Toby Grotz is an electrical engineer who has been involved on both sides of the energy equation: exploring for oil and gas and geothermal resources and in the utility industry working in coal, natural gas, and nuclear power plants. While working in the aerospace industry, he worked on space shuttle and Hubble telescope testing in a solar simulator and space environment test facility. He has also been involved in research for new energy sources and novel forms of hydrogen production.

Toby attended the first Earth Day while at the University of Connecticut and took the first course offered in Environmental Engineering. His passion for environmental issues was fired by reading Rachel Carson’s book *Silent Spring*, which he says should be required reading for every high school student. In 1976, Toby met Jim Fowler an organic farming pioneer who owned the first health food store in Denver and introduced him to the research and work of natural farming advocates of the 1900’s, such as Lady Eve Balfour and J.I. Rodale.

As a preview of his presentation, Toby sent the following:

George Kuepper presented Radionics in the Field – It Really works!

September 25, 2021, George Kuepper gave a great presentation followed by an open Q&A. George is the author of the new book "Psychotronics and a Biodynamic Garden." We have posted the Kuepper talk in members only now.

George has more than four decades of experience in sustainable and organic farming and gardening, and has practiced radionics for well over three decades. He says, "I'm George Kuepper, originally from Wisconsin but, for many years now, a resident of the Mid-South. I earned a Master of Science from the University of Wisconsin in Agronomy in the mid-1970s and am blessed to have spent my entire career working on sustainable and organic agriculture for such noble entities as The Center for the Biology of Natural Systems in St. Louis, The National Center for Appropriate Technology (ATTRA), and the Kerr Center for Sustainable Agriculture in Oklahoma.

I discovered radionics in the 1980s while struggling to revive an Oklahoma blueberry planting where agricultural chemicals had been both overused and misused. The planting was the cornerstone for an eight-acre U-pick farm project for the aforementioned Kerr Center.

We were replanting about 10% of the berry patch annually due to disease and other losses.

Conventional testing by Universities and private labs told me what the symptoms were, but didn't help much with corrective action, other than to suggest more chemicals. It was certainly not sustainable. I'd reached the point where I'd try almost anything."

Around that time, I learned of radionics from several independent sources. I chose to listen to what the Universe seemed to be telling me, and I allowed myself to be dragged—often kicking and screaming—into a New Age art and science. I took my first radionics class in 1986 from the well-known radionics trainer, Steve Westin. Thanks to his skill and patience, I returned to the farm with enough confidence to begin turning things around. It was amazing how rapidly change happened."

November 20, 2021: Glen Rein will present "The Role of Longitudinal Scalar Energy and Bio-Energy in the Healing Process."

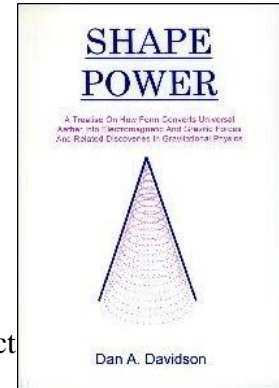
Dan Davidson, has recently (July 2021) revised and expanded his book, *Shape Power*, into a larger Second Edition.”

The new book is *Shape Power Second Edition; The Fundamental Discovery of How Shape Modifies Undifferentiated Universal Aether into Electricity, Magnetism, and Nuclear Forces*.

Dan first used the term “Shape Power” in his first book on free energy... *Energy Breakthroughs to New Free Energy Devices*. **Using Psychotronics In A Biodynamic Garden: Jens Jensen Interviews George Kuepper.**

**Q: George, thanks for agreeing to this interview. What drew you to dowsing and radionics, and how would you describe the essential ideas behind them?**

I was privileged, in the mid-1980s, to hire-on with an Oklahoma-based foundation whose mission was advancing sustainable agriculture in the eastern part of the state. I had responsibility for developing a model pick-your-own farm with diverse berry and vegetable crops. As a quick-start, the Foundation purchased a nearby 3-acre blueberry patch in its earliest years of development. While it seemed the wise move at that time, what we hadn't recognized were problems emerging from overuse and miss-application of farm chemicals. In defense of the original grower, he faced a number of challenges related to poor, shallow soil and an environment not especially welcoming to blueberries. The only tools he was aware of were agrochemicals and he naturally believed that "more was better."

During that first season, I was able to document virtually every blueberry disease and insect pest to be found in the Ozark growing region, a mere 75 miles to the north. Roughly 10% of the plants died or were so un-thrifty they had to be replaced. The next season was more of the same. Though I enlisted university and industry guidance, their advice was well-intentioned, but not helpful. I tried to bring reduced-chemical and organic practices to bear, but they seemed too little too late.

I was close to abandoning the planting when the universe rushed to the rescue. In a brief period of about three months or so, I began hearing of something called "radionics" from three or four independent sources. I recall my head snapping back each time the topic came up and knew it held

something of importance for me. A brief bit of reading on the subject scared the hell out of me. I knew it would be life-changing. But I believed the universe was providing a river of direction and means, and I was meant to go wherever the current took me. So I enrolled in my first radionics training in the summer of 1986.

