

#### 1980 Dayton Conference

#### Iridotronic Conference

The International Association for Psychotronic Research (and Division for Iridotronic Research) announced the First International Conference on Iridotronic Research for Sept 29 —

October 2, 1980, at Fibichova Street 19, 736 01 Havirov, Czechoslovakia.

Generally referred to as iridology in the United States, iridotronics is a diagnostic modality based upon the examination of the iris.

Sponsors are listed as Dr. Zdenek Rejdak, President of IAPR; Prof. M.D. Romashov, F.N., President of the preparatory committee, and Ervin Wojnar, leader of the division of iridotronic research.

### FDA Requests Cooperation of USPA President

The Indianapolis, Indiana, office of the Federal Drug Administration, an arm of HEW which has in the past classed radionics as fraudulent, has approached J. G. Gallimore, President of USPA with a request for collaboration. The unofficial support of radionic treatment however, represents a psychological approach to a difficult case rather than the reversal of established FDA policy.

#### **Pervier Design Wins Logo Contest**

The USPA logo contest winner is Curt Pervier of Midland, Texas. The new logo now decorates the masthead of the newsletter as well as other USPA literature and documents.

The logo is a stylized representation of the hyperfield flux in a magnetic field surrounding the south pole of a magnet.

#### The Charles Whitehouse Case

Charles F. Whitehouse, D.C., member of the Board of USPA under attack by the Virginia State Board of Medicine (see page 7) on September 11th has been deprived of his license to practice. Hearing officer Charles F. Poston, a Norfolk lawyer recommended that Whitehouse's license be revoked for "gross malpractice and fraud."

While deciding whether to appeal to the Norfolk Circuit Court Whitehouse plans to continue the work of the Etheronic Research Foundation under the umbrella of a church.

USPA Directors approved support for Whitehouse defense effort in the amount of \$500.00 during the 1980 Conference.

The Whitehouse case also gained the interest of the National Health Federation. Dr. Clinton Miller, President of the Federation, as a keynote speaker at the Dayton conference delivered a rousing defense of Whitehouse and new modalities of healing.

The case has attracted broad attention in alternative healing circles and in the Virginia press. A sampling of the three months from July to September discloses the following coverage: Metro the Magazine of Southeastern Virginia, July, Vol. 10 No. 7, 46 inches; Virginian-Pilot, August 16, 34 inches; Virginian-Pilot, August 21, 38 inches; The Beacon, August 21/22, 15 inches, The National Enquirer on September 2 carried a ten inch story on the Navy's use of Whitehouse and purchase of his equipment for tracking submarines; The Beacon, Sept 4/5, 18 inches, The Ledger-Star, Sept 11, 5 inches; The Virginian-Pilot, Sept. 12, 14 inches.

# A Selection of Abstracts of Papers Presented At Dayton

#### MIND AND MATTER INTERACTION

T. E. Bearden

Almost all human concepts, ideas, and logic have been based upon — and fitted to — the photon interaction, which differentiates spacetime (4-space), leaving a spatial (and partial) reality which we detect and observe. Classical (3-law) Aristotlean logic is simply the synthesis of detection/perception after the photon interaction is invoked. Using electrons, Young's two-slit experiment conclusively proves reality changes merely by whether or not the photon interaction is applied to the electron.

Since mind occupies time but is coupled to space only by the factor 1/c3, normally mind is spatially *virtual* and thus totally lost in any simple quantum detection process.

Since all objects have temperature and continually exchange photons with their surroundings and within their own makeup, the photon interaction is universal. Human concepts and logic, fitted to this interaction, thus contain a single fundamental shortcoming or "delusion" and most of reality becomes illogical at base.

The author demonstrates a fourth law of logic which, when added to Aristotle's three laws, enables a closed logical system. Using the fourth law of logic, a mind can be modeled as a physical universe, and a physical object can be modeled as superposed "mind cards," each containing that form, from all existing minds. Thus matter is totally mindstuff, while mindstuff is totally physical, and the di-

chotomy between mind and matter is removed. An infinite-dimensional universe results where the 'laboratory frame' 3-space is common to all physical mindworlds. Each mindworld is a separate physical universe three or more orthogonal turns away from the laboratory frame in hyperspace.

