#### First Local USPA Chapter Organizes

The first local USPA chapter of 12 members was formed March 5th, 1981, on the initiative of USPA's secretary, Robert Beutlich. The chapter's name, "Wild Onion" is indian, and is pronounced "Chicago." Meetings have been held twice a month and rapidly over-flowed the limits of the private home, with 25-30 in attendance. The chapter is now scheduled to meet in the Parish House of St. Paul's Church By The Lake, 7100 N. Ashland, 1st & 3rd Weds. at 7:30 PM. Subjects covered: The Seven Levels of Theosophy & Kabbalah; Demonstration of the Copen Machine; Catastrophe Theory; and A Basic Course in Pendulum & Dowsing. #### Ira Einhorn Bail Forfeited

**Ira Einhorn** of Philadelphia, known to many researchers in psychotronics as an active contributor to the field, has been reported missing by police.

Einhorn had been under arrest for the alleged murder of his close friend and was free on bail. The authorities are said to be considering the sale of the Einhorn parental home to satisfy bail.

Latest reports from knowledgeable sources include the significant information that a classified FBI report lists Einhorn as the victim of a conspiracy.

#### Golka Lab Vandalized In Utah.

The workshop of **Golka**, for years based in a deactivated Air Force hangar at Wendover, Utah, has been broken into and seriously damaged. Golka's research in high voltage energy production and manipulation included the use of a large tower outside the hangar. This has been partially destroyed, an eye witness stating that insulators and sections of the tower are lying scattered around its base.

The scientist's work has attracted national media attention due to its dramatic nature. Wendover community leaders has regarded the publicity as advantageous for the remote community. However, their attitude underwent reversal during the past year and Golka's rental rate was raised by 1000 percent.

Golka's refusal to leave is based upon the inevitability that any such massive move would cause termination or long term interruption in research, as well as unbearable financial difficulties.

The difficulties now developing threaten to completely terminate Golka's further research.

NBC TV of New York, through producer Tony Van Whitson, devoted serious coverage on its News Magazine program Friday March 13th to Pacific Northwest Center's director, William Bise and his research. Having taped two hours of material, the network aired 18 minutes on the David Brinkley hosted show.

#### The Charles Whitehouse Case

Virginia Beach, VA — USPA's Dr. Charles F. Whitehouse has won a temporary relief of the september '80 revocation of his license to practice medicine.

Entering an appeal against the state board of medicine ruling, Whitehouse pointed out that loss of the right to practice has brought him near bankruptcy. The judge ruled that Whitehouse could practice traditional chiropractic techniques. He is still denied the right to employ radionics or light treatment. Local Virginia newspaper gave the matter 50 column inches of coverage.

#### The Bise Magnetic Pacer

In following up the report on the Elf Magnetic Pacer by William Bise in the Summer, 1980 (vol.2, no.2) newsletter, the Pacific Northwest Center for the Study of Non-Ionizing Radiation has announced that the first magnetic pacer prototype has been produced.

Despite organizational and financial difficulties encountered by the Pacific Northwest Center, production plans are approaching realization. A member of the Bise organization reports that orders are being received and that, with the exception of MU metal processing preparations for manufacturing are now complete. Herein is a brief background on biologic sensitivity to some electronic waves and a description of magnetic and electromagnetic waves measured in the Pacific Northwest. Included also is a description of geologically induced waves, waves seen to be associated with area UFO sightings. and similar waves seen when the spaceship Columbia emerged from her blackout period following her landing on April 14, 1981. A discussion of Tesla's Nicola magnifying transmitter is presented as a probable explanation for some of the ''lightning signature'' waves measured.

The following letter was received by the International Association for and Research Psychotronic Appeared in the I.A.P.R. Newsletter #10 of April 1, 1981.

I enter into this correspondence with you with certain preconceptions in mind as to the exact nature of your organization. Since I have no direct familiarity with the studies that you are at present engaged in, I can only surmise from the fact that you are indeed conversant with paraphysics, you could be said to be tuned into what has variously been termed the ether, Urfeld, odic force, radiant energy, biomagnetism, etc., etc., and that we have much in common. I can at least entertain the hope that you will not dismiss or take lightly what I have to say.

I have dedicated the past decade of my life to the pursuit of scientific truth as I see it. This pursuit has led me, just as it must lead any individual who looks anew at the world without the prejudices of our mechanisticoriented civilization, onto a path which opens a vast, largely untapped territory ready and waiting for exploration and development. The vistas here are grand and the potentials for a better future are immense.

Many of the most profound, intellectually honest human beings ever to walk on our imperiled planet have already made significant inroads into this terrain. I will enumerate only a few. They are: Tesla, Mesmer, T.H. Moray, von Reichenbach and Reich. Unfortunately, to the detriment of the further evolution of mankind, their incisive reconnaisance of the new realms have been ignored and they themselves, in many cases, slandered, persecuted and relegated to the status of charlatans.

Some two years ago I left my employment with a nationwide engineering firm in order to devote my full time to a natural research project. I left behind me a good salaried job, the



**ELECTROMAGNETIC** sium, Marburg, September 5, 1977, 1979, Urban and Schwarzenberg. Munchen-Wien-Baltimore, \$38.00.

This book may well be one of the three or four most important books ever published in the English language. In fact, it clearly lays out a future for theoretical biology, which at present is only in its infancy. Indeed, a simple extension to the work shown in this book -- along the lines of our own proposal for direct engineering of the virtual state -- allows the direct modeling of life, consciousness. biology, and physics in a single comprehensible model.

From the work reported in Electromagnetic Bio-Information and its extension to virtual state engineering. we are speaking of a quantum leap in all the life sciences across the board, an advance as profound as Newton's or Einstein's original work.

In conventional Western biology there is still little knowledge of the basic principles governing a cell as a whole, how the life of a cell is regulated, and precisely how cells communicate and exchange information with each other. The theoretical and experimental investigations necessary to answer these questions are only just beginning.

startlingly shows, a small but determined group of Western researchers has made fundamental progress in the field, and already these developments profound have implications for humanity.

Specifically, biological systems can emit electromagnetic waves and also show sensitive responses -- to signals many orders of magnitude weaker than our normal instruments can detect -- throughout the entire spectral range, from the extremely