The class was held on a sugar cane plantation near Mercedes, Texas, just minutes from Brownsville but a day-and-a-half drive from my home in southeastern Oklahoma. When I returned after four days of training, I was quite befuddled and doubtful. I was only able to do a few simple procedures and was not confident in them. I had my new “black box” instrument, but not much certainty that it would help.

Despite that, I immediately began applying those “few simple procedures.” I was amazed to see fast, remarkable improvements. As the season progressed, diseases and pest-infestations rapidly retreated; weed pressure declined; and all the plants took on a much healthier appearance. That year there were no dead or declining plants to replace. Within two years, our yields were competitive with plantings on much better growing sites. I began to apply radionics and dowsing (which is incorporated into the protocols of radionics) to new pick-your-own crops we planted, such as blackberries, and had similar successes.

**Q: Many people today would consider dowsing to be “folk wisdom,” meaning unscientific, subjective, and even an illusion. Is psychotronics similar in any way to the more traditional method of using a forked dowsing stick?**

Let me try to clarify. According to my grasp of the term, psychotronics involves the interaction of the mind (psycho) with physical devices (tronics). Based on this understanding, it (psychotronics) is an umbrella term that encompasses dowsing—where simple tools such as forked sticks, L-shaped rods, and pendulums are used—and radionics, which relies on complex instrumentation. A continuum exists between these two modalities based on the complexity of tools employed. The principles and paradigms, however, are essentially the same.

**Q: Does dowsing in this sense require developed intuition, clairvoyance, or some other special capacity?**

The vast majority of us are endowed with the talent of intuition. Most also have the physical capability to achieve responses from pendulums, forked sticks, and the “stick plates” used in radionics instruments. These responses are, in fact, the result “ideomotor” activity—very small neuromuscular reactions that are amplified by dowsing and radionics tools.

Of course, there are some who cannot dowse, for example, those suffering certain kinds of brain or nervous system damage, and individuals under the influence of certain drugs or alcohol. However, many who claim they cannot dowse, or do basic radionics, often construct their own barriers to learning. Sometimes those barriers arise for psychological, cultural, or religious reasons. But whatever the reason, denial and doubt are self-reinforcing, and ensure failure at any form of psychotronics without a significant change in attitude or belief system.

That said, we need to recognize that innate intuition, while present in almost all of us, is not evenly distributed. We know that most of us are well-able to paint a bedroom wall; far fewer, however, can provide it with an attractive mural. And only a sprinkling of those with extra talent can paint a valuable, artistic masterpiece to hang there. The analogy goes on to suggest that, as most all of us can do the practical task of painting a wall, most of us can also dowse at some practical level that will be useful and reliable.

**Q: Would you briefly describe the basic electronic instrumentation of radionics and how it is used?**

Radionics instruments are tools for the mind. They provide an organized procedural means for finding information that we cannot access through reasoning. They do this by clarifying and holding the operator’s intentions and, as with dowsing, provide a physical means for finding accurate and precise details through pendulum responses, physical sensations on a smooth rubbing plate, or other means, some of which are similar to those used in biofeedback and polygraph testing. Furthermore, radionics

instruments can hold operator intent to provide healing and balance to plants, gardens, and landscapes, as well as to humans and animals—something akin to psychic healing.

Now, what I have just described can also be done using less complex and lower-cost dowsing tools, though it often requires more intense and sustained focus. Instrumentation also provides something like a psychic firewall that reduces the operator's vulnerability to negative influences and conserves his or her energy.

It is also true that some people simply have more confidence when using instrumentation. I tend to be one of those. But certainly, it is this fascination with the technology that seems to draw so many engineers to radionics.

**Q: How can you know that the results obtained from dowsing are “real” and not just self-deception?**

Confidence in dowsing and radionics derives largely from practice and the trust that comes with it. However, self-deception is not only possible, but likely when we allow personal prejudices and assumptions to drive the process. Unless the dowser approaches with a truly open mind, he or she might use it to justify racism, social injustice, environmental destruction and other unhealthy ideas and actions.

What I'm saying might appear to suggest that dowsing and radionics are too risky to mess with. Perhaps that's true for some. I, for one, have found psychotronics a fantastic tool for expansion of consciousness and advancing spiritual growth. If you sincerely seek the truth and proper guidance for your life, it should work that way for others as well.

**Q: How does one's intent play into the process and results of dowsing?**

Focused intent is a requisite for accuracy and precision. Clear intent allows us to resonate with the subject we are studying as well as its specific aspects or qualities. This is the “psycho” part of psychotronics. If we ignore that part, we are simply left with the interesting but useless “tronics” part; we have devices that no longer have utility.

