ITS TIME FOR A CODE **OF ETHICS**

Many members and friends of USPA have expressed concern that the public is being misled, perhaps even fraudulently, by sales advertising for certain psychotronic devices. Some of these devices are regarded as totally inadequate for meeting the stated purposes. Some are of very shoddy manufacture. The possible far-reaching adverse effects of this situation upon the credibility of our field demands USPA attention.

The following is not yet an official USPA position. It is merely my personal opinion gleaned from discussions with several members of USPA's executive group.

First, a STRONG word of caution: USPA must not become guilty of the same kinds of accusations, judgments and tactics used over the years by those who have opposed the use of all psychotronic devices. No product, re- the Advanced Sciences Research and



USPA Researcher Announces New Herpes Treatment

Charles F. Whitehouse, D.C., of the Etheronic Research Foundation in Venice, California, has reported the establishment of a new immunity program in the treatment and prevention of Herpes Simplex I and II viruses.

Revitalization of the immune system causes the cell to reject the viruses which are neutralized and become non-active.

USPA GAINS NON-PROFIT STATUS

After lengthy negotiations, spear-headed by Secretary-Treasurer Robert Beutlich, the IRS has granted USPA a temporary tax exempt status under 509 (a)(2). Final approval is expected at the close of 1983.

The period of correspondence, extending from 1977 to 1981, has resulted in the approval of a 501(c)(4) status which will allow the recovery of taxes and penalties assessed by the IRS

Continued from page 1 please everyone. No theory or explanation, regardless of its depth or excellence, will satisfy everyone. Furthermore, no psychotronic device, regardless of its design, profound theoretical basis or quality of manufacture, can be expected to perform equally (or even as designed) for everyone. No set of instructions or training plan has yet been offered that can make a successful "operator" of every person

A public-supported, non-profit organization, USPA cannot be judge, jury and police force for any absolute standards for the design, construction and operation of psychotronic devices.

What we are in a position to do follows.

Purchasing a psychotronic device by mail, where inspection and test of the device before making payment is not possible, requires a strong, positive Guarantee of Satisfaction.

Such a purchase by mail should not be considered final until thirty days after receipt of the psychotronic device by the purchaser. During this period, the purchaser should be entitled to inspect the device (without damaging it or tampering with its technology) just as though he were examining it beforehand. In addition, the purchaser should have this period to test the device, in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, to make certain that it performs for the purchaser as advertised. Should the


purchaser's decision result in rejecting the device, he should have the right to return the device to the supplier for a full and immediate refund of the purchase price.

Every supplier should include a written warning with every device pointing out that a small percentage of users of psychotronic devices may experience "negative" or "disturbing" influences on their own wellbeing. The warning should state that, in the event of negative effects, the user should immediately shut down all psychotronic devices and seek guidance, training and/or counselling from a person or organization recognized as being both knowledgeable and experienced in the area of psychotronic phenomena.

I would see these suggestions as the basis of a "code of ethics" for mail order sales of psychotronic devices. The "standard" Guarantee of Satisfaction could be published and promoted by USPA. These suppliers incorporating it in their literature and implementing it in their practices would be publicly recognized. Only these suppliers would be recommended in response to inquiries.



BOOK REVIEWS



THE MAGIC OF TONE AND THE ART OF MUSIC, BY Dane Rudhyar, 1982. Shambhala Press, 199 pp., \$8.95 paperback

Dane Rudhyar leaves no stone unturned in his effort to uncover the history of music in the light of new age concepts. His vast knowledge of the esoteric sciences, such as astrology and numerology, adds a new perspective to music, sound and the music of the spheres.

He begins with the primitive use of sound and tone, (tone is sound imbedded with quality), as a magical rite and sacred intonations of the seven great dieties.

This magical power, claims Rudhyer, has been lost through the ages and is on the verge of rediscovery. The turn of the spiral is coming to a time in which sound and its sacred uses will again become central to an age of man.

To musicians, his historical work done on Pythagoras is truly an important contribution.

"As a continuing stream of consciousness, sound is also a current of energy which changes and grows," Rhudyar claims. The music of the spheres will allow the collective humanity group to be in harmony with each other and communicate upon a higher level.