A thought experiment is used to show a mass can travel at the speed of light, becoming a photon in the process. Velocity is simply a measure of the rotation of an object into hyperspace away from its line of motion in laboratory 3-space, as shown by the direct examination of the Lorentz transform equations. The speed c of electromagnetic energy in vacuum simply represents the rotation of an object (such as an electron) one such orthogonal turn away, so that its projection into the laboratory frame has lost one dimension. An electron so turned has been changed to a two-dimensional transverse front or plane moving at the speed of light - in short, a photon.

The identity between higher dimensional spaces and nested sublevels of virtual state is shown for the first time. Kindling, a method of amplifying virtual state into observable state based on the Prigogine effect, is advanced as a new concept.

Consciousness is rigorously defined as a preferred coherence and tuning loop kindling channel between a physical mass tuner and the intersected virtual state projections from one mind world, and vice versa. This allows rigorous definition and modeling of a living biosystem and definitions of both ''life'' and ''death.'' Several specific unexplained phenomena types are presented which can be explained by this new approach to mind and matter and their interaction.

The operation of the neurophone (which puts thoughts into the mind), the Priore device (which cures cancer and leukemia), and the Moray amplifier (which taps zero-point energy of

vacuum) are explained as are the mind control and death induction potentials of the Soviet "woodpecker" signals.

The nature of the collective human unconscious is presented, and how minds and being can be integrated into yet higher-dimensional living entities is shown. The linkage of the entire human species into a multidimensional, unlimited being beyond ordinary space and time is postulated as the final step in human evolution.

#### "QUARKS, OCCULT CHEMISTRY AND THE STRING MODEL"

Just before the turn of the century, two Theosophical Society members, Leadbeater & Besanit clairvoyantly viewed while in the state of 'Samadhi' the simplest of known physical elements, hydrogen, consisting of a single proton in the nucleus and one electron orbiting.

They 'saw' an egg shaped, translucent, rotating, wobbling spheroid. Within the spheroid were little bright lights, a total of six, in two groups of three. Each group of three lights always remained in a spatial relationship with each other in the shape of a triangle. The eggshaped container pushed back space so it was more of a partial vacuum inside the spheroid.

Upon further magnifying the little bright lights, they were seen to be spheres which again contained three more 'little lights.' As these were magnified they appeared as a heart shaped spheroid with ten bands of energy making 2½ turns on the outside surface and returning up from the bottom sharp point, through the center in 2½ turns to the top depression of the heart shaped ovoid.

Two scientists, H. Phillips of England & R. Beutlich, USA, in 1978 wrote articles in the journals of Theosophy/

Science published in England and India respectively. They saw the similarity of the modern quantum physics model of quarks which make up all the fundamental heavy particles in the atomic nucleus and the shapes which Leadbeater & Besant described and published in the book "Occult Chemistry" published by the Theosophical Society.

Mr. Phillips is a physicist and has further proposed a coupling between the light and heavy particles in Physics Review, which accounts for all their properties (not now being done by current classical physics). Also he noted that the energy streams that were clair-voyantly observed holding these little lights together was identical to the theory used for superconductors. He then postulated a system to account for the existing etheric and magnetic charges of the configurations of the various types of quarks that make up the heavy nuclear material.

This is a most exciting confirmation of a psychic ability being used for scientific observation and these findings will in time revolutionize the quantum theories. Hopefully, also, awaken the world of science to the reality of what psychics "see."

### THE STATE OF VIRGINIA VS. CHARLES F. WHITEHOUSE, D.C.

As a result of pre-hearing investigations conducted by the Attorney General's office, at the request of the Virginia State Board of Medicine, an injunction has been issued requiring Dr. Charles F. Whitehouse, D.C. on Dec. 12, 1979, to cease and desist from all activities regarding research using color therapy, radionics, the transference of mind energies and any parapsychological methods.

Charges of fraud and unconscionable conduct and practicing outside the scope of chiropractic are the main issues.

In addition to pre-hearing activities, an account is given of the hearings from Feb. 27, 1980 to the 24th of July 1980 including a discussion of briefs by the attorney general for the State Board of Medicine and a brief by respondent's attorney.