**Q: When and why did you take up biodynamic methods for gardening?**

Years before venturing into psychotronics, I learned of biodynamics, from organic farmers in the upper Midwest. I went on to read an array of pamphlets and articles on it; I even began Steiner's “Agriculture Course.” Unfortunately, I just wasn't prepared for the metaphysical concepts. So, while I remained curious, I largely shelved any efforts to understand BD for quite some time. It wasn't until I was well into radionics that I began to grasp what biodynamics might be about and resumed looking more closely at it.

My professional work enabled me to toy a bit with the more mystical practices of BD. I found synchronizing horticultural practices with celestial phenomena very useful, especially for fertilization and mowing operations.

It wasn't until I approached retirement around 2015 that I immersed myself into biodynamic practice on my own property in northwest Arkansas. I set out with the objective of discovering ways in which psychotronics could aid biodynamic farming and gardening. This is ongoing work for me, and centers on my one-quarter acre garden. It's not always a pretty site as I'm also experimenting with organic no-till methods and other practices that make the place appear more unkempt than it is.

**Q: Do beings such as elementals, devas, and so on have a role in psychotronics?**

Like biodynamics, I played with the concepts and practices for communicating with nature's “intelligences” for years, not really understanding their roles or their relevance to what I was doing with organics and psychotronics. I began with the writings of Machaelle Small Wright of Perelandra Garden and continue to follow her guidance. I strongly recommend her work to others. As with BD, my early efforts in this area were just as confusing and not terribly successful. Again, I really didn't understand the essentials. While I still make my share of mistakes these days, the situation is vastly different. I've found real harmony and great satisfaction in working with devas and nature spirits.

As for the specific matter of psychotronics and its relationship with nature beings: One can practice dowsing and radionics without intentional acknowledgement of their existence or the roles they play in



the natural world. Though I consider the information about devas and elementals the most important topic of my book, I present things in such a way that readers can draw upon psychotronics without focusing on nature beings at all, should they so choose. In my opinion, however, they are missing out on something truly beautiful.

Psychotronics is actually quite utilitarian; it can easily be adapted to different gardening and farming philosophies and approaches. As an early student of agricultural radionics, I was taught concepts associated with Carey Reams' "Biological Theory of Ionization." Reams' theory formed the basic structure in which I and others used psychotronics to determine what to do with the crop, what to apply to the soil, and when to do these things.

Simultaneously, however, teachers and researchers elsewhere were using radionics to guide BD practices, organics more generally, Albrecht theory, and even conventional farming with agrochemicals. I am choosing to use psychotronics with biodynamics because through BD I'm discovering a coherent and spiritual understanding of nature that welcomes the knowledge of the conventional sciences, while selecting only technologies that are life-affirming.

Daniel Taylor recommended the article "How GPS Weakens Memory--and What We Can Do about It"¹

A new app helps you navigate, not with turn-by-turn directions but via audio "beacons."

Using mobile phones to navigate has become second nature. Whether you're heading to a new park, meeting friends at a restaurant, or going to run errands, you just tap the location on your phone and go. Prior to GPS, exploring and wayfinding in new places required preparation. We had to think, consult paper maps, and plan and memorize parts of our route. But in today's technological world, there is no need to think. Simply follow the turn-by-turn directions on your phone, and you'll end up where you need to be. But your overall sense of the place suffers. Spatial navigation, which had been a process performed exclusively by the human brain and perceptual system, has now been surrendered to technology.

However, in doing so, we also surrendered our agency. Does it matter?

There are structures in the brain dedicated to these complex pathfinding tasks. In particular, the hippocampus is deeply associated with supporting spatial memory, spatial navigation and mental mapping.

Anthropologists have gone so far as to suggest that navigation needs might have been the starting point for all memories (as discussed in Nicholas Carr's book *The Glass Cage*). For example, mnemonic techniques for remembering large numbers such as the digits of pi often rely on the "memory palace" (or "method of loci") made famous by Cicero, with multiple floors and connected chambers in which one mentally stores the digits. One can then recall a long sequence of digits through an imaginary navigation, revisiting the chambers of this memory palace.

IF WE DON'T USE IT, WE LOSE IT

As we age, our memory declines. And while there is no silver bullet for healthy aging; neuroscientists agree that one of the key ingredients of successful aging is staying mentally active. Studies show that we can actually exercise the hippocampus memory through exploration and spatial navigation. Expert navigators such as London cab drivers have larger hippocampi compared to regular populations in consequence of their intensive spatial mapping and multisensory experience of the city.

If spatial navigation is such an essential element to healthy aging and mental activity, why surrender this critical skill to our phones? By following a set of digital turn-by-turn directions, GPS navigation apps treat us as passive passengers rather than active explorers, removing our agency to make decisions.

In turn this inhibits our ability to create proper mental maps of the surrounding environment, and negatively impacts the hippocampus, which is critical for brain health.

While advances in technology clearly have many benefits, we must remain mindful that technology can influence the brain. Ultimately our goal should be to create and design technology in ways that complement our brain and enhance our opportunities to interact and engage with the real world around us.

