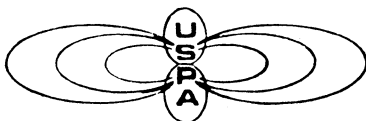

BASIC SCALAR EM CONCEPTS
and
A SCALAR WAVE DETECTOR

By Thomas E. Bearden

Define a "vector zero" E-field system as:

$$\vec{E}_T = \vec{0} = \sum_{i=0}^n \vec{E}_i$$

Define an artificial electrostatic potential as:

$$\phi_a \equiv \sum_{i=0}^n |\vec{E}_i|$$

It can now be seen that the \vec{E}_i can all (or a portion) be time-varying. Take the simplest case, where all vary sinusoidally with time, and in phase. In that case,

$$\vec{E}_T = \vec{0} \quad \text{always, yet} \quad \phi_A = A \cos \theta \quad \text{or}$$

$$\phi_a [X, T] = A \sin \left[\frac{2\pi X}{\lambda} + \frac{2\pi f T}{m} \right]$$

So we have defined a wave of pure potential, a "scalar wave" or "Tesla wave," which never develops a non-zero gradient to a point-measurement device, yet is a sinusoidal wave of pure potential as a function of time.

Note that each component \vec{E}_i has "EM energy" in the accepted sense, yet the overall scalar wave does not possess any "envelope" E-H energy.

This is the scalar EM wave. Note I can "enfold" as much EM energy as I wish, yet ordinary measurement detection devices (point measurement) show no energy whatsoever.

The "locked-in" energy is in a new form; I call it "anenergy."

Let K represent "kinetic" wave energy in the accepted EM sense.

Then $K_i \neq 0, [A_i \neq 0]$

yet $K_T = 0 [A_i \neq 0], \left[\sum_{i=1}^n \vec{E}_i = \vec{0} \right] \ggggg$

Scalar EM Concepts (Continued)

Now define K_A as the anenergy.

then $K_A \neq 0$ even though $K_T = 0$

Let
$$K_A = \sum_{i=1}^n |k_i|$$

This is its definition. It represents the amount of "energy" (related to a single non-zero force gradient) which has been locked into "an-energy" (related to a multiple set of force gradients that sum to a system zero-vector resultant).

Let K_S = the average ambient anenergy stress of vacuum/spacetime.

Then the scalar wave represents a disturbance in K_S

In a local region, a standing scalar wave represents an additional accumulation of K_S in that local region. In other words, the addition of K_n represents an amount of $[K_S + K_a]$ in the local region of spacetime.

This now represents a locally curved spacetime, and the local system is now a general relativistic system. Ergo, "conservation of energy" does not locally apply, if we believe general relativity!

The Bedini motor utilizes special application of this principle to achieve a locally general relativistic system. Locally, then, it can be either a local sink or a local source to the external observer, depending on the way the curvature of spacetime is achieved (positive or negative).

Note that, in either case, a compensatory opposing curvature of spacetime will exist in the immediate surrounding environment. Hence, if the machine produces "free energy," this energy is extracted from the locally surrounding environment, producing a cooling effect externally. If the machine acts as a "sink" and soaks up energy, this energy is added to the locally surrounding environment, producing a heating effect externally

Scalar EM Concepts (Continued)

Scalar Wave Detector

The following is a scheme for building a scalar wave detector. The features are:

(1) A Faraday cage is used to strip off and ground out competing ordinary (transverse) EM waves. Only scalar waves (waves of artificial potential) enter the Faraday cage.

(2) The S pole of a strong magnet (ceramic or similar) inside the cage is used to warp the local spacetime. Specifically, it adds a magnetostatic scalar potential to the ambient magnetostatic scalar potential of the vacuum.

(3) The entering scalar wave -- which is after all a zero-summed system of phased EM waves -- enters the warped spacetime region above the S-pole. The warping thus dephases the waves partially. The result is that the system no longer sums to zero, but now has a situation where:

$$\vec{E}_T = \sum_{i=0}^N \vec{E}_i \neq \vec{0} \quad (\text{"e" vector no longer} = \vec{0})$$

Thus the new \vec{E}_T is non-zero, and this is detectable by a quite ordinary detector. Similarly with the \vec{B}_T field.

