

PETER KELLY

We have reached a point in time and understanding that we create our own This takes place on many levels, but foremost on a personal one.

Once one reaches the realization that we create and are responsible for ourselves and let go of the idea that others are responsible for the way our life is going, you can restructure your life to move events into a positive direction. Beyond the individual level, this principle extends also to social groups, nations, and finally to the whole world.

For purposes of this discussion, Radionics, Psychotronics, and Free Energy phenomena will all manifest to their full levels, as the collective consciousness of mankind accepts and functions within the premise that we create our reality.

Why should this lead to breakthroughs in psychotronics? Very simply because we create our realityand as more people become involved in the research and operation of mind/ matter devices, and the more information becomes available, the greater will be the successes due to first: causality, and then secondly: acausal principles.

When a sufficient number of indi-

sults become scientific (scientifically replicable). Enough momentum builds in the world-mind so that it becomes everyone's reality. This principle is unfortunately true with negative ideas and beliefs also. As Winston Churchill stated after the Battle of Britain,''We have nothing to fear but fear itself''. At some level, by allaying the fears of a discouraged Nation, he rallied them toward a belief of right which led to the turning point of WWII.

The point in linear time between an original idea and its universal acceptance at the world-mind level could properly be called "Kindling Time" (ala Tom Bearden in his many papers Briefing"). and book ''Excalibur I believe (and create by my own belief) that we are in a time in which the seeds have been sown, beliefs created, and enough people have added their beliefs so that breakthroughs in technology will occur on a regular basis. The time of Kindling varies, but since we are in linear time, "Kindling Point +1," would occur by my definition: "When the building of beliefs, anomalies, and effects thereof, reaches a point of cascading or full manifestation into full reality."

Naturally, this is not limited to Psychotronics but is probably some part of the "Whole Truth". Through our realization, may our manifestations all be positive and right for the benefit of the collective consciousness of mankind, the planet Earth, and the Universe of which we are all integral parts.

TOWARD A NEW ELECTROMAGNETICS

TOM BEARDEN

The technical part of Tesla's work, with some new, important aspects of electromagnetics and physics that follow from it. The new work offers

the possibility of eventually tying in Charles Muses' work on the structure of time. It proposes that vacuum, spacetime, and charge are electrical ideas in unexpected ways. It offers a new concept of electrical current that should have been forseen by the particle physicists, and that is consistent with the two-slit experiment, including delayed choice experiments. It also shows exactly what "hyperfields" and "hypercurrents" are, and how they are related to present electrical current and to particle physics.

A PRELIMINARY REPORT

ANDRIJA PUHARICH, M.D., LL.D.

Identification of a chemical compound which may possibly be the receptor mechanism for artificial predatory ELF emissions. In Vitro, and In Vivo [human] studies.

ABSTRACT:

The *in vitro* synthesis of a protoporphyrin complex which shows free oscillatory entrainment from the earth's natural ELF magnetic field at 8 Hz in a solution. This compound has also been found in human blood where it may possibly serve as the receptor-detector for artificial predatory ELF emissions. These findings suggest a line of research to be followed that may lead to a means of protection and defense against artificial predatory ELF emissions.



Carefully researched techniques and an exceptional record of exorcisms make it possible to follow the directions of the super-conscious of an individual in an altered state of consciousness and to communicate with these possessing spirits or invading aliens. Audio and film clips offer profound insight into this stark reality. Scenes ranging from horror and pain to blissful freedom are shared as the appropriate energy is engaged to release these forces into light. memory/intellect, recognition of truth Mental and physical illnesses and burdens can be observed instantly being released.

This presentation discusses briefly the origin of the Lambdoma Diagram and presents its laws relating sound to mathematics. Applications of the Lambdoma Diagram to physics, particularly sound, light, electricity and gravity.

Lambdoma sounds generated by computer at MIT are presented by video.

The effects of these sounds upon residents in a drug rehabilitation art workshop are presented and their results are shown by slides.

SYSTEMOLOGY: A NEW PARADIGM TO RECONCILE PSYCHOTRONICS AND CONVENTIONAL SCIENCES

Abstract

REV. HENRY J. NAGORKA

The history of science records innumerable instances of hostile reception to new ideas—as a result of which scientific progress is impeded. For some time, the fledgling science of psychotronics has been trying to gain

recognition and acceptance as a valid discipline but with little success. The cause lies in the character of the present scientific paradigm which ignores vital functions that confront us in nature. This paper presents the fundamental viewpoints of an alternate paradigm with its own epistemology and methodology originated by a highly gifted friend and colleague, Benedict Victor Arul.

