From Beverly Rubik – Passing of Lisa Tully (May 19, 1961 to June 11, 2022)

Dear Friends & Colleagues,

"I have some very sad news. A colleague and friend, Lisa Tully, has passed away. She was 61 years old. Lisa held a PhD in pharmacology and was a researcher of energy medicine over many years."

The following is adapted from her website at the Energy Medicine Research Institute:
Lisa received her PhD in Pharmacology and Toxicology and completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the Indiana University School of Medicine. She received her undergraduate degree in Biology/Chemistry from Indiana University Southeast, followed by the Medical Neurobiology Program at Indiana University-Purdue University and a Summer Research program in Marine Biology at University of Texas, Austin, before pursuing her PhD.

She was the author of many publications in peer-reviewed medical journals (some in her married name of Barber) and presented her research at international scientific conferences. She served on the Scientific Advisory Board of several companies and non-profit organizations.

Dr. Tully founded the Energy Medicine Research Institute (EMRI), whose primary mission was to assess the efficacy of vibrational medicine technologies and therapies. Her clients included scientists working on the cutting edge of energy-based diagnostics and therapeutics. Over the past two decades, Lisa attended hundreds of health, medical and natural product conferences and developed an extensive network of health, medical and scientific colleagues, always seeking to stay on the cutting edge of frontier diagnostics and therapeutics.

You'll find me in the Lab -A farewell to Alexis Guy Obolensky

I wrote this obituary on January 9th, 2018 on Facebook. I decided to post it here as well as I might one day leave Facebook as I am not happy with some of the choices they make and I want a part of my Uncle to stay alive in the currents of the interwebs ...

I just found out that my uncle Alexis Guy Obolensky died last night. I am sad: (He was my grandmother's first cousin and the ex-husband of my mother's twin sister. My uncle guy was not your average bear, if the doctor from back to the future had a baby with uncle Fester you would have had Guy. My uncle was a scientist and a brilliant one at that. He was recruited by Colgate at 19 and made millions for them and with them. He never had any formal training he was entirely self-taught and a true Genius. He did some pretty crazy stuff after that in his own Lab and also was contracted by the government (on work I cannot discuss obviously).

When I was 17 I lived with him at his laboratory and was part lab rat and part conversation partner. Guy saw the world quite differently than most people and conventional ethics and norms just did not apply or exist with him. Like uncle Fester he was not beyond self-experimentation, but he equally had no qualms testing theories and things on you just to say, "I wanted to see how you react to ABC or how XYZ affects you".

Most human beings did not really register with Guy, at least not as equals. Most people bored him, on a deeper level, and like most eccentrics, the needs or feelings of other people did not always register with him. However my uncle was never malicious or mean spirited, quite the opposite. When he was in the mood for people he was gregarious, friendly and open, like a child. He loved talking to an audience about his quite interesting life. Stories about his friend the Satanist rabbi who conjured demons in the lab and died there, stories about his inventions, women and many friends from all parts of the world were spun and given to an often wide eyed audience.

Parts of Guy remained the eternal boy, always wanting to tease you with the scientific equivalent of a frog down your dress, a glint in his eye enjoying the fun he was having with you. He was however never so good at 'adulting;' he married strong women who took care of the daily details he would completely forget. Both his wives made sure he was fed and that bills were paid, clothes were washed and his life organized. Chaos always broke out when he was left to his own devices. Thankfully despite his friendly indifference Guy was always able to invoke admiration and love in a steady flow

of interns who, some more some less successfully, kept the grey parts of the world at bay for him after his divorces.

Sadly guy also had a few shady types who were drawn to him, and because he was almost childlike in his approach to people he trusted fully and openly, some took very much advantage of him and he lost the lion share of his fortune.

Guy was no coward however he exposed some very unsavory dealings in the military during the Reagan era and was not afraid to stand against the subsequent bullying that followed suit. When I lived at the lab it could happen that we had secret service people hiding in the bushes or parking on the other side of the street. Guy did not back down and I had some real respect for him for that.

I loved living at the lab. It was like some crazy sitcom. I lived on the top floor of the side house he on the bottom. Sometimes I would help him or watch him work in the lab. Anything from shooting lightning bolts though the place to decontaminating equipment he bought from a nuclear plant could happen there. He even had bottles he stored gold in protected by liquid cyanide. Most of his work was based on that of Nicola Tesla, who he worshiped. Once he decided to perfect the concept of a bug zapper. His version was bug zapping on steroids basically anything flying near the thing in a one and a half foot radius fell died out of the sky leaving a very disturbing round carpet under it.