Obviously, he is a philosopher and, at times, a scientist.

I hold this work in great admiration.
It is a feat of enormous experience and insight. I would recommend it highly for any musician, professional or amateur.

A layman certainly would profit from the book as long as an open mind and open heart are kept alongside the mind. The book is not easy reading, but is extremely rewarding.

TRANSVERSE PARAPHYSICS, by J. G. Gallimore, 1983. Tesla Book Co., Milbrae, CA, \$40, Large Format

This is by far Gallimore's best book. The previous books were a montage of facts and miscellany, and one needs almost as much knowledge as the author to comprehend the material. Here, however, is a straightforward presentation which makes sense.

The author begins with a postulate created by Rocky McCullom in his book (which he credits) of "Spanners" in Chapter I, and progresses with numerous drawings throughout to explain the systemology. Chapter II discusses the relationship of space, time and gravity flows, building a working theory. Chapter III is devoted to particles, their formation and charges. Chapter IV is on gravity/time. Chapter V concerns new gravity discoveries. Chapter VI takes up antigravity and Chapter VIII is on spacetime and bio-physics.

Gallimore also includes his patent applications and additional detailed materials not hitherto published, which are excellent.

While there are questionable areas, in my opinion, relating to velocities cited and charges assigned to particles, the whole book stands out as one which can be easily comprehended. The math is at a minimum and to the point, making it digestible by one with a

high school education in science and physics.

INSIGHTS INTO PREHISTORY—A New and Startling Overview of the Late Prehistoric Period, by Michael Barron, 1982. Exposition Press, Inc., Smithson, NY, 107 pp., \$7.00

A scientific journalist and Who's Who alumnus, Dr. Barron adds a second volume to his study of the prehistoric beginnings of man's ancient past. Just a year ago, he published Atlantis Reconsidered, first outlining his amazing scientific theories concerning the progressive stages of man's prehistory and past technology utilized on the two ancient continents of Atlantis and Lemuria. Insights Into Prehistory further substantiates his claims with phenomenal evidences that infer antediluvian (Adamic or Cro-Magnon) man's origin, with references from such diverse sources as esoteric writings, archival and folk legends.

Dr. Barron establishes a logical approach to the subject of earth's cosmogenesis with the comparison of two most important allegories of the prehistorical period, the Genesis and Homer's Odyssey. Earth core gravitational energy is the essential catalyst which brought about dynamic magnetic conditions, especially in the great polar concavities described as nether regions where a high degree of volcanic and magnetic activity provided heat and illumination. In such an environment, unexposed to the earth's surface and in close proximity to the earth's core, amazing and dramatic effects result in the atomic structure of matter, producing such phenomena as induced invisibility and spontaneous genetic transformations. magnetic Such a biological picture, not evident today, accounted for the fabulous technological resources used by such civilizations as Atlantis and Lemuria.

World cataclysms of which at least several have taken place over the recent millenia, very probably are related to subterranean gravity tapping activities of Atlantis and Lemuria. The author further substantiates his theory of an advanced underground civilization and its eventual merging with the surface inhabitants. same model hidden between the lines of man's recorded past is outlined in detail in the chapters on Psychical and Esoteric Insights and Prehistoric Traditions. The "Anthropogenesis in the Secret Volume" of which Mme. Blavatsky selected 49 stanzas for the Secret Doctrine, traces the races of man beginning with the Polarian or Adamic, through the Hyporean, Lemurian, Atlantian and Aryan. essence of ancient symbology collectively reflects a past pointing to Atlantis and Lemuria. This central theme is repeated throughout the brief nine chapters.

After reading this very interesting essay on prehistory, I was quite convinced concerning the possibility of a dynamic society once ruling the earth using an energy source such as magnetic gravitation. The reference to the succession of the races taken from the Secret Doctrine, and allegories found in Homeric, Old Testament and other legends are quite convincing evidence and provide familiarity to those interested in esoteric reading.

Continued from page 11 the Secrets of Electrical Free Energy. Dr. Rolf Schaffranke has published a paper entitled Proofs of Free Energy Devices and Supporting Data. Both are combined in one 8½ X 11 booklet issued by the Tesla Book Co. of Millbrae, CA.