Positivism, logical positivism, and empiricism stand challenged by the discoveries in the psychology of perception which has shown that perception is subject to organization suggesting that "the empiricist credo claiming the possibility of objective knowledge through experiment and observation alone is substantially at variance with truth." (Arul, 1981).

What kind of organization intervenes to arrange sense-derived information into a cognitive system that serves to confer meaning on the world of one's experiences? Arul argues that the same laws that govern the development of biological systems operate in cognitive system formation. This position is in line with the thought of the well known psychologist, Jean Piaget (1971). The necessity of supplanting the present paradigm with another that can live in harmony with the complexities of living systems, and of embracing a scientific method that is suited to the study of living nature is becoming increasingly evident. Ernst Mayr has noted, the conventional scientific method has been heavily influenced by physics and chemistry (Mayr, 1982), while it is biology which deserves the preeminent position as a field wherein conceptual novelties suitable for application in the investigation of natural phenomena should originate.

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN E.L.F., CONSCIOUSNESS, PSYCHOTRONICS, AND ENERGY SYSTEMS

Abstract

ROBERT C. BECK, D.SC.

DESCRIPTORS: Soliton Fields, Morphogenetic Fields, E.L.F., ''Life Force" Patterns, Computerized Radi-Free-Energy developments, Psychokenesis and Metal Bending.

The years 1981-82 have seen stundisciplines, including psychotronics, radionics, life-fields, P.K., and alternative energy systems. Common links are emerging in unrelated scientific studies.

"Morphogenetic Fields" or universal "patterns" (re: Rupert Sheldrake, Cambridge) are under investigation by numerous researchers. Experiments with lower life-forms indicate that our matrices exist externally to our physical bodies, and are NOT carried in the RNA/DNA as previously postulated. Genes may be simply "tuners".

These findings, coupled with the Pribrim/Baum "Holographic Mind" model, suggest for the first time hard core scientific models for empirically established successes of distant treatment with "psychotronic" devices, which with "intention", tap life patterns.

Slides show a modern medical facility in Nevada using advanced, comaccupuncture puterized radionics, and homeopathic modalities achieving stunning success rates with previously "incurable" patients. Advanced instrumentation will be discussed.

Since 1973, when the author first undertook human experiments with E.L.F. magnetic stimulus with human subjects, nearly 2000 studies by medical and university researchers have replicated in large part his initial find-"Soliton" waves in human neuronal tissue have been postulated by Adey, and Huth has demonstrated 100% cures of certain forms of cancer with EM irradiation. Millimeter waves existing on intercellular membranes appear to carry the life-signals instead of random noise as previously assumed. When these are decoded, "life patterns" themselves may emerge. This may portend vastly more significant changes in consciousness and medicine than the physical/chemical ''genetic engineering'' making today's ning and unexpected advances in the headlines. Implications for E.S.P. and fields of many previously controversial psychokenesis will be discussed. Slides will show "metal bending" tests via "mind". The reproduceable interface between Electronics, Gravity, and Life-Patterns (Burr/Ravitz) may have been discovered by W. Hooper shortly before his death in 1971. Two U.S. Patents, issued posthumously, disclose a simple electronic system for generation "motional electric" fields that may simulate the communications link (scalar interferometry) used by higher life-forms for supra-normal communications. (Slides will show his patents and devices and methods.)

Finally, two recent and mysterious "meld-downs", apparently impossible by accepted scientific knowledge, have occurred at widely separated locations in the Southern California deserts. The writer was privileged to be called into the investigation, and hard-core evidence suggests that a new and unexpected mechanism has been accidentally revealed for generating megawatts of power with simple magnetic devices. Slides of the sites, the apparatus, and the devices will be shown. "Hooper" waves are strongly implicated as the "trigger" for converting gravity into electricity. Time permitting, new electronic instruments may be demonstrated so that participants can directly experience the effects of the Scalar Polarization Vector fields.

ELECTROTHERAPEUTICS: WAVE FORMS OF THE PRESENT

Abstract

RUTH HARVEY

Pain . . . neuro-musculo-skeletal pain in particular, is the number one reason most people seek the help of their physicians. In some cases, pain is relieved by the administration of analgesic medication, facet rhizotomies and cordotomies. These are traumatic, invasive and stress producing methods which often prove to be ineffective for long term relief. The chronic pain patient appears to be rehabilitation auite refractory to through surgery or analgesics.