My relationship to guy was strange; on the one hand he did experiment on me more than once. On the other he was one of the only people I could talk to about how I see the universe, quantum physics, sound affecting mood and other 'sciencey' stuff that would have peoples' eyes glazing over with in most cases. In these moments he would look at me and it was like his gaze would focus and finally register me. On other evenings he would sneak up in my kitchen and raid my fridge usually going after the giant bottle of vodka I had stashed there and a cold slice of pizza. I would always mock scold him but he knew I did not mind. Often those were the times we would sit and talk and I would find out what experiments he had done on me, which we would then discuss in length.

There was one room in the some point it got so bad that I That evening Guy told me that a that room and that he wanted to see he was a man of science he also the paranormal. One of his witch and he would gleefully tell lover to drop dead and that he his horse right in front of her.

Guy was a father to five marriage and two from his last. He was not the best of fathers he was to be.

In many ways it is sad because exceptional human beings and he

children; three from his first had four girls and one boy. Guy just too much in his own world

all five of them grew up to be only fleetingly caught glimpses

of it. That being said I know that he loved them as deeply as Guy was capable of loving and when for a minute he did focus on their existence he was very proud of them.

I lost contact with him over the years. When I was younger we would still talk regularly on the phone once or twice a year. But life does what life does and I got caught up in my own very turbulent life. I saw guy last in summer 2003 at a party at my aunt Bebe's house. I was there because I had flown my dogs in from Europe and had come to NY to pick them up at the airport.

I remember what he was wearing; it was a dress shirt with fine light blue pin stripes, some tan trousers with a maroon leather belt. The last impression my mind has of him is him standing between the living and dining room of Bebe's house with a plate of her cooking, that he always very much

appreciated. His eyes crinkled at the corners; his smile was wide and friendly, his head was slightly tossed back and he was laughing at something.

Today I am sad. I lost my uncle who in a way I thought would live forever in his laboratory in my mental landscape. How is it that people stop aging in our minds when we have not seen them for so long? I don't always understand my emotions or am not always able to decipher them correctly; but considering the tears that are flowing like rivers down my face as I write this, I must have loved him more deeply than I even understood.

To my cousins Helena, Anna, Michael, Nina and Alexa I say I am so incredibly sorry for your loss. I love you even if I am more of a hermit and some of us have had differences in the past. You five are undoubtedly Guy's greatest creations and he loved you more than you know.

And Guy, I bid you goodbye; if there is a life after death you are undoubtedly hanging with Tesla and Einstein. Until we meet again Godspeed.

Effects of Psychotronics Treatments on Agricultural Soils

Introduction

From 2020 to the present, the authors have been engaged in developing and refining psychotronic2 methods for advancing crop production in the Arkansas Delta. The long-term objective was, and remains, the development of a viable commercial enterprise.

During 2021, in the process of testing various techniques, we documented positive physical changes in the field soils of several farms. Our methodologies centered primarily on psychotronic broadcasting, and it is these results that we record and discuss here.

Historical Perspective

From the late 1940s into the early 1970s, a commercial venture called U.K.A.C.O, provided psychotronics services to farmers in several states, with a particular focus on pest management.

According to popular sources, U.K.A.C.O. was quite successful.4 While letters of attestation from the Farm Bureau and others are available, there appears to be little detailed documentation of those successes and scant records of the methodologies used; certainly nothing that includes hard physical data. Subsequent to this, many have applied psychotronics to agriculture with further claims of success; these, however, remain largely anecdotal. When scant documentation is added to its controversial nature, there is little to encourage serious investigation of agricultural psychotronics by the conventional scientific and agricultural communities.

Still, the lack of hard data does not discourage many committed farmers and practitioners, however. To paraphrase one of them, "We've been doing this a long time and we have confidence in what we're doing." That said, conventional documentation of psychotronics applications would support and encourage farmers and others in the practicing community to investigate, develop, and expand their application of this intriguing method.

From Scott Beutlich: William A. Tiller, Ph.D. on Radionics, Radiesthesia and Physics

William A. Tiller, Ph.D. Doctor Tiller, a director of the Academy of Parapsychology and Medicine, has been chairman of the Department Of Materials Science at Stanford University since 1966 and is a consultant to government and industry in the field metallurgy and solid state physics. He has published more than 100 scientific papers, has five patents issued, and has a definitive text on the Science of Crystallization in preparation, and area in which he is an international authority.

