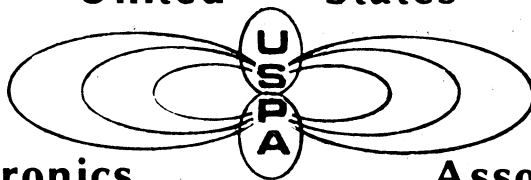

First Local USPA Chapter Organizes

The first local USPA chapter of 12 members was formed March 5th, 1981, on the initiative of USPA's secretary, Robert Beutlich. The chapter's name, "Wild Onion" is indian, and is pronounced "Chicago." Meetings have been held twice a month and rapidly over-flowed the limits of the private home, with 25-30 in attendance. The chapter is now scheduled to meet in the Parish House of St. Paul's Church By The Lake, 7100 N. Ashland, 1st & 3rd Weds. at 7:30 PM. Psychotronics IN THE NEWS

Ira Einhorn Bail Forfeited

Ira Einhorn of Philadelphia, known to many researchers in psychotronics as an active contributor to the field, has been reported missing by police.

Einhorn had been under arrest for the alleged murder of his close friend and was free on bail. The authorities are said to be considering the sale of the Einhorn parental home to satisfy bail.

Latest reports from knowledgeable sources include the significant information that a classified FBI report lists Einhorn as the victim of a conspiracy.

Golka Lab Vandalized In Utah.

The workshop of **Golka**, for years based in a deactivated Air Force hangar at Wendover, Utah, has been broken into and seriously damaged. Golka's research in high voltage energy production and manipulation included the use of a large tower outside the hangar. This has been partially destroyed, an eye witness stating that insulators and sections of the tower are lying scattered around its base.

The scientist's work has attracted national media attention due to its dramatic nature. Wendover community leaders has regarded the publicity as advantageous for the remote community. However, their attitude underwent reversal during the past year and Golka's rental rate was raised by 1000 percent.

Golka's refusal to leave is based upon the inevitability that any such massive move would cause termination or long term interruption in research, as well as unbearable financial difficulties.

The difficulties now developing threaten to completely terminate Golka's further research.

NBC TV of New York, through producer Tony Van Whitson, devoted serious coverage on its *News Magazine* program Friday March 13th to Pacific Northwest Center's director, William Bise and his research. Having taped two hours of material, the network aired 18 minutes on the David Brinkley hosted show.

The Charles Whitehouse Case

Virginia Beach, VA — USPA's Dr. Charles F. Whitehouse has won a temporary relief of the september '80 revocation of his license to practice medicine.

Entering an appeal against the state board of medicine ruling, Whitehouse pointed out that loss of the right to practice has brought him near bankruptcy. The judge ruled that Whitehouse could practice traditional chiropractic techniques. He is still denied the right to employ radionics or light treatment. Local Virginia newspaper gave the matter 50 column inches of coverage.

The Bise Magnetic Pacer

In following up the report on the Elf Magnetic Pacer by William Bise in the Summer, 1980 (vol.2, no.2) newsletter, the Pacific Northwest Center for the Study of Non-Ionizing Radiation has announced that the first magnetic pacer prototype has been produced.

Despite organizational and financial difficulties encountered by the Pacific Northwest Center, production plans are approaching realization. A member of the Bise organization reports that orders are being received and that, with the exception of MU metal processing preparations for manufacturing are now complete. 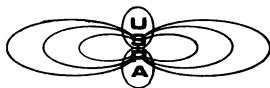

Natural and Artificial Pulsed Electronic Waves and Life Function

Psychotronics, or the interaction of the psyche with electronic waves, and the generation and interaction of these waves by such psychic media as the brain cells of living organisms and electronic products is a subject which Soviet researchers have taken very seriously for a number of years. The subject has only recently been considered even touchable by American researchers, and for the most part, those who have scientifically examined the phenomena have been ignored by the large majority of establishment science. Unfortunately, this state of affairs has allowed the Soviet researchers to gain a large lead in this area. Nonetheless there are some independent American scientists who have made significant inroads and breakthroughs in this important field. Drs. Andrija Puharich, Hal Puthoff and Elizabeth Rauscher immediately come to mind. Puharich worked in his important pioneering efforts with such psychics as Eileen Garrett, Peter Hurkos, Harry Stone, and the Israeli, Uri Geller. Dr.

Puharich published in 1962 *one of the most significant scientific works in the field...BEYOND TELEPATHY*. Hal Puthoff's work at Stanford with remote viewing is outstanding, and Elizabeth Rauscher's theoretical mathematics on multidimensional models concerning psychic functioning is phenomenal. There are also other pioneers whose works are brilliant and have a direct bearing and contribute greatly to this cutting edge in science.