Medical and behavioral sciences have concluded that there are specific personality types or 'Biotypes' that can be identified as having a unique predisposition for specific diseases. This awareness suggests that more emphasis can be psychotronically directed toward the identification and alleviation of the identifiable disease predisposers.

### PSYCHOTRONIC RESEARCH AND INSTRUMENT DESIGN

Kathleen Joyce

This paper discusses some intriguing areas for psychotronic research and some ideas for specialized psychotronic instruments with which to research these areas. It deals with the time properties of the psychotronic instrument and its use as a predictive instrument. It describes a psychotronic instrument device which would allow for an infinite number of rates. The question as to whether psychotronic rates are relative or absolute is also considered. The possible use of

radionic instrumentation for quality control, chess playing, archeology, astronomy, high-energy particle physics and the administration of justice is also considered. It is suggested that rather than trying to first get psychotronics adopted in the health field, that we demonstrate its indispensibility to other areas of research. Then, like the computer, it will be universally acknowledged as a very valuable tool, and the health industry will also want to avail itself of its benefits.

#### THE MATHEMATICS OF CONE DESIGN

The paper presents a set of formulas for designing and constructing cones. A wide range of technical information is provided by the formulas. This range of data includes such areas as the physical characteristics of a cone, the quantities of materials needed to construct a cone, various measurements used in construction of

a cone and data needed to use cones in pyramid power experiments. The formulas were developed from data published by G. Patrick Flanagan, Ph.D. (1).

#### **Perception Physics**

The foundation physics for biophysical existence as well as actual perception as a mind quantity are expressed in the new stress model. The 'mind' quality as well as quantity are for the first time directly expressible in mathematical models with a corres-

The expansion or contraction of "mind" is found to be directly proportional to the space/time stresses incurred by the bio-body.

This preliminary physics excursion into new areas predicts that future medical or metaphysical areas are both potentially able to utilize space/time stresses as tools—perhaps the ultimate controlling tools.



# THE MAGNETIC PACER – A COUNTERMEASURE FOR EXTREMELY LOW FREQUENCY MAGNETIC RADIATION

The environment of the planet has become increasingly filled with manmade electromagnetic waves in the last decades. Most of the signals and power levels of the waves serve useful and vitally beneficial purposes for mankind and other living systems. Unfortunately, there also has been an increase in the power levels and numbers of signals which produce significant interference to the lawful communications and navigational systems and the electronic products upon which our civilization has become so dependent. Many of the electronic products. such as computers and medical instrumentation systems, are extremely sensitive devices; yet, compared to the delicate complex electrical and chemical signals in human and animal brain and cardiac systems, these electronic products are relatively unresponsive. Electronic components of the central nervous system govern many behavioristic patterns in living systems.

### THE ELF POLLUTION'S BIOLOGICAL EFFECT


The combination of high intensity ELF (Extreme Low Frequency) magnetic signals from both the U.S. and the U.S.S.R. may be significant enough to produce effects on humans as well as other living systems. Such effects, when they exist, would not normally be perceived by the individuals affected because the electrical activity of the central nervous system would be altered. Since human perception is a direct result of the chemical and electrical activity of the brain, one would

not normally be able to determine whether perception has been altered. Special biological instrumentation systems can detect alterations of biological electrical activities, however, and thus provide a means by which one may monitor alterations in behavior patterns not otherwise observable. A simultaneous comparison of biological signals with external magnetic and electric signals in the environment has shown that human electroencephalograms will occasionally lock onto some of these external signals, or otherwise show external modifications. Robert Beck with Andrija Puharich noted such correlations in the ELF range in 1977. I found similar patterns in a research study with micro wave frequencies in 1975 and verified the finding in the ELF range in 1978-1979.

Considerations of the implications of this information led to the development of the magnetic pacer which is currently under test. Some earlier scientific studies have been conducted, notably by **H.W. Ludwig** of the Federal Republic of Germany, into the feasibility of developing devices pulsed within the ELF range which reportedly were beneficial for some people (especially that country's diplomatic community), and sold under the trade name, "Vitasette".