He is a member of honorary societies and is associate editor for two scientific journals. In 1970 he was awarded a Guggenheim fellowship for a year study at Oxford University, England. Doctor tiller has been engaged educationally in a variety of activities related to parapsychology. These include lecturing and writing. He has two books now in progress, one on the subject of "concepts and models were understanding the transformation of man."

Introduction

The word "radiesthesia" may be defined as <u>sensitivity to radiations</u> covering the whole field of radiations from any source either living or inert. Special examples of this sensitivity are to be found in the activities of eyeless sight (dermoptical activity), clairvoyance, clairaudience, telepathy, psychometric, dowsing, and so on.

Of course those radiations associated with the five physical senses are well known and, presumably, perception of these other radiations by the brain occurs in a similar fashion to the mode of operation of the physical senses; I. E., a sensory network receives the radiations and sends a set of energy pulses to an appropriate level of the brain for transferal to an interpretation unit at the conscious level of the brain in addition, complex information can ripple these waves much as audio and video information ripple that television electromagnetic carrier wave.

In some people, all the important network linkages have been constructed and are in good operating condition so that they perceive these radiations in most of us, more "muscle building" is needed in this area to put the circuitry in reliable working order!

Radionics is an instrumental form of radiesthesia and as such, deals with the interaction between mind and matter with the complete inter-relationship of all things. The notable names connected with the development of this subject are Abrams, Drown, De la Warr, Hieronymus, Rae and others. Although it has other important users, radionics it is primarily used as both a method and a device with the diagnosis and healing of plants, animals and humans. One of its most striking features is that it seems to function effectively over separation distances between operator and patient of thousands of miles, using only a spot of the patient's blood or other suitable witness as the link between the two.

The technique has been used to heal the general spectrum of ailments in humans, from the common cold to serious illnesses of the various body glands; In animals from distemper to hoof and mouth disease; And implants from stimulating nutrient uptake from the soil to inhibiting pests from destroying a crop. The method has also been used for prospecting for oil, water or minerals (using only a good map of the area); For finding lost articles or people; For designing industrial equipment or selecting staff; In education for lowering a student's resistance to a subject, school or teacher; In research for probing theoretical and experimental directions and in the area of thoughtography.

During the past two or three years, I have devoted a portion of my time to the study of radionic to see if a rational explanation of device operation could be constructed in terms of a set of testable hypothesis. I did not limit myself to the known facts of present hashtag physics but allowed extrapolations of this modeling of nature. As might be expected, it was possible to conceive of a not too unreasonable model of device operation which affords a basis for serious experimentation. This model will be described in the present paper.* in addition, the relationship between the primary radionic wavefield ¹, the five axis wavefield ² and the acupuncture points of the human body ³ will be noted. Finally, another antenna system of the body connecting the endocrine glands will be discussed.

A Brain Circuit for Addiction Remission Identified June 13, 2022

Summary: Using lesion network mapping, researchers identified brain circuits associated with addiction remission. The findings provide a new target for the development of treatments for addiction. **Source:** Brigham and Women's Hospital

In the United States, substance use disorders are a leading cause of death among young people. Treatments such as deep brain stimulation hold promise for helping people overcome addiction, but many questions remain about what brain areas should be targeted.

Researchers are gaining new insights from patients who are no longer addicted to nicotine after experiencing a brain lesion, such as a stroke.

Using a new technique known as lesion network mapping, researchers at Brigham and Women's Hospital have mapped addiction remission to entire brain circuits rather than specific brain regions, pointing to new targets for treatment.

Their results are published in *Nature Medicine*.

"By looking beyond individual brain regions and, instead, at the brain circuit, we have found targets for addiction remission and are eager to rigorously test them through clinical trials," said Michael Fox, MD, PhD, of the Department of Neurology at the Brigham.

"Ultimately, our goal is to take larger steps towards improving existing therapies for addiction and open the door for remission."

Neuromodulation therapies, such as deep brain stimulation, transcranial magnetic stimulation, and MRI-guided focused ultrasound, allow clinicians at the Brigham's Center for Brain Circuit Therapeutics to directly target brain circuits and improve symptoms in ways that may not be possible through treatment with medication.

