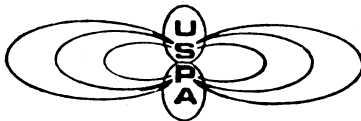

SELECTED ABSTRACTS OF CONFERENCE PAPERS

**INTERACTIONS OF WEAK NON-LINEAR
EXTREMELY LOW FREQUENCY ELECTROMAGNETIC
FIELDS WITH BIOLOGICAL PROCESSES**

by Eldon A. Byrd

Recent work by Delgado, Adey and others indicate profound alterations of biological processes in cells, organs, and organisms under the influence of certain types of non-linear, weak, electromagnetic (mostly magnetic) elf fields. These effects include: reprogramming of DNA genetic codes (in human leukemia cells and in inherited characteristics in whole organisms), entrainment of DNA replication, direct interaction with the self-generated fields of growing embryos, regeneration of amputated mammal limbs, and marked slowing of the ageing process. These and other recent discoveries will be presented.

A model has been developed in an attempt to explain the mechanisms which may contribute to the observed interactions. Although complex in its entirety, a simplified version will be presented which includes soliton interaction with glycoproteins in cell membranes and how the energy can be transferred into chemical processes inside cells.

The implications of this new technology will be discussed, including how it is going to change our lives. Also, how early work by USPA members paved the way toward development of what may turn out to be the most important discoveries in the history of mankind.

**PATTERN ANALYSIS OF THE
MALCOLM RAE CARDS**

This paper covers an analysis done on several hundred Malcolm Rae pattern cards. Radii positions on the cards were translated into angle measurements and analysis of several different types was performed to determine significant parameters in different types of Rae cards.

The parameters and their limits are described, as well as the experimental procedure involved in translating the geometric patterns into mathematical figures. Differences and similarities for the different cards are noted.

Connections are also drawn to the work of other researchers in allied fields.

SAKKARA, THE SCHOOL OF MIND OVER MATTER

Sakkara was the school of mysteries in Egypt. It was here that the builders of the great pyramid were trained to use the rods and coils which were developed so that this structure could be built. The rods were used to levitate the blocks and the coils were used to change the structure of the magnetic field so that this great feat could be accomplished.

Within the confines of Sakkara the magnetic field of the earth was changed so that the student's own electromagnetic field could be charged with electromagnetic energy. The secret of learning to use the rods and coils has to be achieved within a raised frequency. In order to use these instruments, the individual must learn to alter his own aura. This alteration allows the student to have mind over matter.

This paper is designed to describe some of the principles of how the magnetic fields of Sakkara were generated. Sakkara was a walled school, with the walls so built as to set up a Hertzian wave. Built in the center of this compound was a step pyramid (condenser) designed to send a pulsed energy field throughout the whole school. In the time of Atlantis the step pyramid was called the Temple of Beauty. It was here that a student trained to transmute himself to a higher plane.

Within this center there were other structures developed to advance the student's ability to control his own energy field. The Temple of Sacrifice was the beginning level. Here the student learned to balance out all anxiety -- fear, anger, jealousy and hate -- so that he could enter the school of vibration where he learned to use the rods and the coils. These instruments allowed the individual to alter his own energy field and change the structure of matter.

The rod was the Viril rod, similar to the rod of Moses, and the coil was the Caduceus carried by the medical profession today. Its purpose was to alter the magnetic structure of matter so that base

metals and liquids could be changed. Both these instruments allowed the student to develop his own energy field so that he learned to overcome matter. In fact, the whole complex of Sakkara was so developed that it generated a field designed to help humanity advance in consciousness.

This paper is designed to review the techniques used in training the students of Sakkara in the proper use of the Caduceus Coil. The Caduceus was one of the first psychotronic devices ever given to humanity. Its use is designed to help the human being learn to transform his own energy field so that the electromagnetic field of another human being, the earth, or the small particles of matter can be changed. The Caduceus was an instrument designed to aid the student into a complete understanding of altering his own electrical field so that he could achieve mind over matter.

COSMIC PSYCHOTRONICS

THE THEORY OF UNIVERSAL DYNAMICS

Over the last decade, scientists working on the frontiers of physics have come up with an entirely new way of looking at the universe. Their focus is on the forces of nature and their goal is grand unification. They hope to find one single entity which will govern all interactions in the universe. Many theories have been presented and experimented with, but none can claim this grand unification.

The theory of Universal Dynamics does not claim grand unification, but it does claim to be a tool for better understanding of the basic laws and principles of Universal Law.

Contained in this paper is a working understanding of unification of technical, scientific and abstract information. The theory explains:

1. The 12 secondary laws and their division into 7 absolute and 5 permissive laws.
2. How these laws can be found in the musical scale, sunspot cycles, and other relationships.
3. The 4 primary universal forces.
4. The 3 laws relating polarity and its dynamics.
5. The 2 laws relative to the law of balance.
6. The outline of the principle of 1 universal cycle and all it contains.

A completed Dynamics Work Chart has many practical uses, not only to the physicist but in all fields of study.

For example, the quotation "Is this good or bad?" is an age-old question. If you know the composite vibration of something, you can compare it to the chart, and if it matches one of the numbers, it is "good" or in harmony with the universe. If it doesn't match, it is out of harmony or "bad." The 60 cycle electricity we use today is a good example of how this can be used. Is it positive or negative to us? By using the information provided by the chart we find that 60hz is NOT in harmony with our brain waves

and therefore any entrainment with it would be negative. If it were 61.74 or 58.27 hz, it would have a positive effect on us. Conclusion: use DC converters on all incandescent lights to avoid negative light pulsation stimuli.