The same firm has also published Bearden's Solution to Tesla's Secrets and the Soviet Tesla Weapons, combining it with John Ratzlaff's Reference Articles for Solutions to Tesla's Secrets.

A hitherto unmentioned researcher who is publishing his own materials is Raymond A. Nelli, of High Energy Electrostatics Research in Springfield,

Virginia. His introductory work of 90 pages, 81/2 X 11 in size, takes up: antigravity and UFOs, paranormal phenomena, energy, and three appendices, including 58 pages of patent abstracts, including filings by Tesla, Hieronymus, L. DeForest, Edison, J.G. Trump, T. T. Brown and others. Nelli has projected an output for the near future of three major volumes expanding the three subjects touched upon in his introductory book: These three volumes, of which No. 1 is now available (Antigravity and UFOs) are all expected to run about 600 pages in length, and to cost \$65.00 or more. STANDARDS ACTIONS—A REVIEW

Rev. Henry J. Nagorka

Within weeks after the 1982 Conference, the USPA board turned its attention to two matters which further point up the need for the setting and maintenance of standards.

Since the organization's inception in 1975, discussion has continued informally in the matter of standards relating to research presentations and the quality of related products and instrumentation sold privately and commercially, as well as the personal ethics of members and officers of USPA. The implication arising from such discussion is that the USPA, aside from governmental agencies charged with overall policing of the commercial and health activities, remains in the most central position for accepting responsibility in this matter.

Opinions expressed during continuing consideration of standards for USPA itself and to an extent for the whole field of psychotronics/radionics in the U.S., include several basic positions. (1) There is no authoritative or responsible "policing" of standards. (2) The USPA is not in a position at present to initiate a national program of this kind. (3) Its organizational charter carries specific selfimposed limitations in regard to such activities. (4) Despite all considerations to the contrary, it is generally agreed that at least intra-organizational standards and maintenance are needed.

The first Standards Committee was created during the 1977 Conference in Atlanta, Georgia. Members included T. Galen Hieronymus, Robert Beck

and Neil Michaelson. The present committee is composed of J.G. Gallimore, Ivan Kruglak, Kathleen Joyce and Thomas Bearden. A parallel Instrumentation Committee consists of Robert Beck, T. Galen Hieronymus, Samuel Lentine, Peter Kelly, Ivan Kruglak and Joan Orion.

These groups are now considering two cases. One involves a commercial firm which is marketing a psychotronic device which has drawn criticism and complaints from numerous members and non-members. Analysis of the instrument has been made, and all company advertised claims for it are on file. The product has been found to include serious flaws in design and The committees are now function. considering a progressive plan of action designed either to correct the shortcomings of the product or, failing this, to publicize the facts, thereby discouraging prospective purchasers.

The second case, one which is infinitely more difficult to deal with, involves matters integral with USPA and its personnel. In view of its sensitivity and the attendant dangers of misconstruing actions and attendant motives, thereby damaging individual reputations and psyches, the matter has been classified as strictly confidential. It is in the organizations' and members' best interest to resolve such matters without publicity.

This review of standards considerations and actions is being provided for the information of the membership in the interest of keeping it apprised of USPA's growing responsibilities.



Many presentations at USPA Conferences have included The Many Worlds Interpretation of Quantum Mechanics which included work by physicists Hugh Everett, III, who passed away in northern Virginia in 1982, and J. A. Wheeler, his mentor at Princeton University, who, a few years ago, before a yearly gathering of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, denounced these concepts and himself. He was apparently no longer able to withstand the psychological pressure of his orthodox colleagues' disapproval. The Princeton series in physics is still publishing this work at \$12.50 in paperback. However, if your mathematics expertise is not at highly advanced levels, you may find it incomprehensible.

Simon and Schuster of New York City in 1982 published Heinz R. Pagels' book *The Cosmic Code*. Intended to bring the excitement of physics to a larger public, this work is divided into three parts: *The Road to Quantum Reality, The Voyage into Matter* and *The Cosmic Code*. It is good solid information reviewing the progress made recently in understanding our cosmic environment.