(4) A coil, axially aligned along the longitudinal axis of the magnet, acts as a detector for the now non-zero, time-varying $E_T - B_T$ wave from the dephasing of the scalar wave.

(5) A simple adjustable tuning capacitor in series with one end of the floating pickup coil allows the resonant bandwidth desired to be tuned in.

(6) The detected signal is carefully brought through the Faraday cage within a shielded cable out to an oscilloscope. For greater sensitivity, include a transistorized preamp inside the cage, just after the tuning capacitor. Adjust pickup coil value and tuning capacitor value according to the bandwidth it is desired to scan.

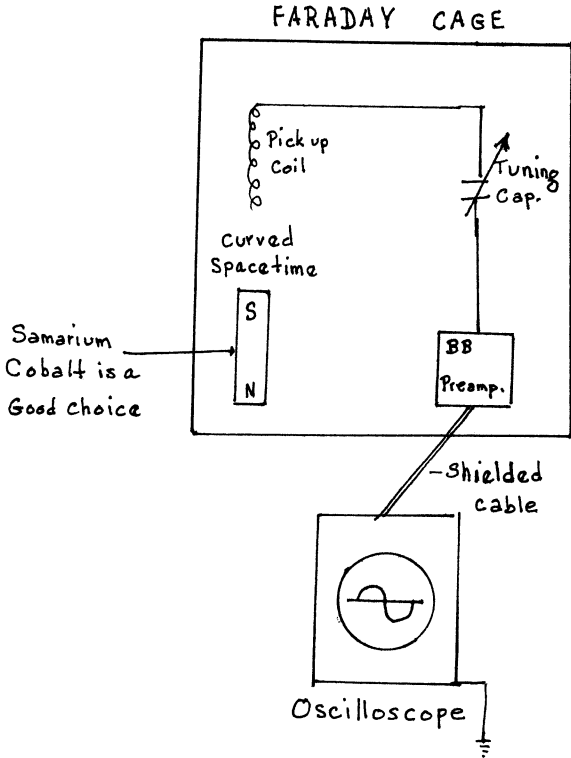
(7) Multiple tuning arrangements can be incorporated to constitute a spectrum analyzer.

(8) A superconducting magnet can be utilized for much greater sensitivity.

(9) Note that the cage must not be large and enclosing the human operator. The human being is a scalar functioning system which can to some extent "blank out" or cancel scalar fields in its immediate environment. >>>>

Scalar EM Concepts (Continued)

This is the scheme for the scalar detector built by John Bedini. It generally follows a scheme originated by Jack Dea and Hal Faretto. The scalar EM explanation is my own, along with the concepts of the vacuum/spacetime being nothing but combined electrostatic and magneto-static scalar potential, the concept of the artificial potential, the concept of anenergy, etc.

GEOPATHOLOGY

PHYSIOLOGICAL EFFECTS AND METHODS OF DETECTION

A geopathic stress or zone is any disturbed energy field arising from the earth or from the local environment. These areas may be classified into five categories: Charging "Yang" fields such as those arising from mineral ore deposits or from fault lines; discharging "Yin" fields from underground water streams -- moving and under pressure or from caverns; Global Grid Networks which may be Yin or Yang; Radiation stresses -- corpuscular or non-corpuscular; and Electromagnetic stress, which is usually man-made and has been recently dubbed "Technical Stress."

There are two types of Global Grid Networks: the Hartmann grid, which runs north-south and east-west, measures 2m x 2.5m, and whose intersecting points occupy a 20cm. square; the Curry grid, which runs diagonally to the Hartmann grid and measures 3m x 3m.

The Yin type of geopathic stress areas give rise to "hypofunctioning" disorders such as fatigue, arthritis, cancer, multiple sclerosis, and degenerative conditions. The Yang type promote "hyperfunctioning" disorders such as hypertension, apoplexy, "mania" type of psychological disorders, and alcoholism.

The low-level non-corpuscular radiation varies according to rock structure; e.g., granite, or from underground oil deposits as found in shale. The emissions from radioactive ores would fall under the corpuscular type and would be more easily detected. Fatigue, chronic skin complaints, and degenerative conditions are all possible complaints arising from the radiation type of geopathic stress.