The purpose of the pacer unit is to reintroduce a natural field into a localized area of about 1 meter radius. A 7.8 Hz frequency lies near the base of the range of natural frequencies known as the Schuman earth-ionosphere resonances. This 7.8 Hz frequency has appeared to be able to pace the human

heartbeat and affect the brain wave patterns of some people; it may be useful for inducing relaxed or sleep states. The higher frequencies may be useful in enhancing alert states in some persons. A pulsed south polar field has been seen to more easily affect males while a north polar field has been seen to more easily affect females. Placing a pacer next to the left chest, pulsing at 7.8 Hz, has shown that the heart will rhythmically respond in some persons when at rest, sitting quietly.


Studies have shown that specific low level electric and magnetic fields and frequencies have profound effects on almost all biological systems on this planet. Therefore, it seems reasonable to assume that alterations of natural fields may produce alterations in biological system response; thus a method of reintroducing approximate natural field conditions may be able to produce what was once natural biological system response.

It should be clearly understood that this magnetic pacer is an experimental unit and that no claims whatsoever are made regarding specific effects which may, or may not, occur to individual experimenters. The small group of persons who volunteered to participate, out of curiosity, as test subjects, is too small a sample of the population to know with any certainty what the specific effects of such a device may turn out to be on the overall human population.



- 1. To promote the free exchange, discussion and dissemination of information, theories, ideas and practices related to psychotronics.

#### NEW AND RECENT BOOKS ON PSYCHOTRONICS and Related Subjects

THE CYCLES OF HEAVEN, COSMIC FORCES AND WHAT THEY ARE DOING TO YOU, by Guy L. Playfair and Scott Hill, 1978. Avon Books, The Hearst Corporation, NY, paperback. 364 pp., \$2.75

''The Cycles of Heaven'' is an attempt to present a coherent picture of man in his cosmic environment; to understand the interactions of man and nature, including those of which he is not consciously aware. For some form of invisible force affects everything on. above and under the Earth, whether living or dead.

The Cycles of Heaven is a collaboration between a research scientist (Playfair) trained in biophysics, an interdisciplinary science, and a writer (Hill) interested in the unexplained border areas of human activity. They are repeating an old question posed by T. S. Eliot, "Where is the knowledge we have lost in information?" referring to the vast amount of scientific data that has accumulated in the Space Age. This knowledge of our environment is increasing daily, but what does it tell us of "inner space" which is as exciting as outer space and of more immediate importance?

In the beginning the reader is compelled to look at the Earth as a planet in its cosmic environment centered on its local star, the Sun. Other planets are explored in terms of their relationships, via astronomy and astrology. The two principle invisible forces. gravity and electromagnetism, are introduced as background to man's interactions with nature. Earthquakes are shown as examples of natural and strange forces in their most extreme and destructive actions (with great visible effects). All of this leads up to the important subject of cycles - in nature, in human affairs and in the natural rhythms of the human body and the way these cycles interact. To alert, rather than alarm the public, the authors show that the invisible forces in

nature can and do influence man's thoughts and actions. They describe means whereby he can fight back and reassert control over himself and part of his environment. From this the reader is led to venture beyond the frontiers of established science to the fascinating new concepts of man's "energy body" and its radiations. The critical climax is man's energy body interacting with its energetic surroundings for his good or his harm.

All arguments used in the discussions are rigorously based on international scientific data. But from this data come many perplexing questions.

The material varies from highly technical to a narrative essay, making it a bit difficult to follow. The vast number of references given became at times confusing. There is almost too much information used to prove an argument. But if one only wanted to pick and choose, there is still much to be garnered from this treatise on Cycles.

The authors more than achieved their purpose of showing how man interacts with his environment, whether inside his skin or out in the cosmos. They gave fresh insights into man's responsibilities for cooperation and consideration of nature and its varied operations.

For the uninitiated this book may be rough going. One has to understand the scientific data and logic before applying the discoveries.

For the metaphysician it is indeed appropriate and should prove both provocative and stimulating. Reading the chapters on "Homo Electromagneticus," "Bio-Entrainment," Feedback/Self-Entrainment," Electro-Magnetic Web," and "The Energy Body" (which is not new to occultists), will bring the uninformed up to date in short order, while with the same effort, it affords some hearty "food for thought."