Recognizing the depth of the problem, pain clinics are sprouting in growing numbers all across the land. Using biofeedback, autogenics, hypnosis, meditation, acupuncture and nutrition . . . all methods designed to assist the body in its effort to right its disorders naturally.

Recent advances in the neurosciences, micro electronics and computer technology have given us an unsurpassed method for pain relief and other disorders: Electro-stimulation. Safe, non-invasive, painless, cost effective and fast. Average treatment time is five to ten minutes, with 80% of patients receiving immediate relief for hours, days or permanently from back pain, joint pain (arthritis and bursitis), headaches, muscle pain, nerve pain, post operative pain, whiplash, idiopathic pain and more.

Electromedicine includes electroacutherapy, transcutaneous electric nerve stimulation and biofeedback technology. Electro-acutherapy is a more efficient modality than acupuncture as it does not necessitate puncturing the skin. Also, treatment time is shortened considerably.

Another arm of electromedicine is the somatotopic auriculo-therapy, mapping of the body, which is represented upon the external ear. According to this system, the pioneering work of the French neurologist Paul Nogier, auricular areas of increased electrical conductivity and tenderness to touch, correspond to specific areas of the body where there is pathology. The hypothetical map of bodily regions appears on the external ear in the form of an inverted fetus. Upon diagnosing a reactive point by way of a minute current (one microampere) plus computerized feedback, treatment is administered via biphasic current at particular frequencies and amplitudes.

Other areas of the body can be similarly tested and treated, pathology being denoted in any given area by high impedence to electrical flow. The goal is to break through this impedence and increase conductivity, thereby assisting the body in the correction of electrical balances.

PRE-ATLANTEAN UFO SITES IN THE WEST

THE MANY VARIETIES OF ENERGY

Energy is defined as the ability to cause changes in matter or in other forms of energy. Any change in the condition, the position or the state of motion of any matter, requires energy. "Matter, if entirely without energy would be a meaningless essence which could not manifest itself in any way, and could not even be seen." (Aristotle in "The Physics.") Energy, in itself is completely non-material, and manifest only through effects of interacting with matter. These effects constitute the great bulk of the science of physics.

There are however, some forms of energy which, like the neutrino, do not interact with matter, but only with other forms of energy, and so cannot be detected by material instruments. Some of these energy forms are so subtle and so difficult to detect or to measure, that they are virtually unknown to the conventional sciences, and become known only to those dedicated individuals who spend their lives seeking them out and developing means to demonstrate their existence forms is now generally known as Life uses only his own muscular system as

Energy, but in the past has been known as Vril, Prana, Elan VitalZand by many other names. Its presence is necessary to the creation and the continuation of any form of life, and the degree to which its flow is unimpeded determines the degree of life expectancy, since the aging process begins only as the flow of life energy dwindles.

There are several of the more subtle energy forms that tend to inhibit the generation and the flow of life energy. One of these is emitted from the nucleus of any atom when, for any reason, there is a net loss of binding energy, whether it results from the fission of a heavy atom or the fusion of several light ones, or even in chemical changes, although in that case they are van-Since the radiated ishingly small. energy does not interact with matter, it cannot be detected by any of the instruments designed for the detection of nuclear particles or energies. Since it readily penetrates all matter, there is no way in which any life can be shielded from its effects, and because of the constant nuclear actions going on in the sun, all life is exposed to a certain amount of it. Like all radiation however, it is attenuated according to the inverse square law of distance, and is to begin with, a rather weak energy There is little likelyhood that life on earth will be endangered by it, but its effects upon life expectancy will probably become measurable as nuclear processes proliferate on the planet itself.



Primitive man enlisted the aid of animals stronger than himself to perform his tasks. Even today, in some countries the muscles of domestic animals contribute a large percentage of the energy available to man. As man's knowledge increased however, he bemany forms of natural energy manifesting themselves all around him. When man learned to create and to control fire, he was separated for all time from the life pattern of animals. The heat of fire enabled him to melt metals and to make tools for the collection of other forms of energy, such as that from wind and falling water. Few people today, except those who have studied the subject, have any real concept of the degree to which natural energy sources had been utilized in the distant past and whose technology had progressed steadily until rudely interrupted by the discovery and use of fossil fuels. The fossil fuel interlude will soon be drawing to a close and man will return to the interrupted development of the natural and perpetual sources which will easily serve all of his needs until perhaps, he achieves the final technological breakthrough of the rotation of matter upon the energy axis, or the complete conversion of hydrogen atoms to energy, without pollution and without residue.

