extrasensory perception, feng shui, homeopathy, kirlian photography, magnetic therapy, pendulum use and methods, prayer effects, psionic medicine, psychic healing, psychometry, qigong, radiesthesia, radionics, remote viewing, shamanism, sound and sonic healing, telekinesis, telepathy, and others.