Electromagnetic stress may arise

from many different sources, most of which are "self-induced." Electric blankets, waterbed heaters, and main power lines situated in a wall by one's sleeping place are just a few examples. The electromagnetic fields created by electric lines in our houses can have a significant effect on the hypothalamus, particularly when they are located near one's head. Buccal currents created by the interaction of amalgam fillings and saliva can lead to kidney, cardiac, and intestinal disturbances, as well as disorders of the central nervous system.

There is an oscillating, harmonic, magnetic field which exists between the ionosphere and the surface of the earth called the Schumann Waves. These waves can be distorted and blocked by various structures such as reinforced concrete. Over a period of time one may begin to experience vague and unusual symptoms which are often misdiagnosed, and more importantly, mistreated.

Another type of electromagnetic stress results from electrostatic fields created by high voltage power lines. In the Atlanta Constitution, June 19, 1984, an article entitled "Power Line Hazard a Real Possibility" reflects the increasing awareness of these unseen health hazards. Back in March, the AP carried a story that the federal government plans to expand research on magnetic fields produced by power lines in the wake of studies linking exposure to such fields with higher incidence of leukemia, other types of cancer, and suicide.

The U.S.S.R. already has very strict rules and limitations regarding high voltage powerline construction and microwave emissions of radio stations.

The position of the moon as well as a presence of solar activity will affect the "strength" and size of the geopathic >>>>

disturbance fields. It also should be noted that the aforementioned "Technical Stress" is less intense than the other Geopathic stresses and that the oscillations arising from the technical variety are more intense at about 10 cm. from the floor surface.

Although a geopathic zone rarely affects healthy persons to a significant degree, experiments have revealed that susceptible individuals will demonstrate aberrations of physical processes involving such things as extra systoles as found on an EKG, i.e., heart arrhythmias; hormonal changes; alteration of resistance values as measured by E.A.V.; and infrared spectral emissions of patients.

"Charging yang" geopathic areas will increase the geomagnetic field intensity, resulting in a proportional increase in liver glycogen synthesis. DNA changes have been found and are proportional to geomagnetic changes. The helical structure of the DNA, as well as in hair, memsenchyme, and hemoglobin, serve as antennae which receive the geopathically disturbed oscillations. The result is a change in polarity and in the direction of spin (electrons rotate to the left; protons to the right).

Cellular metabolism, e.g., rate of mitosis (cancer?), oxygen utilization, as well as the permeability of the cell membrane, is affected adversely by these geopathic zones. In a study by the U.S. Dept. of Health, Education and Welfare conducted in 1976, entitled Geomagnetism, Cancer, Weather and Cosmic Radiation, it is stated that "An association was found between geomagnetic latitude and neonatal deaths due to congenital anomalies" and further goes on to say, "The distribution of cancer...tends to conform to the pattern of geomagnetic flux." That

is to say, there was an increase in the incidence of cancer proportional to a decrease in the intensity of the geomagnetic fields.

Colloidal fluid systems of living tissue will demonstrate variations in the presence of geopathic fields. Apparently the connective tissue zone between the capillaries and the parenchyma is affected by the the geopathic zones via the influence of the altered geomagnetic field on the cluster structure of water. This may be a possible explanation why therapies, including homeopathics, are ineffective until the geopathic disturbance is addressed.

The magnetic field distortions found in geopathic zones affect the direction of spin of the molecules as well as their axis of orientation. This may result in changes in the pH of the blood and other body fluids depending on the amount as well as location of the stress on the body.

Scientists in West Germany feel that this molecular spin disturbance affects the photo-repair system, which plays a vital role in one's immunological system. It appears that the cells communicate with each other via an electromagnetic phenomenon which permits the detection and consequent repair of chromosomal aberrations. It has been suggested that a breakdown in this extremely critical "surveillance" system may result in the uncontrolled proliferation of cells, as found in cancer.

The symptomatic picture present in patients continuously exposed to geopathic stress will vary according to their health status prior to the exposure. Weight loss, increased susceptibility to bacterial and fungal infections, therapy resistance, and excessive dreaming and nightmares are some of the numerous complaints commonly reported. People may indicate that they feel better while on vacation or with a change of >>>>

residence. Exposure often leads to insomnia, waking up often with difficulty falling back to sleep, and arising in the morning feeling as tired as when they retired the previous evening.