These are the complex eight space, five and six dimensional Kaluza-Klein geometries. Descartes geometries. The twister algebra of the complex eight space is mappable one-to-one to the spinor calculus of the Kaluza-Klein geometry. The nonlinear properties associated with the imaginary components of space and time lead to soliton "nondispersive" solutions of the Schroedinger and Dirac equations, which demonstrates a mechanism of this remote connectedness.

Certain detected radiations may be explained by such a model of electromagnetic phenomena. Source and interaction terms such as nonlinear coupling constants are theoretically formulated and experiments suggested.

99.9+% pure nickel anodes of critical diameter, submerged in cells of extremely dilute distilled water solutions of certain alkali halides, when subjected to microampere direct current of low forward potential difference have shown sensitivity to mental activity. Sudden mood and metabolism changes in humans, up to several kilometers distance from the cells, also cause them to react.

Artifactual effects such as R.F. and A.C. interferences, capacitance and instrument noise have been ruled out.

The Executive Council looks forward to a similar level of effectiveness in the 1983 Conference at the University of Portland, Oregon.



beautiful mountainside setting of the town and the school.

The air was pristine at the 5,690 foot altitude and the occasional lazy white cloud only emphasized the intensely blue sky. The horizon in one direction was completely eliminated by a sharply rising range of mountains, partly covered with pine and brush—while in the opposite direction it was possible to see the land dropping away toward Denver, leaving an expansive vista of twenty or more miles.

When we spoke excitedly of this natural beauty, a native resident reacted with reserve.

"You came at a very unusual time. We're usually cloaked in smog up here!"

This was indeed difficult to accept. Here? At a mile up—in the mountains?!

"Yeah"—said the man without reaction. "More and more industry is coming into the area. . ."

After registering and settling into the pleasant accomodations—with no locks on the doors—we stepped out to look about the town—a full three or four blocks long. We discovered Golden to be a treasure house of Americana. The old evidences of a mining town were everywhere. The hilly streets and nineteenth century buildings almost suggest a film setting for a John Wayne western.

We found our way to the dining hall on campus and discovered that we were in for a treat. Institutional food does not need to be overcooked and bland. The cooks at the cafeteria prepared good fresh food with imagination—and tastily seasoned. The "newagers" among our participants—and there are more every year—were pleased to find enough meatless fare and variety of salads and vegetables.

For the most part, the meals were taken up with discussion of the papers just heard—and although friendly, the excitement of new concepts or directions scientifically and metaphysically often animated the cafeteria table debaters.

The scheduling of the presentations into two main lecture halls to run simultaneously was a wise departure from former practice. Although voices were heard objecting to the necessity to choose one speaker over another, this was a natural development resulting from USPA growth. Compare this with the scheduling of 15 speakers simultaneously by the World Future Society (see News Note on page 3) or an even greater number of conflicts each year in the meetings of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

We found ourselves sampling some of the presentations by checking both. For the most part however, it was possible to make a decision from the titles in the program. We missed one or two presentations which we later learned were of serious interest to us. Most of what we heard was useful. A few presentations represented the spearhead research being conducted in the field. Several papers approached the "Ah Ha!" level and were mind-boggling. Exactly what we came to hear!

The release of heretofore concealed information in electromagnetism theory and its profound implications for the future of this civilization made the presentations by Tom Bearden and Bob Beck most significant.. Of equal, if not greater importance, was the exposition by Andrija Puharich on how he is creating life in the laboratory, and his discovery of the key to move it into flora or fauna. Puharich's award for achievement in 1982 was appropriate indeed. The disclosures he made during his acceptance remarks were shockingly significant. It is not necessary to go into the substance of his comments since they are available in their original form on tape (see the end pages of this newsletter), but for the reader who was not there, the substance concerned itself with the mechanisms of interaction with non-terrestrial, god-like intelligences and individualities which have lived for thousands of years.

The evening rap sessions held privately for exchanging information which could not be offered publicly, as well as group metal-bending sessions—these could not compete in excitement and meaning with the Bearden, Beck and Puharich presentations. These lifted us out of this world into some other—and it was hard indeed to return to the physical present.

Packing up to leave the conference we felt great reluctance—wishing to meet again and again with these giants of the frontiers of science and to bathe in the light of their expert knowledge and wisdom. But, the accomodations were already assigned to the next conference—due to arrive that evening—and so with considerable feeling, we made our farewells.

We both agree—we'll never be the same again. We've moved forward.