But knowing the location to target is critical. In a previous study, researchers used lesion network mapping to examine patients whose essential tremors resolved, confirming targets used in treatment with deep brain stimulation.

The study authors set out to apply the same approach to addiction remission. "Although we know a great deal about the neurobiological mechanisms in addiction, treatment options are still very limited.

"Our findings with essential tremor made us realize the potential of this approach to localize key brain circuits mediating symptom improvement," said Juho Joutsa, MD, PhD, of the Turku Brain and Mind Center and Clinical Neurosciences at the University of Turku.

Fox and colleagues used data from two independent cohorts of patients addicted to nicotine who then suffered a brain lesion, usually from a stroke.

Fox's team compared lesions in patients who were unable to quit smoking to lesions resulting in remission of smoking addiction. They then used a database known as the human connectome to map each lesion to the larger brain circuit. They found that the two smoking lesions datasets that led to remission of smoking addiction mapped to a specific brain circuit.

To their surprise, they also discovered in a third alcoholism lesion dataset that a reduced risk of alcoholism mapped to a similar brain circuit, suggesting a potentially therapeutic, targetable neural pathway for addiction in general, rather than addiction to a specific substance.

"Although neuromodulation treatments using electricity or even brain lesions have shown promise in relieving substance addiction, the therapeutic target has been unclear," said Fox.

"Now that our study has identified a target — a specific human brain circuit — we hope to test whether targeted neuromodulation to this brain circuit provides sustainable symptom relief to our patients."

The authors acknowledge two primary study limitations. First, the results are solely based on retrospective analysis of existing datasets and, second, the datasets examined only covered specific substances of abuse.

The researchers, therefore, advocate for prospective validation of their findings through clinical trials testing and an examination of additional substances of addiction to determine if their findings can be applied widely. Treatments such as deep brain stimulation hold promise for helping people overcome addiction, but many questions remain about what brain areas should be targeted. Image is in the public domain

"We were excited to discover that our mapped lesions associated with addiction remission led back to a common brain circuit. While our findings point towards therapeutic targets for addiction, we need to test these targets in randomized clinical trials," said Fox.

"We study brain lesions in the context of the brain circuit because it provides a powerful way to understand the causal links between addiction and our neuroanatomy. We have hope that we can make significant strides towards helping patients with substance use disorders."

Scientists Tweaked Genes in a Way that Made Hamsters Very, Very Angry

In the universe of charismatic rodents, the hamster looms large. They're great pets for kids; as emotional-support animals, they're "adorable, portable, and convenient," according to the website ESA Doctors.

But, in what's perhaps another sign of our dawning dystopia, scientists have managed to use emerging genetic technology to make your friendly hamster into a hyper-aggressive tyrant. Using



CRISPR Cas9, a gene-editing technique, a group of University of Georgia researchers took a bunch of hamsters and eliminated a "neurochemical signaling pathway that plays a critical role" in affecting group behavior in mammals—DNA thought to shape "social phenomena ranging from pair bonding, cooperation, and social communication to dominance and aggression," according to the university's press release.

Shocking the Georgia team, the gene-edited hamsters emerged as bullies. Put a couple into a small cage, and it might turn into the equivalent of an MMA ring—a kind of portable *Fight Club* set.

The researchers figured what they did would make the fuzzy critters more passive, because they assumed the pathway, known as vasopressin, triggers conflict.

"We anticipated that if we eliminated vasopressin activity, we would reduce both aggression and social communication. But the opposite happened," the eminent neuroscientist <u>H. Elliott Albers</u>, one of the study's authors, said in the press release. In other words, they thought the modified hamsters would be more chill. Instead, they became more hostile. Oops!

Interestingly, male hamsters are prone to showing aggression to other males, but females don't have that trait. Nixing the vasopressin pathway not only dramatically ramped up same-sex aggression among males, but it made females just as mean to each other as their male counterparts, a finding Albers called "startling."

In addition to generating <u>funny headlines</u> about turning tiny cuddly pets into "rage monsters," the Georgia study gets at an important point. Hailed for its <u>precision</u>, CRISPR Cas9 is an incredibly potent tool, and the Georgia study counts as an impressive display of its power.

"Developing gene-edited hamsters was not easy," Albers said in the press release; and could not have been done without CRISPR. But it also demonstrates the limits of our knowledge of how tinkering with genes affects traits in the real world. "We don't understand this system as well as we thought we did," Albers said. "The counterintuitive findings tell us we need to start thinking about the actions of these receptors across entire circuits of the brain and not just in specific brain regions."