Chronic diseases are also pathognomonic of geopathic stress as the body loses its ability to adapt. Dyspnea, asthmatic complaints, restless legs, feeling cold in bed, and especially, nighttime aggravation of symptoms will often plague these poor, misdiagnosed people.

Evidence of geopathology can also be found in nature. Plant root patterns and color changes; rotation and/or spiraling of bark lines; changes in grass type, pattern, and quality; knots in trees (some theorize this to be a tree "cancer!"); parasitic plant growth on trees (usually associated with underground water streams); and split trunks have all been linked to geopathic phenomena.

Research has shown that a geopathically disturbed zone will demonstrate an alteration of several physical parameters, such as lowered levels of gamma-type radiation; acoustic anomalies; microwave and shortwave variations; increased concentration of positively charged ions; higher resistance of air and soil; and temperature differential, particularly from an increase in the infrared zone.

A variation in the quantity of cosmic radiation registered over geopathic zones has also been documented. If the earth's magnetic field is disturbed over a large area then more cosmic rays are allowed through, since the magnetic field acts as a shield. Environmental changes are likely at these locales.

It has been determined that an abrupt change in the strength of

the earth's magnetic field -- approximately 3,000 nanoTesla or more over an expanse of 50 cm. or less -- will indicate the presence of a significant, biologically hazardous geopathic burden. The greater the change in magnetic field strength (over the shortest distance) the stronger the geopathic disturbance.

Dr. Ludger Mersmann, a German physicist, created an extremely sensitive instrument capable of measuring these ultrafine alterations of the earth's magnetic field. Much like a Geiger counter, which measures changes in radioactivity levels, the Geomagnetometer BPM 2001 detects the magnetic fluctuations found over geopathic zones. Dr. Mersmann's instrument provides an invaluable tool for the physician who is aware of the pathophysiological relationship between ill health and geopathic stress.

ELECTRIC SMOG

>>Microwave or radiowave sickness is recognized as an occupational sickness in the Soviet Union.

>>Out of a group of 17 men who worked on an experimental EMP (electromagnetic pulse) generating system, beginning in 1967, five developed cancer within the following seven years.

>>University of Colorado medical researchers found that the death rate for certain cancers, such as leukemia, was higher than average in homes within 130 feet of high-current power lines.

Does such information surprise you? If it does, likely you are among many millions who have always thought of electricity as a clean, non-polluting source of energy.

We have heard a lot about environmental pollution since the late 1960's and early 1970's. To improve matters, some scientists and ecologists recommend that more of our modern power-consuming equipment be changed over from fossil fuels to "clean electricity." But, in view of accumulating evidence, many researchers are now asking How "clean" is electricity? They speak of "electric smog."

WHAT IS "ELECTRIC SMOG"?

It has long been recognized that all electric appliances give off radiation and create electromagnetic fields. Of course, the most significant of these fields come from power-generating plants and their transmission systems. But mankind is now enveloped in an extensive variety of man-made fields at diversified energy levels. In this way the environment is polluted with fields of static, alternating electricity and electromagnetism. Just a few examples

illustrate how pervasive it is:

<A group of people who live near high-voltage power lines in New York State took fluorescent tubes outdoors one moonless night. As much as 200 feet from the lines, the tubes began to glow -- just from the electricity in the air!

<At an airport, a magnetic field invisibly frisks you, and your baggage is X-rayed. On leaving a library or department store a detection system sets off an alarm if you haven't checked out your book or have failed to pay for goods in your possession.

Wherever we go, whatever we do, it appears that we cannot get away from these EM fields. The question which now concerns us is: Are these fields harmful?

HOW HARMFUL?

Dr. Joseph H. Battocletti in his book Electromagnetism, Man and the Environment made the statement: "It has already been established beyond a shadow of a doubt that some sources produce extremely deleterious effects. It is also probably true that some sources produce no effects...There are many sources whose effects are as yet unknown."