PHYSICAL MAPS, THE FIRST REVOLUTION

Mental maps arise from direct experience. As we explore new environments, the brain constantly maps out our surroundings. And we use all of our senses to learn about and remember our surroundings, not just vision. In particular, evolution rewarded auditory navigation: as hunter-gatherers we listened to the environment and moved towards sounds, allowing us to avoid predators, track prey and locate water sources. Our brains ultimately could generate detailed maps of our environment through active exploration, a hard-won evolutionary skill that never went away.

So even today, strolling along a modern city waterfront, we might hear the petulant squawks of seagulls fighting over a bread crust, or the low throaty notes of approaching ships in the fog. We refer to such distinctive, spatially situated sounds as *auditory beacons*.

However, as civilizations expanded and grew, it became more difficult to navigate over long distances only through sensory experiences and memory. One cannot sail to another continent on senses alone. So, maps were a revolution for humanity. Rudimentary maps were created as early as 16,500 B.C. when people drew paintings on the walls of caves showing stars or landscape features. Later, these were carved into wood or rocks so they could be carried while traveling. But it wasn't until the ancient Greeks and early Chinese dynasties that the first paper maps appeared.

Physical maps were a revolution. They can contain enormous amounts of information about the surrounding environment on a simple piece of paper, but using them successfully requires both the correct placement of oneself within the map and the correct heading. Maps are an example of *allocentric* navigation, with *allo-* meaning “other”: all the information on the map is displayed as it relates to other features and landmarks within the environment.

In contrast, a set of directions is direct and easy to follow. Directions are an example of *egocentric* navigation, with *ego-* meaning “self”: all information is relative to the person's current position and orientation. However, egocentric navigation and directions are considerably less flexible as they only work from a single location and contain significantly less information about the broader environment.

The challenge is that physical maps can be very abstract and require many other techniques to operate, such as the ability to determine where in the map one is located. Indeed, maps evolved in parallel with wayfinding techniques. Wayfinding tools empower self-location, from compass to stars, latitude, longitude and realigning landmarks. Such tools allow us to achieve the self-location and heading necessary for allocentric navigation. But the expertise needed to be a successful navigator is not within everyone's grasp. Even commercial airplanes used to have an expert navigator on board: a person dedicated to determining the aircraft's current position—and next changes to heading—on top of a map. At the individual level most of us didn't have the luxury to afford a navigator, and families would have table discussions preparing routes for their trips. And then assign their own familial navigators.

GPS NAVIGATION

The rise of satellite-enabled GPS was revolutionary for navigation, and with the rise of mobile phones, anyone can have their personal navigator. We can go places spontaneously, with little need for planning or additional people to navigate. GPS navigation apps enable egocentric navigation with easy-to-follow turn-by-turn directions: “Turn right in 100 meters, then turn left,” all the way to the destination. With these conveniences at our fingertips, we are no longer active navigators; we are passive passengers aboard the GPS.

However, multiple experiments have shown that this easy egocentric navigation also reduces spatial awareness and mental mapping when compared to more traditional forms of allocentric

navigation like paper maps. See for example recent work by Eran Ben-Elia comparing paper maps to Google Maps, in which app users significantly underperformed on traditional memory map tasks such as pointing or landmark recognition.

Our question is: Can we find a way to still use GPS but reduce the harmful effects of current GPS navigation on memory?

The challenge is to create alternative forms of GPS navigation that will remain easy enough for the general public, but also enable allocentric navigation and thus be more likely to improve spatial awareness.

Our research finds that appropriately designed audio beacons offer an alternative that fosters a much more active form of egocentric navigation. Instead of guiding users to turn right and turn left on the way to their desired destination, we can convert a location of interest to a distinctive auditory beacon (digital versions of the aforementioned petulant squawks and low throaty notes) via earbuds or headphones. Our auditory navigation application, known as Soundscape, has an effect that resembles a church bell or minaret, where peals or calls to prayer can be heard at great distance; our would-be navigator can make way by heading toward the sound.

But audio beacons can be created for any chosen destination, and without sound decay, so they can be heard from as far away as needed. With an audio beacon at the destination, a pharmacy two miles away can produce a sound that we can hear through our phone. Then one simply moves towards it, but unlike with turn-by-turn directions, you can build spatial awareness through active and direct exploration of the environment along the way.

In recent experiments, available in our publication in *Scientific Reports* (an open-access journal by the publisher of *Nature*), we show that this type of sensory navigation through audio beacons outperforms turn-by-turn navigation in the creation of mental maps.

We believe these results, at least in part, derive from people taking a more active role in their navigation. They explore more while using auditory beacons, and can engage with the environment, both of which support allocentric navigation and the construction of mental maps.