Implicit in the operation of psychotronics principles is generation of electronic waves and some sensing apparatus for the detection and interaction of the waves; whether the sensor be a life system or an electromechanical device only has bearing on the amount of objective data gleaned from the sensor system. In science, and particularly in electronics, "to measure is to know" is the accepted maxim from which one can begin to build a data base.

Everything in our environment vibrates, and vibration of whatever kind is able to either be measured or perceived by

sentient systems. Indeed, vibration is the very basis of what we call life and its support systems. Vibrational motion which is harmonious within and throughout various systems can be said to be beneficial to the systems, and conversely, inharmonious motions can have adverse effects on these systems. It has been the objective of this investigator to explore the types of vibrations which seem to be either beneficial or detrimental to our planetary ecology. For twenty years, exploration and measurement have been made of vibrations which fall into the category of electric and magnetic oscillations emanating from living and artificial systems, in an attempt to determine which are harmonious to life and spirit and which are not. These efforts have met with a limited success.

Initial experiments by this investigator, some twenty years ago, involved the search for psychokinetic interactions between living systems and measurement apparatus. After exhaustive trial and error, it was discovered that 99.9+% pure nickel anodes of critical diameter, when submerged in cells of pure distilled water "doped" with many of the common alkali halides and subjected to microampere direct currents, showed sensitivity to mental activity and sudden mood and metabolism changes in humans up to several kilometers distance from the cells.

Later experiments showed similar sensitivities to the sudden mood and metabolism changes by differentially coupled thermistors in a special D.C. Wheatstone bridge configuration. This psychokinetic effect is demonstrable and the experiments are replicable in an imprecise manner. Over the years of experimentation it became more clear that the reactions were being influenced by other factors in the environment such as acoustic and electromagnetic waves, thus preventing a precise replication of a given experiment. Various shielding materials were used in efforts to exclude these other influences. It was found that shielding of the higher frequency radio and microwaves from a given psychokinetic sensor system yielded more consistent and repeatable results. Infra sound (below 20 Hertz) and ELF magnetic waves (below 300 Hertz) are very troublesome and almost not possible to exclude from a test environment, and these waves seem to have the more significant influences on the consistency of the experimental result. Until shielding these factors is accomplished, this phenomenon, like so many others in psychic research, will remain an interesting curiosity. This researcher has been making measurements of the extant vibrations and waves in the environment and testing various methods of shielding and, in the process, has dis-

covered many complex and interesting waveforms and intensities both natural and artificial.

Herein is a brief background on biologic sensitivity to some electronic waves and a description of magnetic and electromagnetic waves measured in the Pacific Northwest. Included also is a description of geologically induced waves, waves seen to be associated with area UFO sightings, and similar waves seen when the spaceship Columbia emerged from her blackout period following her landing on April 14, 1981. A discussion of Nicola Tesla's magnifying transmitter is presented as a probable explanation for some of the "lightning signature" waves measured.

The William Bise paper will continue in the next issue with a backgrounder on biological effects.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

The following letter was received by the International Association for Psychotronic Research and Appeared in the I.A.P.R. Newsletter #10 of April 1, 1981.

I enter into this correspondence with you with certain preconceptions in mind as to the exact nature of your organization. Since I have no direct familiarity with the studies that you are at present engaged in, I can only surmise from the fact that you are indeed conversant with parapsysics, you could be said to be tuned into what has variously been termed the ether, Urfeld, odic force, radiant energy, biomagnetism, etc., etc., and that we have much in common. I can at least entertain the hope that you will not dismiss or take lightly what I have to say.

I have dedicated the past decade of my life to the pursuit of scientific truth as I see it. This pursuit has led me, just as it must lead any individual who looks anew at the world without the prejudices of our mechanistic-oriented civilization, onto a path which opens a vast, largely untapped territory ready and waiting for exploration and development. The vistas here are grand and the potentials for a better future are immense.

Many of the most profound, intellectually honest human beings ever to walk on our imperiled planet have already made significant inroads into this terrain. I will enumerate only a few. They are: Tesla, Mesmer, T.H. Moray, von Reichenbach and Reich. Unfortunately, to the detriment of the further evolution of mankind, their incisive reconnaissance of the new realms have been ignored and they themselves, in many cases, slandered, persecuted and relegated to the status of charlatans.