Regarding certain effects which are known to be serious, Dr. Milton M. Zaret of NYU in Medical Research Engineering, stated: "Some general population groupings...appear to have been placed in jeopardy." Illustrating his point, he referred to northern Karelia in Finland. Directly across Lake Lagoda from this region, Russia has installed its high-powered microwave radar early warning system against possible ICBM attack. As a result, the population is under a 24-hour-a-day bombardment of both ground waves and scatter radiation. The death rate from sudden heart attack in this area is among >>>>

the highest in the world. Also, medical findings show a meaningful increase in the cancer rate.

The real concern felt by medical men regarding the adverse effects of microwaves is well summarized by Dr. Felix Gad Sulman of Hadasah University Medical Center in Jerusalem: "We must now accept the fact that radar is detrimental to the human body. The following organs seem to be especially sensitive: the central nervous system, the endocrine system including the gonads, the blood system, the eye, the ear and the genes."

What about the power-transmission lines of generating plants? Studies differ in their conclusions, yet numerous studies have shown that growth rates of mice and rats have been affected by these EM fields.

It has been demonstrated that artificial EM fields can interfere with the way our internal clocks are synchronized. Consequently, our normal biological rhythms tend to adapt to the artificial pulse of electric smog rather than the natural magnetic field of the earth. The result is stress on the human body, bringing with it a breakdown of our general resistance to various diseases.

Some U.S. Navy technicians who underwent prolonged exposure to radiation from extremely low frequency transmitters experienced unusually high levels of serum triglycerides, a sign associated with coronary troubles and strokes. The ability of some of these men to perform simple addition deteriorated. Even the buried antennae of some transmitters emitted enough radiation to disorient waterfowl flying overhead.

Home electrical appliances also give off radiation, though in lesser amounts. Some may have little or no adverse effect, but others do. The ultraviolet sun-

tanning lamp is considered to be the most dangerous source of radiation in the home. Also, warnings have been issued regarding hair dryers and even electric blankets. These three items, because of their prolonged use, are considered to have possibly the most injurious effects, though some people may use them for years with no discernible negative results.

Exposure from household accessories such as microwave ovens can also have a definite effect on a person's health. Low-intensity microwave exposure has observable adverse influence on the body's bloodmaking process and could bring changes in the immunological system.

WHY CONFLICTING REPORTS?

Why are there still reports of experiments indicating no harm resulting to human beings or other creatures? One researcher stated: "Unfortunately, almost all of the research work currently in progress, as well as most of the surveys of existing literature, is directly or indirectly financed by the electric industry. It would be unrealistic to expect that results emerging from this industry-funded research would present an unequivocal case against the big transmission lines."

Interestingly, Environment magazine of 1978 lists a summary of 45 scientific researches done by various universities and research institutes. All, without exception, demonstrate adverse effects of power line radiation on animals as well as on human beings.

The answer? The possible dangers of electric smog need to be cautiously weighed against the benefits from the use of electric power. We cannot entirely avoid undesirable side effects of the environment as mankind has made it.

TENTH ANNIVERSARY-- FOUNDATION OF THE USPA

Two researchers traveled from Indianapolis to New York in 1972. With 12,000 books in their own private library, it was easy to separate the occult from the serious researcher in unusual energies.

College professors, nurses, physicists, and electronic men were interviewed. What we found was that little more than existed in popular occult books was known about the energy.

We drove to Washington, D.C. to interview similar people doing research, mainly in plant responses. Again little was known, so we drove back to Indianapolis.

I continued to search around the country: Denver, Sacramento, Dallas, Iowa City, and universities across the nation. The end result: almost nothing was known about an unusual energy which thousands of people believed in.

A newsletter was started on Radionics, which reportedly utilized the energy in an instrument for healing people and plants. A former organization in Radionics had existed, grown, and died out thirty years previously. Serious researchers from across the country subscribed, as well as 'old' Radionic believers. The editor, J. L. Terrel, and I as the instigator were surprised by the response, and of acting as intermediaries to introduce researchers from one part of the country to others living elsewhere.

The results were seen immediately. People were hungry for information, and likewise hungry for someone to talk to intelligently without occult palmistry or astrology being thrown into the conversation. In short, researchers relaying results.

J. L. Terrell married, dropped out of the search, and resigned. I continued until the newsletter

failed.

Four months passed while letters poured in. Researchers wanted to meet other researchers. Bio-physics professors wanted to talk with people in electronics, in physics, and in medicine. The thing holding everyone up was that there was no "academic" publication which would "dare" print research on energies which were reportedly "metaphysical" or occult in nature. England and Czechoslovakia were doing 'open' research, but not in the United States -- it was 'stigma' and taboo!