We invite the reader to try such auditory beacon experience by trying the Soundscape app on their mobile phone. The Soundscape team originally designed the app as an experimental tool to enable blind and low vision populations with a potentially safer, more robust and accessible navigation than turn-by-turn options; to date, it has enabled over 500,000 walks in seven countries. <https://youtu.be/BMG1uVuBW3w>

Auditory beacon navigation is an example of how we are entering into an era where noxious effects of automation on our brain health will be at the forefront of technological development. Technology does not need to replace our evolutionary functions and distance us from our environments, but rather with appropriate design can complement the sensory inputs processed by our brain. In that regard, GPS navigation based on auditory beacons offers a compelling example of a sensory augmentation that helps humans connect more deeply with reality; perhaps instead of evolving into a new species of turn-by-turn zombies, we can thereby all engage more deeply with humanity, our local environment, and life itself.

A Quest for Connections: The Mark Gallert Analyser

Dan Taylor fielded the rest of the inquiry, by saying this: “Articles are frequently useful in the hands of radionics practitioners, without usually being explicitly written for one form of instrumentation over another. However, Mark Gallert and Katherine Gray did influence several practitioners in the Ontario, Canada, area.”

Here are a few excerpts from the article “BREATH ON THE MIRROR

Even in this century, for all its worldliness, there have been significant currents of thought which privilege and order of existence that is inaccessible to the senses. Though not experienced directly, the processes that take place in this unseen realm were regarded as having profound implications for one's state of mind and general wellbeing. This was therefore a site of healing, and it followed that along the margins of the mainstream various systems of medicine would develop which paid heed to nonphysical phenomena that escaped quantification by means of standard measures.

Typically the practitioners of these forms of healing relied less upon apparatus and controlled experiment than upon their own sensitivities in order to identify and relieve suffering. Any such healers claimed to experience the world around them as radiating subtle energies, imperceptible to the eye but discernible indirectly through the radiesthetic, or dowsing faculty, which is intimately allied to the sense of touch. [1] These healers maintained that when energies of this order were deviated or blocked, physical disease would eventually result. Though fundamentally at odds with the dominant paradigm, those who sense the presence of another world sometimes draw upon the idioms of science and technology to bring a measure of orderliness – and perhaps legitimacy – to their perceptions.

In so doing, they may well achieve a higher level of integration by reconciling – as we would say today – the contrasting functions of the right and left cerebral hemispheres. Yet in the effort to render non-linear functions in lineal terms they also run the risk of obscuring a delicate faculty with cultural glosses, with blurred approximations that tend to obscure the very phenomena which they seek to mirror. Hence, the title of this paper.

One especially vigorous and systematic attempt at reconciling these two hemispheric functions emerged in the United States during the 1920s. Called *radionics* by the pioneering practitioner Ruth Drown, this field attracted a dynamic assortment of mystics and tinkerers, who found it helpful to translate radiesthetic perception into the contemporary technology of telephone switchboards and wireless sets. Evidently this merging of tactility and electronics was in line with the times, for until it encountered opposition from the state authorities, radionic treatment became a standard feature in

many chiropractic offices, and there were a number of lay healers who practiced it as well (See, for example, Laurie 2009 ; The Radionist 1968; and Russell 1973).

Most of the early radionic practitioners were at home in the technical world, making it a short step for them to try and represent their knowledge with numeric expressions and wiring diagrams, in the

hope among other things that their schematics would be duly accepted as a scientific undertaking. In conformity with the expansionist ideology of the times, they were persuaded that industrialism was meant to foster the greatest good; and because their own work was evidently so effective and inexpensive compared to the cost of drugs and surgery, it seemed only natural that it would flourish in the heartland of profit-oriented enterprise.

What happened instead was that the State, under the rubric of "device quackery", mustered its power against the radionics initiative.

In the United States Ruth Drown, a prominent exponent was imprisoned, other practitioners were harassed, and several thousand instruments were confiscated by the Federal Drug Administration. No longer respected as healers, but derided as shysters, those few who remained in the field chose either to emigrate or to continue their work on a clandestine basis. Such is the situation even today in the United States, where the authorities permit radionics only as a technique of "soil analysis." In Canada, where radionics has not drawn the attention of repressive authority, present-day practitioners so far need only remain discrete to avoid unpleasant consequences. In Britain, where there is more acceptance of medical pluralism, a healer can obtain standardized radionic training and keep an open office with little fear of reprisal.

A full chronicle of the suppression of radionics is yet to be written. Our purpose here, rather, is to focus intensively upon the work of a single practitioner, who in addition to being a healer and a tinkerer also displayed the qualities of a shaman by intruding fearlessly upon the darker regions of the vibrational realm. In an immensely productive career that spanned the years from 1950 to 1985, Mark L. Gallert, a naturopathic doctor with a background in the physical sciences, not only developed instrumentation that amplified and calibrated his radiesthetic perceptions, but also sought to make his findings available to a wider research community, both in America and in Europe. What Gallert attempted has become a distinct strand of "vibrational medicine" down to the present day. At the same time, Gallert suffered the limitations of his own personality, while contending with the hard-nosed temper of the times. [4] At the intersection of all these influences was his effort to delineate medical knowledge in terms of numerical strings that were amenable to radionic manipulation.