Let's hope scientists keep their CRISPR experiments confined to the lab until we know much more about the relationship between DNA and traits. Because what the world needs now is not more rage monsters.

Effects of Psychotronics Treatments on Agricultural Soils

Introduction

From 2020 to the present, the authors have been engaged in developing and refining psychotronic² methods for advancing crop production in the Arkansas Delta. The long-term objective was, and remains, the development of a viable commercial enterprise. During 2021, in the process of testing various techniques, we documented positive physical changes in the field soils of several farms. Our methodologies centered primarily on psychotronic *broadcasting*, ³ and it is these results that we record and discuss here.

Historical Perspective

From the late 1940s into the early 1970s, a commercial venture called U.K.A.C.O, provided psychotronics services to farmers in several states, with a particular focus on pest management. According to popular sources, U.K.A.C.O. was quite successful. While letters of attestation from the Farm Bureau and others are available, there appears to be little detailed documentation of those successes and scant records of the methodologies used; certainly nothing that includes hard physical data. Subsequent to this, many have applied psychotronics to agriculture with further claims of success; these, however, remain largely anecdotal. When scant documentation is added to its controversial nature, there is little to encourage serious investigation of agricultural psychotronics by the conventional scientific and agricultural communities.

Still, the lack of hard data does not discourage many committed farmers and practitioners, however. To paraphrase one of them, "We've been doing this a long time and we have confidence in what we're doing." That said, conventional documentation of psychotronics applications would support and encourage farmers and others in the practicing community to investigate, develop, and expand their application of this intriguing method.

Methodology

Site Selection

Beginning in the summer of 2020, permission was obtained from several growers in the Eastern Arkansas Delta to test psychotronic broadcasting on fields growing irrigated rice, soybeans, and corn. We identified five good field sites, which are described in Table 1.



For valid comparisons, we divided each field to provide side-by-side treated and non-treated (control) zones. Figure 1 features a rough map of how this was done on one of the test fields. The Figure also shows the approximate locations where we conducted the observations and tests at the end of the season. Every field was divided and tested in this same manner. In no instances were farming practices, fertilization, or pest management varied between the treated and non-treated field areas.

Psychotronics Protocols

Typical psychotronics procedures employ *witnesses*—specimens of the site(s) to be treated. Witnesses serve as the links between the treated ground, and the psychotronics device and its operator. These allow psychotronics evaluations and treatments to occur in real-time. It is one

of the more abstruse aspects of psychotronics, yet it is fundamental to its practice. We obtained site witnesses using combinations of ground-level photography, aerial drone photography, Google Earth images, and physical soil specimens.

Before each broadcast, an analysis or evaluation of each field was done. These psychotronics evaluations employed basic radionics⁵ instruments and protocols; they also required an experienced device operator—a role filled by one of the authors (Kuepper). We used these evaluations to select materials that would serve as psychotronics treatments or remedies, as well as to monitor their efficacy. As part of these evaluations, we tested numerous reagent⁶ samples of fertilizers, amendments, botanicals, and homoeopathic-like substances, (e.g. Biodynamic Preparations⁷) to determine whether their *energetic essences* might enhance the vitality of the specific soils and crops in the trials. We considered a wide range of reagents for each field and for each broadcast.⁸ All fields received multiple broadcasts over the duration of the trial. Each broadcast was an individual event in that the reagents employed were reselected and changed based upon updated psychotronics analyses. The frequency and duration of each broadcast also varied as a result of these analyses. In one field example, during the seven months from February through September, seven separate remote broadcasts were made, with each broadcast lasting from three to five days. The circumstances on the remaining fields were similar.

We performed two types of psychotronics broadcasts:

- a) traditional remote broadcasts⁹ in which the instrumentation is located at a distance from the targeted field (in our cases, from 200 to 300 miles) and,
- b) on-site broadcasts using devices known variously as field broadcasters or cosmic pipes. These are tower-like instruments installed at the field site. They are typically constructed of PVC pipe with ports or *wells* to accommodate witnesses and reagents.

Four different radionics devices¹⁰ were used for evaluation and related non-broadcasting procedures. These originated from three different manufacturers. Four different psychotronics devices were used solely for remote broadcasting; these were produced by three different manufacturers. We also used two different field broadcaster units, each made by a different company.