So the result was..nothing. No serious research here. In a burst of altruism, I spent my last eleven hundred dollars in reserving a large suite of conference rooms at the Indianapolis Hilton, and installing a copying machine. Invitations were sent to all researchers, all publications with interest in unusual energies, and all just plain interested people from my files.

This first "Radionic" conference, held in 1975, was a success. I was nominated as president for a future conference. The Washington, D.C. conference in 1976 was also a success, and the organization was renamed the United States Psychotronics Association and chartered as a non-profit group. I resigned as president and Dr. Henry Nagorka was elected. Every year since then a group of like-minded researchers has met with interesting people from across the country, and the USPA has grown in numbers and stature. We now provide the largest open forum for researchers in unusual energies to present their theories and work. Congratulations on the 10th anniversary to all USPA members!!

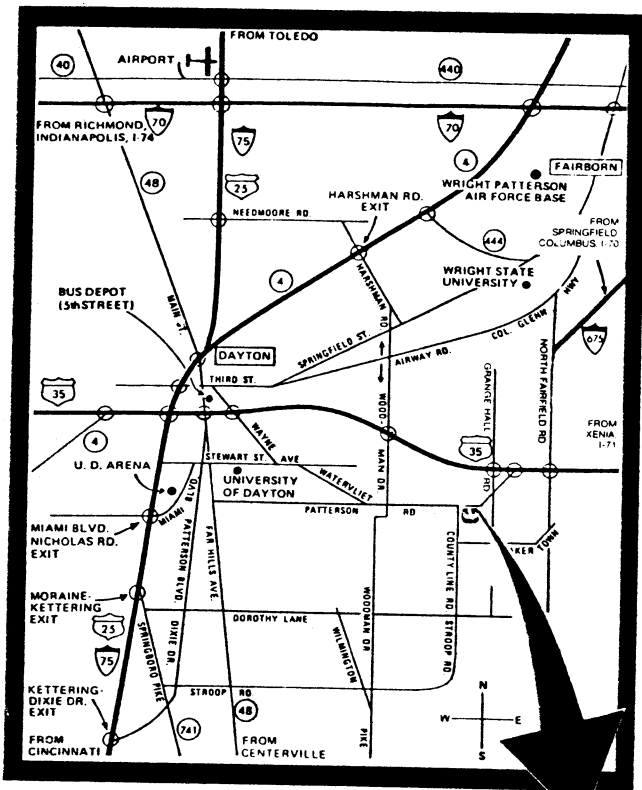

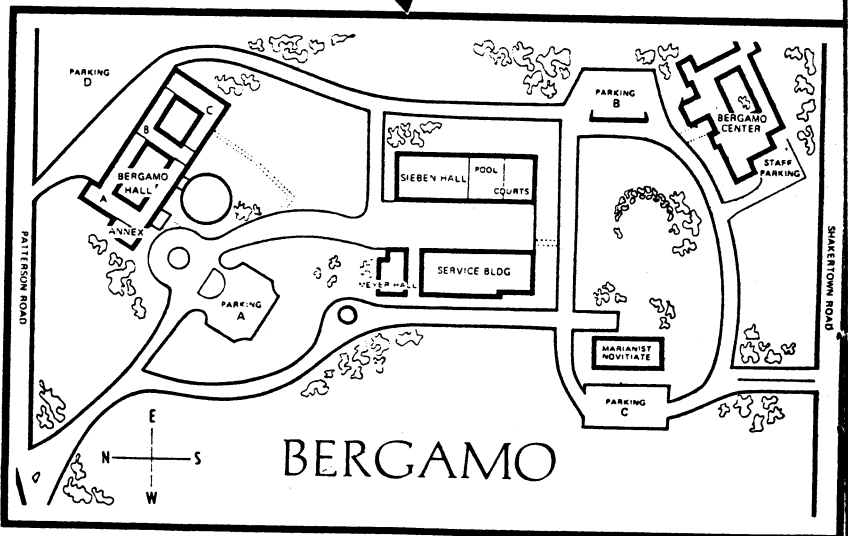