A visionary on the borderlands of healing, Gallert tended to race out in front of his naturopathic colleagues, circulating news of his latest discovery in the form of mimeographed bulletins, which he called "releases." At the peak of his production in the 1970s, Gallert managed to distribute at least one fresh release per month. With the researcher zigzagging breathlessly from case to case and from topic to topic, this certainly made for exciting reading; but it also denied the author the opportunity either to substantiate his immediate results, to assess the consistency of his therapeutic results over time, or to systematize his broadening worldview. As an overworked practitioner, Gallert was not inclined to expend his precious time on epistemological questions. Likely he would have been impatient with any attempt, however well-meaning, to uncover the assumptions governing his translation of radiesthetic sensation into numerical expressions.

Like those of his borderland lineage - Albert Abrams, Ruth Drown, A. Stanley Rodgers and T.G. Hieronymous among others - Mark Gallert sought to understand the world, not through the familiar signifiers of language, but through the reductionism of plain numbers. Consisting of simple integers, the terrain of numbers was familiar to everyone on an everyday basis, yet it provided the intellectual leverage by which science and industry were able to transform the world. It seemed appropriate therefore to employ numbers in order to make radionics a diagnostic and/or treatment modality that could be easily grasped by one's mainstream colleagues. To this end and very much in the tradition of his predecessors, Gallert spent years perfecting an apparatus that would embody his comprehensive vision of health and disease. And in its final form Gallert's White Light instrument, festooned with dials and toggles, indeed represented a high-water mark within that tradition. In its panel design and inner circuitry Gallert's instrument followed a line of development from the so-called "Calbro Magnowave" through models produced by the Detroit-based Art Tool & Die Co, and by Kenneth Hunter in the post-

war period (The Radionist 1968: 13). Under the influence of A. Stanley Rogers, Gallert introduced some further improvements, having learned from early experience in the field that a tuner panel having at least 5 rows of 9 dials each, totaling 45 dials, was needed for the attainment of superior results. Fifteen years ago, the author found it essential to improve the detector apparatus in the interest of greater sensitivity and precision of signal, which in turn led to easier operation of the equipment. (Gallert 1965b: 171)

The White Light instrument resembled nothing so much as a large wireless set that was flanked by two subsidiary units, which we might nowadays call "peripherals." To the right of the operator sat a tablet-like module consisting of a rosewood rubbing plate placed atop a heating coil, along with a set of three dials which were meant to adjust the plate's sensitivity. To the left of the operator was a second module, deeper than the first, but of roughly the same horizontal dimensions. Apart from some on/off toggle switches and a "flash" clearing button, this box contained the witness well, which was about three inches in diameter and two inches deep. Set in the side of the well, a small, frosted bulb served to illuminate a sample, or "witness," placed therein. Positioned beneath the well was a colour-wheel. A metal disk with circles cut to hold gelatin slides, the wheel was itself illuminated from below by a second bulb, its purpose being to direct light through one or another of the coloured slides onto the witness above, bathing it with a variety of spectra in order to enhance its emissions (and hence its perceptibility through radiesthesia).