Field Observation & Testing

We performed physical field tests in mid-to-late October, 2021, as detailed in Table 1. Within-field testing locations were chosen for each treated and non-treated portion of a field to minimize the distance across the interface, as shown in Figure 1.

We used two testing procedures, the first being a water infiltration test recommended by the USDA's Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) and described in detail on p. 7-8 of the Soil Quality Institute's *Soil Quality Test Kit Guide* (July 2001).¹¹

The second procedure entailed use of the microBIOMETER®--a commercial device. ¹² MicroBIOMETER provides is a fast means for evaluating soil quality primarily by measuring biological factors. Data are generated for carbon, and the balance between soil fungi and bacteria.

Results

Water infiltration refers to the time required for a given quantity of water to seep completely into the soil. Rapid infiltration is highly desirable; it suggests a deep, unobstructed root zone, better ability to store water, healthy gas exchange, and reduced rain runoff and erosion.

The water infiltration values obtained for all field sites are displayed in Table 2. The data show clear trends toward better infiltration on field zones treated psychotronically. Because these trends were consistent, we sought the assistance of Dr. Jacob Manlove, Assistant Professor of Agricultural Economics at Arkansas State University in Jonesboro, Arkansas, to undertake a statistical analysis to determine the significance of our findings. Dr. Manlove applied a two-tailed T-test evaluation. His results are included toward the bottom of the table.

Dr. Manlove's analysis justifies high confidence in our conclusion that psychotronics broadcasting *can* effect changes in field soil that facilitate water infiltration—a recognized agronomic benefit for growing crops and improving the environment.

Another recognized benefit for soil and crop health is the increase in soil organic matter—of which carbon is the major component. Indeed, higher levels of organic content play roles in structuring soils for better water infiltration and aeration. Furthermore, soils with more organic matter hold larger quantities of water for subsequent plant needs, while reducing runoff and erosion. In addition, organic matter is a reserve of plant nutrients; it also has a high cation exchange value (C.E.C.), which holds soluble nutrients against leaching.

Table 3 displays the measurements of soil carbon content as captured by the microBIOMETER®. As with water infiltration, there are clear trends suggesting that psychotronics broadcasting increased soil carbon levels. Dr. Manlove again assisted with statistical analysis to determine the possible significance of our findings. Once more, he applied the 2-tailed T-test. His results are included toward the bottom of Table 3.

As with water infiltration, we are justified in our confidence that soil carbon levels were positively influenced by psychotronics broadcasting. At only one site, HUNO, were the findings deemed non-significant (NS); at another, HDOS, they were found to be marginally significant.

Additional data were captured using the microBIOMETER®. They included relative fungal and bacteria populations. These data are displayed in Tables 4 and 5, respectively. As we saw no obvious trends, statistical analyses were not applied.

We made no concerted effort to measure crop yields on these fields. However, monitors on the combine harvesters indicated no increases in yield on the treated portions of HUNO and HDOS.

Discussion

Agronomic Findings

The two parameters—water infiltration and soil carbon—are interrelated. Higher soil carbon levels improve soil structure, leading to better infiltration. However, soil structure can be quickly degraded in the short term through ill-timed tillage if fields are plowed or cultivated when too wet or too dry. Such damage can be clearly seen and measured in the short term. By contrast, soil carbon levels change much more slowly, especially when efforts to increase them exclude the physical application of external inputs like compost or biochar. As this is the case with psychotronics treatments, the increased carbon levels we documented are all that much more remarkable.

Though our overall efforts to recover production data were late and inadequate, we were disappointed that higher yields were not observed on HUNO and HDOS. Agronomic improvements in soil carbon and porosity *should*, naturally, lead to higher production.

A plausible explanation may rest with the chemical-intensive nature of agriculture being practiced on these farms and fields. In the mid-to-late 1970s, one of the co-authors (Kuepper) was part of a project funded by the National Science Foundation and conducted by Washington University, in St. Louis, to study energy use in cornbelt agriculture. It resulted in the first large-scale study comparing organic and conventional farms in the United States.