Some two years ago I left my employment with a nationwide engineering firm in order to devote my full time to a natural research project. I left behind me a good salaried job, the

comforts of a secure home and the company of family and friends. I chose to embark on such a venture because I felt an obligation to make use of my capacity for genuine contact with and insight into what I choose to call the *primary energy continuum*.

Here I was, a single individual without the least financial backing from anyone or any organization, determined to carry out a natural-scientific research project with only a van, camping gear, a miniature "energizer" and some technical books. I travelled from metropolitan New York City to the Florida Keys. This abrupt change to a different geographical area was necessary because experimentation with and the unobstructed observation of the continuum was unthinkable in the polluted atmosphere of the Northeast.

It was my initial intention to spend some three or four months on the project but such a multitude of data and insights began to accumulate that my stay had to be extended to a full year. This was a difficult undertaking, since I had less than \$5,000 to draw on. Nevertheless, by adopting a very frugal lifestyle and with perseverance my goals were achieved.

With the hard-won knowledge in hand, I journeyed back to New Jersey where it took another half year to compile the information into a book-length manuscript. The typewritten text is over 220 pages long and is generously supplemented and enhanced by 70 illustrations and photographic plates — all original. The book contains the amassed observations which give irrefutable proof that the primary energy continuum is a tangible reality. I have entitled the book, "THE DAWN OF THE COSMIC AGE."

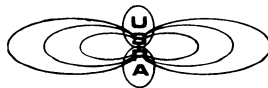
If the human species ever hope to see the actual emergence of an enlightened cosmic age, then there is no time left to waste. I personally have no time to spare to argue with the stubborn, entrenched and compromised adherents and proponents of "official

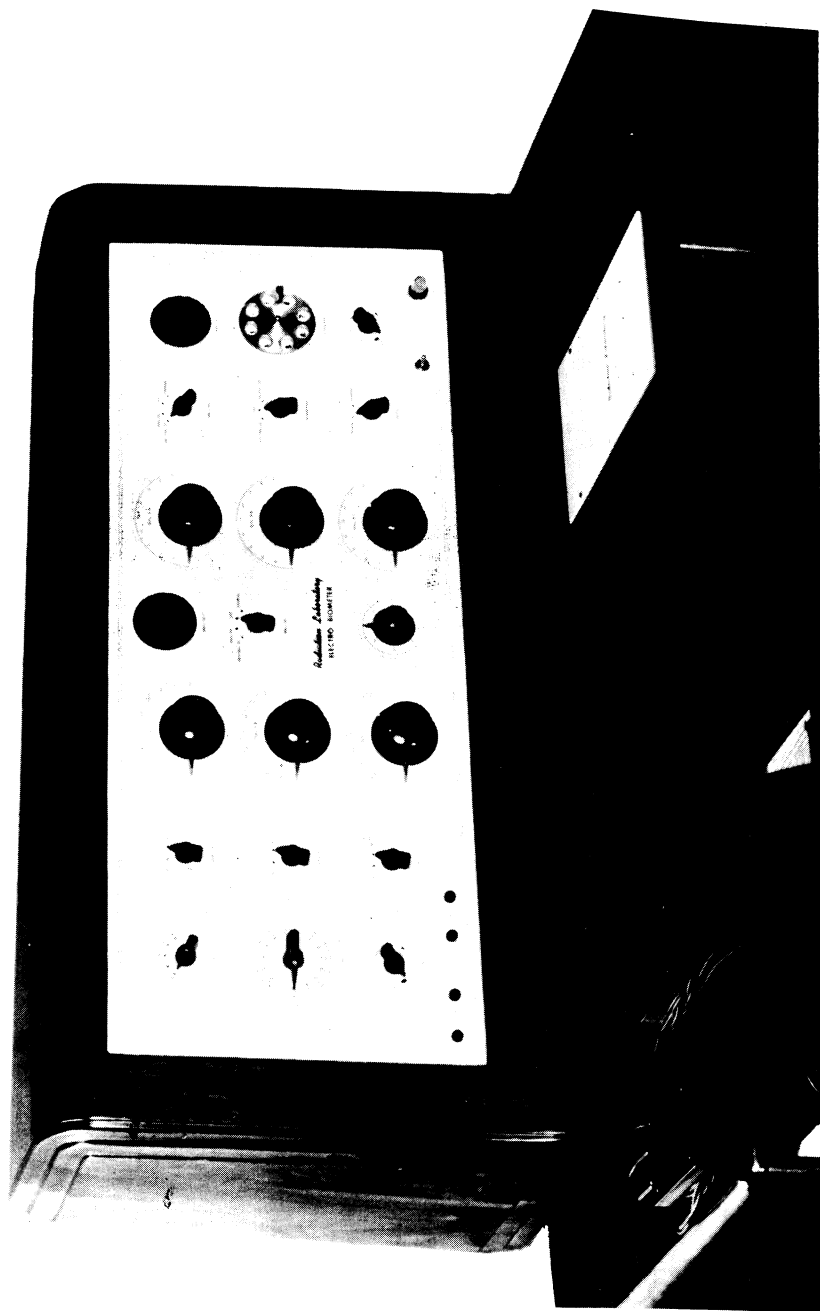
science." The primary = life energy continuum, whose observable, measurable physical properties and awesome potentials I have delineated on the shoulders of the great men previously referred to, has been forsaken by them in favor of "empty, curved space" and explosive nuclear = death energy.