There are several basic charts which can easily be created. The Bio-dynamics is useful as described above. The General Dynamics chart can be used by both technical and lay people for placing information in a workable structure which the brain can easily process. The Particle, Electro, and Etherical Dynamics charts are useful to the pioneers in Universal Law.

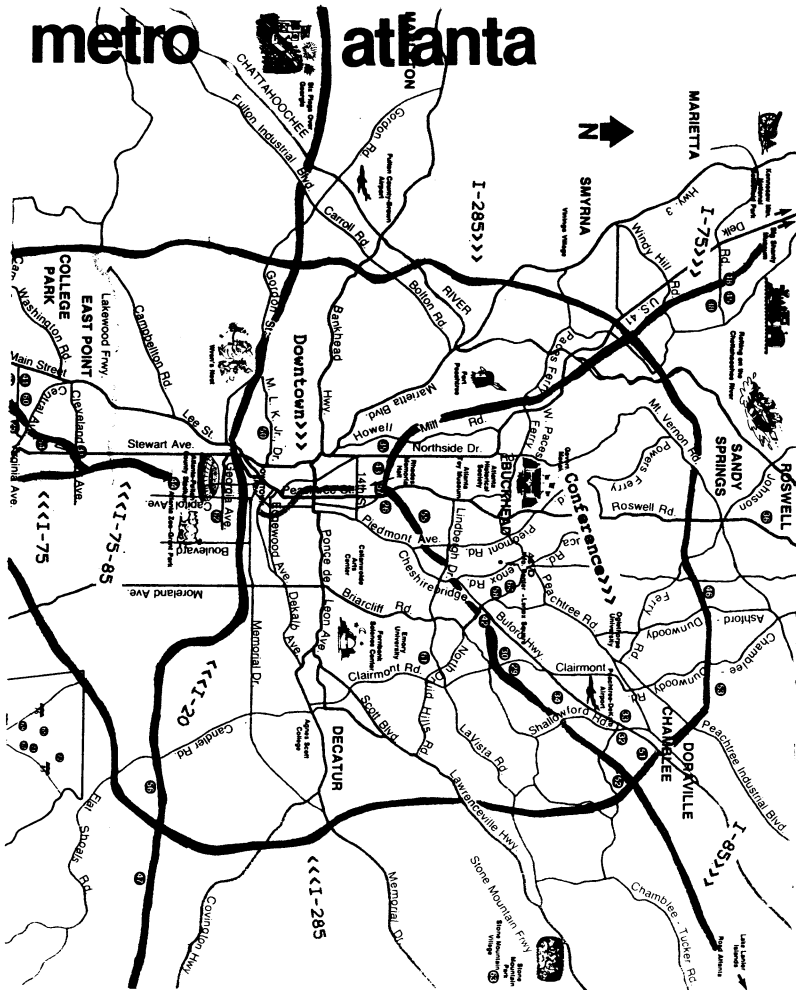

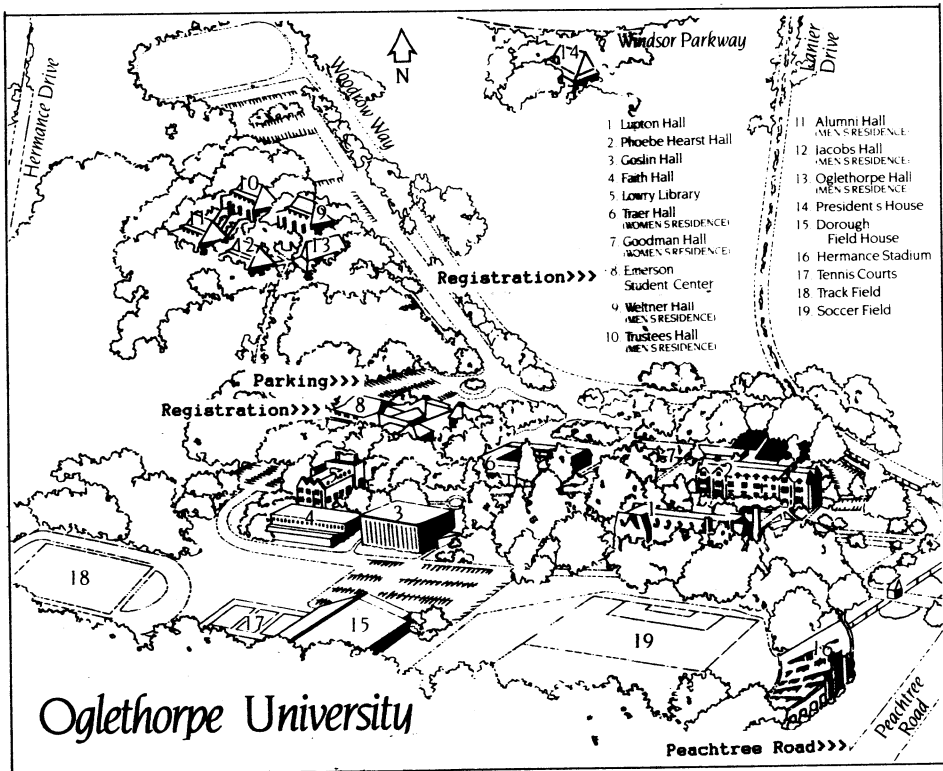