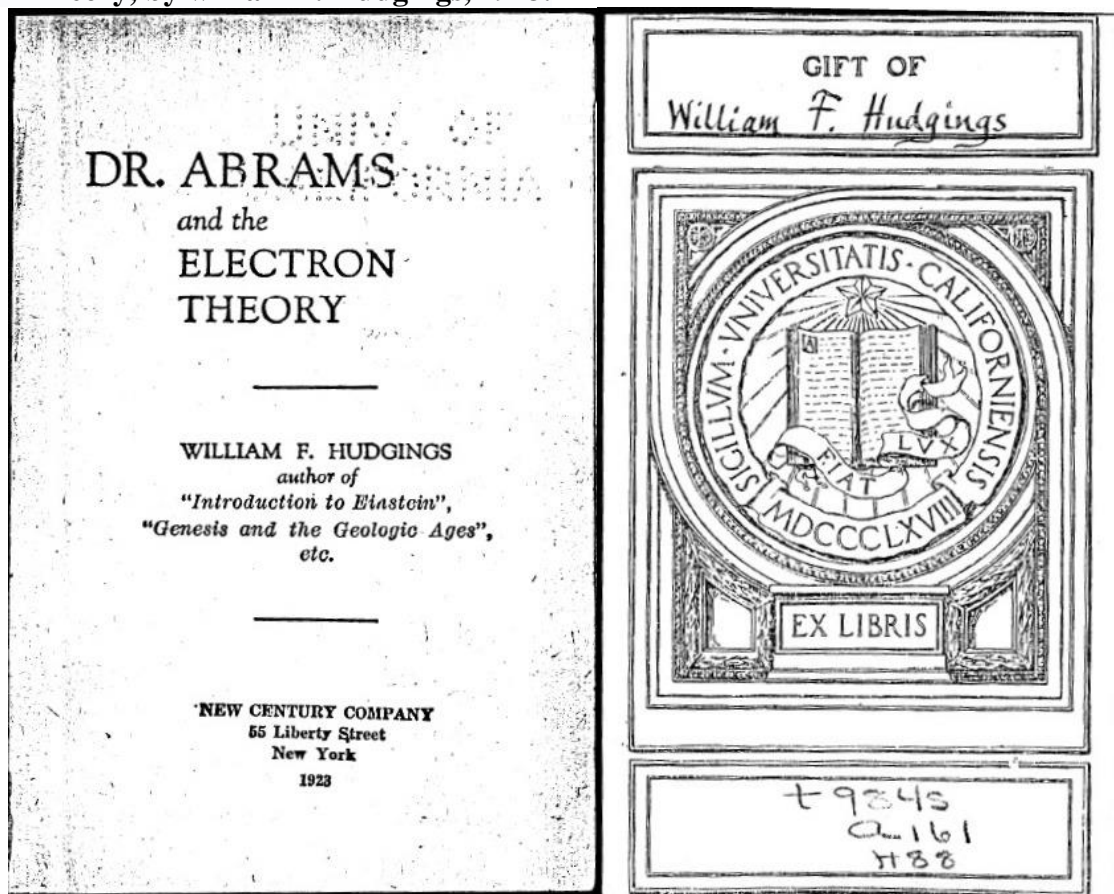
Illustration 1: The Gallert White Light Radionics Instrument

The central component of Gallert's instrument was situated directly in front of the operator. Fastened to the other two flanking modules by means of wing-nuts, it was linked to them electronically through a wiring harness. Bulking large, being on the order of two feet high by three feet long and one foot deep, this unit was basically an upright panel box, carefully sealed from all incident light, on the face of which were mounted five rows of dials, with nine dials per row. Each dial had twelve click-settings, numbered from zero to eleven. In Gallert's system each dial-row was intended to represent, or resonate, with a particular aspect of medical perception. Thus, the topmost row was reserved for disease conditions or etiological factors, while the second and third rows represented organ tunings, or planes of being. The fourth row served to register levels of vitality or pathological severity, while the bottom row was intended for treatment rates.

Introductory

This treatise on the electronic structure of matter and the effects of electronic vibrations within the atom has been undertaken in the belief that the general reader is deeply interested in the work of scientific men if informed about it in comprehensible phrase.

It is regrettable that so few scientific works have been written in language that the popular mind can understand. The average person habitually yearns for knowledge concerning the mysteries of the universe, and every scientific discovery is hailed with popular enthusiasm when the story is told in language simple and lucid. But too often our scientific writers, being brilliantly endowed and accustomed to thinking in abstruse and technical terms, find it quite impossible to come down to the layman's level and express themselves in popular phraseology.

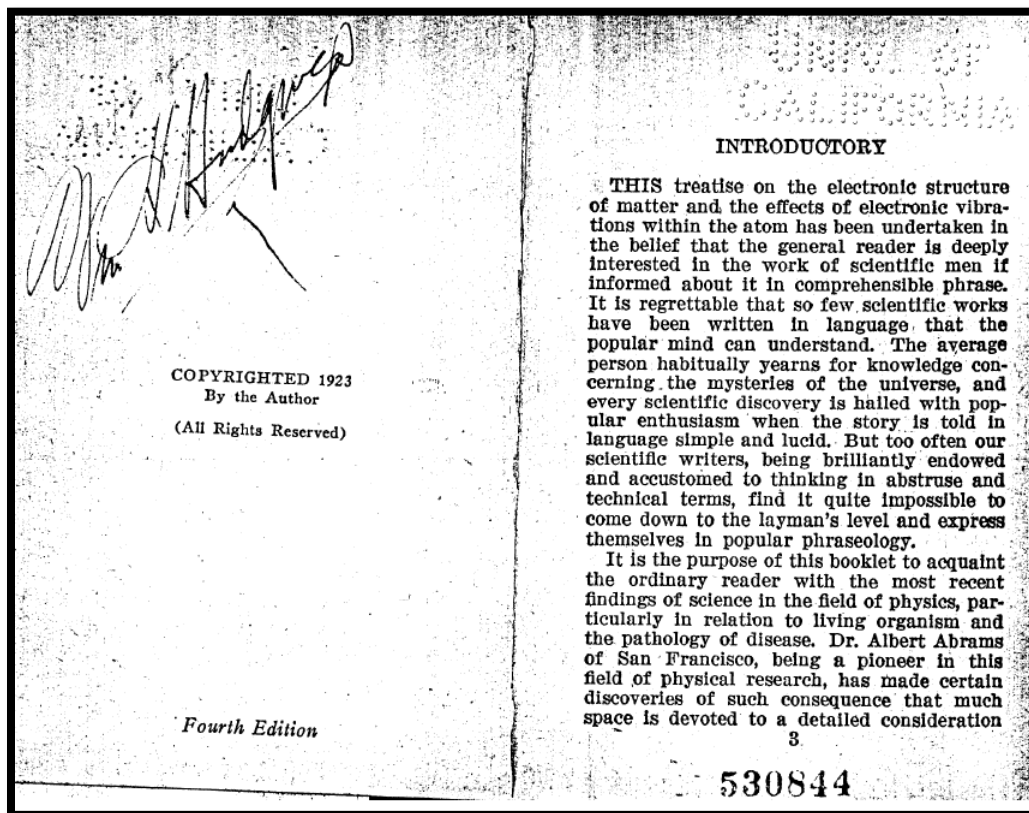
It is the purpose of this booklet to acquaint the ordinary reader with the most recent findings of science in the field of physics, particularly in relation to living organism and the pathology of disease. Dr. Albert Abrams of San Francisco, being a pioneer in this field of physical research, has made certain discoveries of such consequence that much space is devoted to a detailed consideration of his findings. After his experiments have been described, the reader will find in part two of this essay a full popular treatise on the modern electron theory of matter upon which the Abrams research work is based.