Our contaminated environment and noxious atmosphere forecast an ominous future. Let us first plug up the holes in our floundering vessel before we resume the game.

NEW AND RECENT BOOKS

ELECTROMAGNETIC BIO-INFORMATION. Proceedings of the Symposium, Marburg, September 5, 1977, 1979, Urban and Schwarzenberg, Munchen-Wien-Baltimore, \$38.00.

This book may well be one of the three or four most important books ever published in the English language. In fact, it clearly lays out a future for theoretical biology, which at present is only in its infancy. Indeed, a simple extension to the work shown in this book -- along the lines of our own proposal for direct engineering of the virtual state -- allows the direct modeling of life, consciousness, biology, and physics in a single comprehensible model.

From the work reported in *Electromagnetic Bio-Information* and its extension to virtual state engineering, we are speaking of a quantum leap in all the life sciences across the board, an advance as profound as Newton's or Einstein's original work.

In conventional Western biology there is still little knowledge of the basic principles governing a cell as a whole, how the life of a cell is regulated, and precisely how cells communicate and exchange information with each other. The theoretical and experimental investigations necessary to answer these questions are only just beginning.

However, as this book almost startlingly shows, a small but determined group of Western researchers has made fundamental progress in the field, and already these developments have profound implications for humanity.

Specifically, biological systems can emit electromagnetic waves and also show sensitive responses -- to signals many orders of magnitude weaker than our normal instruments can detect -- throughout the entire spectral range, from the extremely

slow ELF fluctuations on the order of a few Hertz and below, up to the extremely short UV waves and even beyond. Indeed, the work reported in this book by the various researchers tends to confirm the possible validity of Lisitsyn's report that Soviet researchers have discovered the electromagnetic genetic coding of the human brain, have isolated the particular frequency bands required, and have successfully formulated a theory fitted to laboratory experiments. [S.K. Lisitsyn, "New Approach to the Analysis of Electroencephalograms," (Selected Articles), pp. 16-25, available through the Defense Documentation Center, ad 730045)]. Since Lisitsyn reports that material can be input directly into and extracted directly from the human brain and mind -- and whether or not conscious awareness is triggered can be predetermined and controlled -- the extreme importance of this area, both for the benefit and detriment of mankind, can readily be appreciated.

For every researcher interested in theoretical biology and the more subtle effects of electromagnetic radiation on biological systems, this book is absolutely essential.

Erich Von Daniken takes his readers once again on a tour of various archaeological sites around the world. On this occasion the reader is taken to the coasts of France, the island of Malta, ancient Israel and the mountains of Zimbabwe.

At each stop along the way, Von Daniken examines the local archaeological as well as mythological

mysteries. While doing so he interprets his subjects in the light of his well known ancient astronaut theory. This holds that the gods of legend and scripture were in fact space travelers from a distant star.

Von Daniken's theories further state that the gods from space trained our ancestors in the arts and sciences of civilization and then vanished into the stars again.

This book is recommended.

EXTRA-SENSORY PERCEPTION OF QUARKS Stephen Phillips. Quest Wheaton, Ill., 1980. 208pp. \$15.00.

While a graduate student in U.S.A., Phillips encountered the

theosophical book *The Physics of the Secret Doctrine* and was entranced by the diagrams and descriptions that purported to show 'atoms' and their substructures as seen by C.W. Leadbeater and Annie Besant. Upon further investigation, when back in England, the source book, "Occult Chemistry" by Leadbeater & Besant was used to begin his research. It rapidly became apparent to him that what Leadbeater & Besant had 'psychically viewed' (in a state of altered consciousness) were in fact quarks.