The study found higher humus levels, lower erosion, greater biodiversity and comparable soil levels of phosphorus and potassium on organic crop soils, but substantially higher corn yields on conventionally-managed farms, even when the same hybrid varieties were grown. It became abundantly clear that synthetic chemistry, in the form of commercial fertilizers and pesticides, over-rode the relative benefits of organically-managed soil. Conventional chemical-intensive growing, however, comes at a cost. Not only are these inputs expensive, they require large amounts of fossil fuel energy to produce. This is especially true of synthetic nitrogen fertilizer. In addition, chemical-intensive farming sacrifices agronomic and agro-ecological resilience, i.e., conventional yields would fall rapidly in the absence of agrochemical inputs. And furthermore, their use contributes to environmental problems such as aquatic dead zones, loss of biodiversity, poor air quality, and declining water quality.

The upshot then, is that the use of large amounts of conventional chemical inputs is likely to obscure the longer-term benefits to the soil from psychotronics treatments much as they did in the Washington University studies where the beneficial results of much-less exotic practices can appear to be much less productive. The most-likely benefits that conventional growers could obtain from psychotronics treatments might come from reductions in costly annual inputs. This is something that requires more research to determine—research that may need to be done by growers, themselves, presenting a possible barrier to rapid adoption of psychotronics among conventional growers.

Evaluating Psychotronics

Psychotronics is a means for understanding and interacting with matter at its deeper energetic levels using the mind (*psycho*) aided by devices (*tronics*). It offers a strategy and tool for altering natural events, processes, and substances through focused intent, facilitated by the use of instrumentation. There is a tendency to consider psychotronics treatments primarily in terms of the device(s) used. Some might argue that we'd have done better in these trials had we used better-designed or more powerful instruments. That might well be true, though we doubt it.

We are inclined to think that the narrowed focus on devices is too simplistic and wanting. It certainly skews one's understanding of psychotronics. To better explain, we will deconstruct the psychotronic process and clarify our perspective on the total process being tested in this set of trials.

Others may see it differently, but from our perspective, we see three overlapping aspects to psychotronics: instrumentation, protocols, and the device operator.

- 1. The first of these, of course, is the instrumentation employed—the 'tronics' in 'psychotronics'. Practitioners of agricultural psychotronics do take their device selection seriously. Because farmers are often dealing with large acreages, they are rightly concerned that their equipment has the 'power' needed. As noted previously, we used four different radionics devices solely for analytical purposes; all had broadcasting capability but we did not use them in this manner. We chose to keep these instruments free for analytical and other non-broadcasting purposes. Instead, we selected four additional devices that were designed solely or primarily for broadcasting. These instruments were manufactured by three different companies. We also employed two designs of field broadcasters, obtained from another two sources.
- 2. Closely linked to the devices are the various protocols employed. Protocols are important to the optimum use of the instrument and to the establishment of clear and firm intent by the operator—the 'psycho' of 'psychotronics'. These protocols include but are not limited to:
 - The witnesses that are used and how they are obtained, handled, and employed;
 - The reagent materials selected and evaluated;
 - The reliance on physical reagent specimens or the substitution of radionics rates¹⁴.
- 3. The final key to psychotronics is the skill and intentionality of the device operator. At this point in time, psychotronics is operator-dependent. A human is essential to the workings of the instrument, the process, and the outcome. This means that the breadth and depth of the operator's knowledge of agricultural systems, agro-ecology, and technology will strongly influence the quality of analysis and the range of reagent materials chosen for broadcasting. The operator's personal philosophies about food

and the environment will do so as well. (While there have been numerous efforts to develop psychotronics instruments that function free of human input, it remains something of a holy grail.¹⁵)

All three elements are integral to radionics and psychotronic work. Therefore, all three must be considered when evaluating the success or failure of these endeavors.

There are multiple challenges to documenting and verifying the effects of psychotronics. It does not easily lend itself to conventional scientific measurements. Radionics pioneer George de la Warr noted this during his efforts to validate his and his wife Marjorie's work in the middle of the last century. ¹⁶ Unfortunately, this will likely be the case for some time to come.

⁹ Remote broadcasting is facilitated though the use of the witness linkage. "Treatment at a distance" is another abstruse yet fundamental characteristic of psychotronics.

To paraphrase one critic: When you consider the intellectual and financial support for conventional farming, including Cooperative Extension, and USDA and Land-Grant research, it was comparable to a professional football team playing a series of games with a junior-varsity high school team, and splitting the wins and losses.

¹⁴ Rates are numbered codes used in radionics. Their uses are various. In this specific instance, rates are developed that equate to reagent substances. For example, a radionics rate developed for synthetic urea, allow the operator to substitute that code for a physical specimen of urea in either analysis or broadcasting.