This part of the essay is really a simplified condensation of all the technical works on physical science of the past 20 years in so far as they relate to the electronic structure of atoms and to chemistry, recording every important discovery on the subject down to the present time.

CONCLUSION

Having now examined into the fundamental basis of material atoms and seeing how completely wonderful are there electronic mechanisms, we are the better prepared to appreciate the electronic reactions of Abrams as outlined in the first part of this book. That which at first may have appeared fantastic and far-fetched is now seen to be scientifically well-founded.

It must also be remembered that while our present treatise on the electron theory has been confined to atoms of inorganic matter, Dr. Abrams researches concern the still more intricate problem of living organism. There is a difference between the atoms of organic and inorganic matter, but just what the differences consist of no scientist yet knows. He must content himself with the mere descriptive distinction that the one has life while the other does not.

What is life? That is the great problem that is still unsolved. To declare that life is energy is entirely too indefinite, because all kinds of atoms, organic or inorganic, possessed energy, as we have seen. The chemist can analyze a living organism; he can determine the elements of which it is composed, and can specify the atomic proportions of each to the molecule. Yet when they are put together by the hand of man the combination though chemically correct, lacks life; it is but inorganic. Considering, then, the electronic intricacies of living organisms, who can afford to blindly contend that the electronic reactions of Abrams are the products of imagination? It is inexcusable folly to say, "it can't be done," when it has been done and is being done every day by 1000 positions.

Nearly every advance in knowledge has been brought about by the sheer aggressiveness of somebody who has dared to depart from the beaten path of ages and plunge determinedly into the wilderness of the unknown. Dr. Abrams has enlarged the horizon of physical science; he has thrown new light upon the subject of atomic mechanism; he has broken an entirely new ground in the field of nature and has opened wide a door to undreamed of possibilities. It is plainly the duty of every true scientist to now aid in further uncovering the long hidden treasures of this infinitesimal world of electrons of which we are made and which he has brought into prominent view.

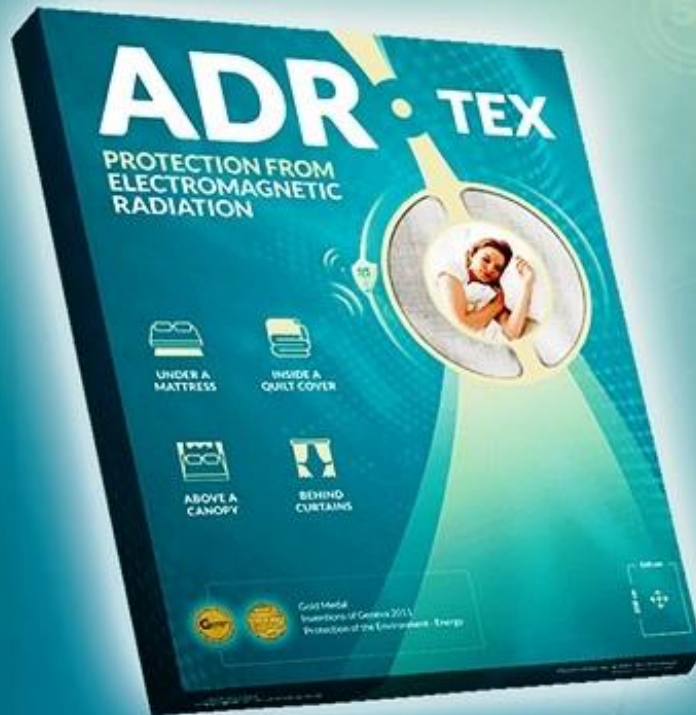


